BALLARD HOUSE

Richmond, Va.

Opened by J.P.Ballard on October 30 1855, and one of its first guests was ex-President John Tyler, who continued to live in it until his death there on Jan. 18 1862.

Richmond society entertained the Prince of Wales (Edward VII) at a grand banquet in the Ballard House on October 6 1860, and in 1869 when the Virginia State House collapsed, the legislature held its sessions in the hotel.

Although Richmond had few pretentious hotels, those it did have were historic. The old Ballard House and the Exchange Hotel, standing side by side, were for many years rivals in popular favor, and during Civil War days they were centers of excitement similar to that at the Willard in Washington. From their roofs great crowds watched the Union and Confederate forces fight the battle of Chickahominy and other events of the war.

Many years after the war, ,the two hotels were merged into one, and together they survived until March 16 1896.


