KNOW YOUR POSTOFFICE (No. 10) -- South Dorset.

The postoffice at South Dorset (Bennington Co.) was originally a portion of the porch of the home of the postmaster, Mrs. Gertrude F. Malloy, which was enclosed and made into a heated room some years ago. This, in itself, is not too unusual; what makes it different is its size. Measuring eight feet from front to back, and nine feet from side to side, it has a counter, with lock boxes, that is somewhat over two feet in width, which leaves Mrs. Malloy about three feet of space on her side, while the customers have somewhat less than three feet from the front wall to the postal window -- and the door opens inward. The first person in has to move to the right to admit the second, and the two are considerably squeezed to admit a third. It then becomes a feat in logistics for the first one to leave the postoffice without being preceded by the others, in reverse order of entrance. Nor is Mrs. Malloy's side too large, especially while the Christmas rush is on. At that time the postmaster's side of the counter is almost completely filled with mail bags, and Mrs. Malloy, one of the most habitually cheerful persons alive, is forced to retreat into her kitchen (whose door fortunately opens into the kitchen rather than into the postoffice) and attempt to transact business by reaching over the obstructing mail bags.

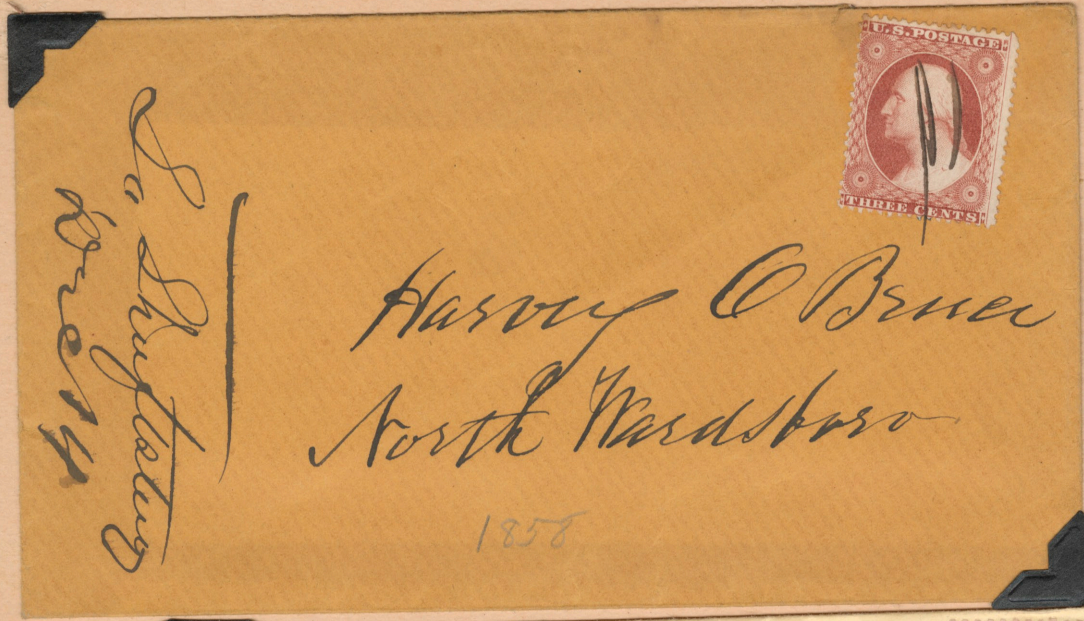
