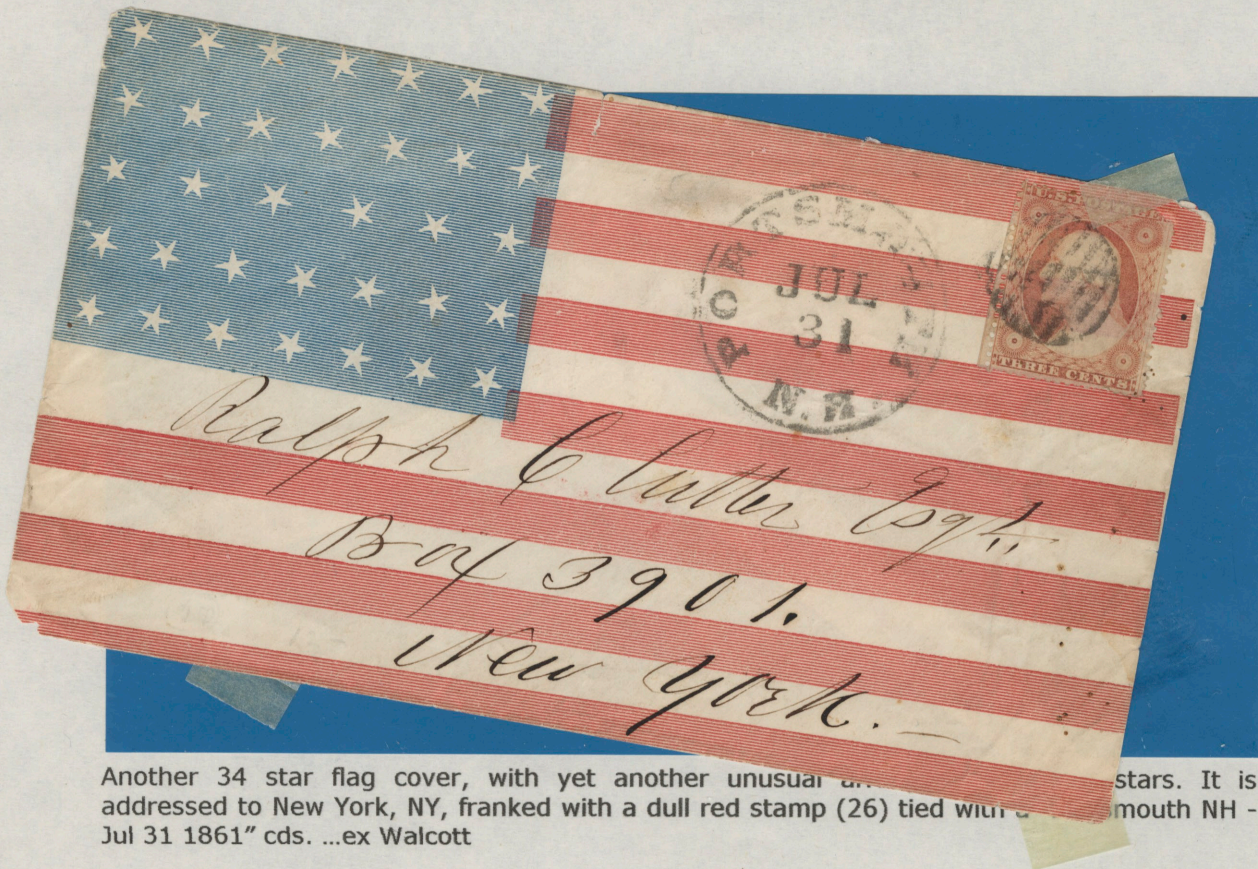


A 34 star flag cover with unusual star arrangement. Probably lithographed. It is addressed to Willimantic Conn, franked with a 3ct rose stamp (65), tied with a "Washington DC Feb 18 1861" cds.



Another 34 star flag cover, with yet another unusual arrangement of stars. It is addressed to New York, NY, franked with a dull red stamp (26) tied with a "New York NH - Jul 31 1861" cds. ...ex Walcott



It is thought that this cover had been lithographed. The 34 star arrangement in the blue field is most unusual. It is addressed to "Philadelphia Pa, franked with a 3ct rose stamp (65), tied with an "Alexandria, Va", Jul 4 1862" cds.



A 34 star full flag cover with an odd arrangement of stars. Very possibly lithographed. It is addressed to Haverhill, Mass, franked with a dark brown red 3ct stamp (26), tied with a "PAID" cancel with an adjoining red "Boston Mass" cds.



A smallish 34 star full flag cover, addressed to Richmond Co., Staten Island, NY, franked with a well centered 10ct green #35, tied with a black "Sacramento City, Cal" cds.
