Vera Cruz. Mexico The U.S. Mail Agency offered full services including registry during the 1914 occupation of North Eastern Mexico. This cover was used Sept. 30, VERACRUZ, VERY 1914, from Vera Cruz by a soldier in the 28th Infantry to Washington, "Vera Cruz Mexico US Mail Agency" registered to D.C. The VERA CRUZ, MEXICO/ Washington DC 30 Sept 1914 at 2 X 2 cents soldier's U.S. MAIL AGENCY killer was rate + 10 cents registry fee. Washington backstamp used on registry and on Ex-Frajola, Landau. Reduced 3/4" at left but parcels. The registry cachet \$250 Scarce usage KKL handstamp was a captured device 8/88 used by the Agency.
