men here now

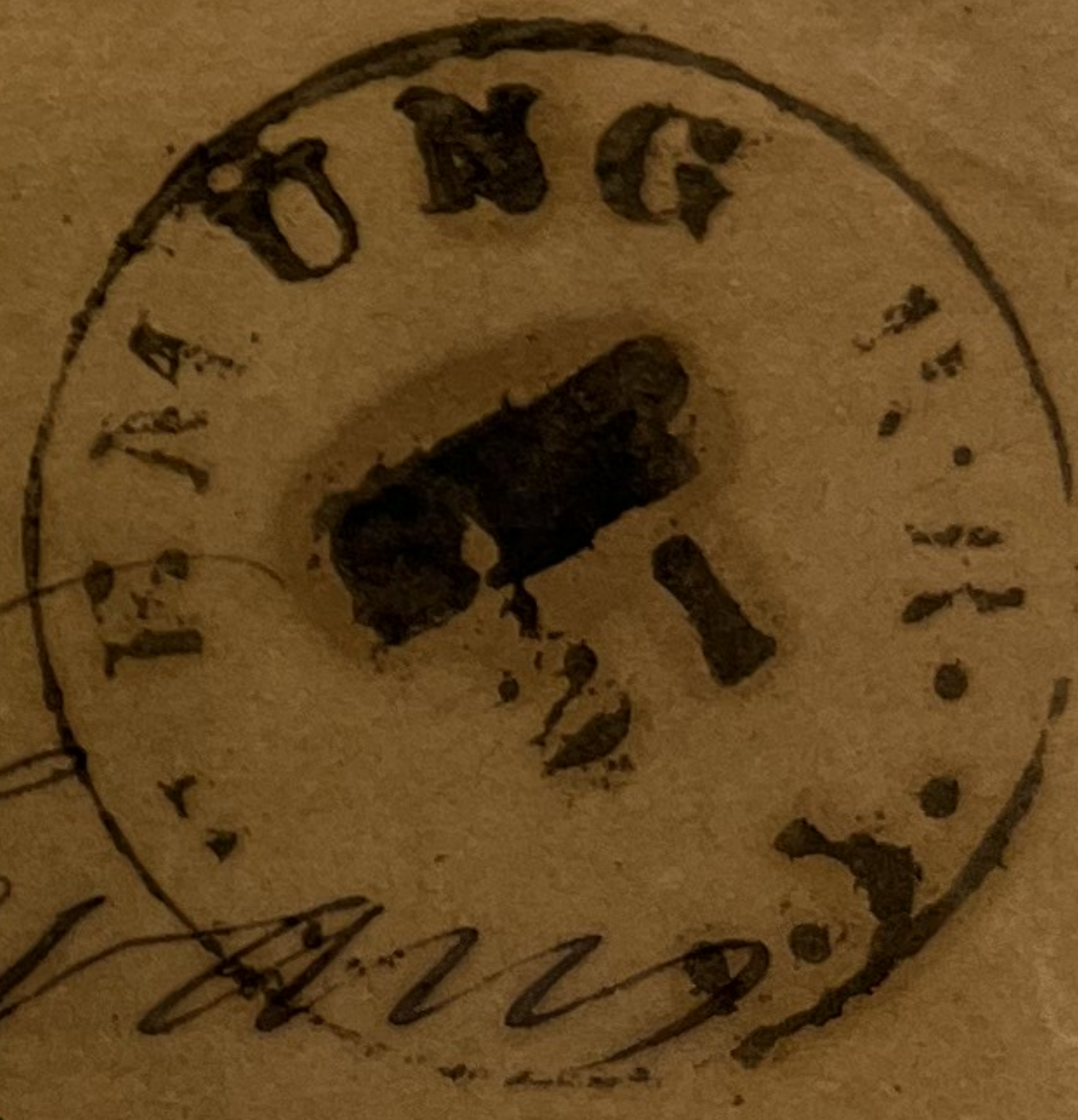

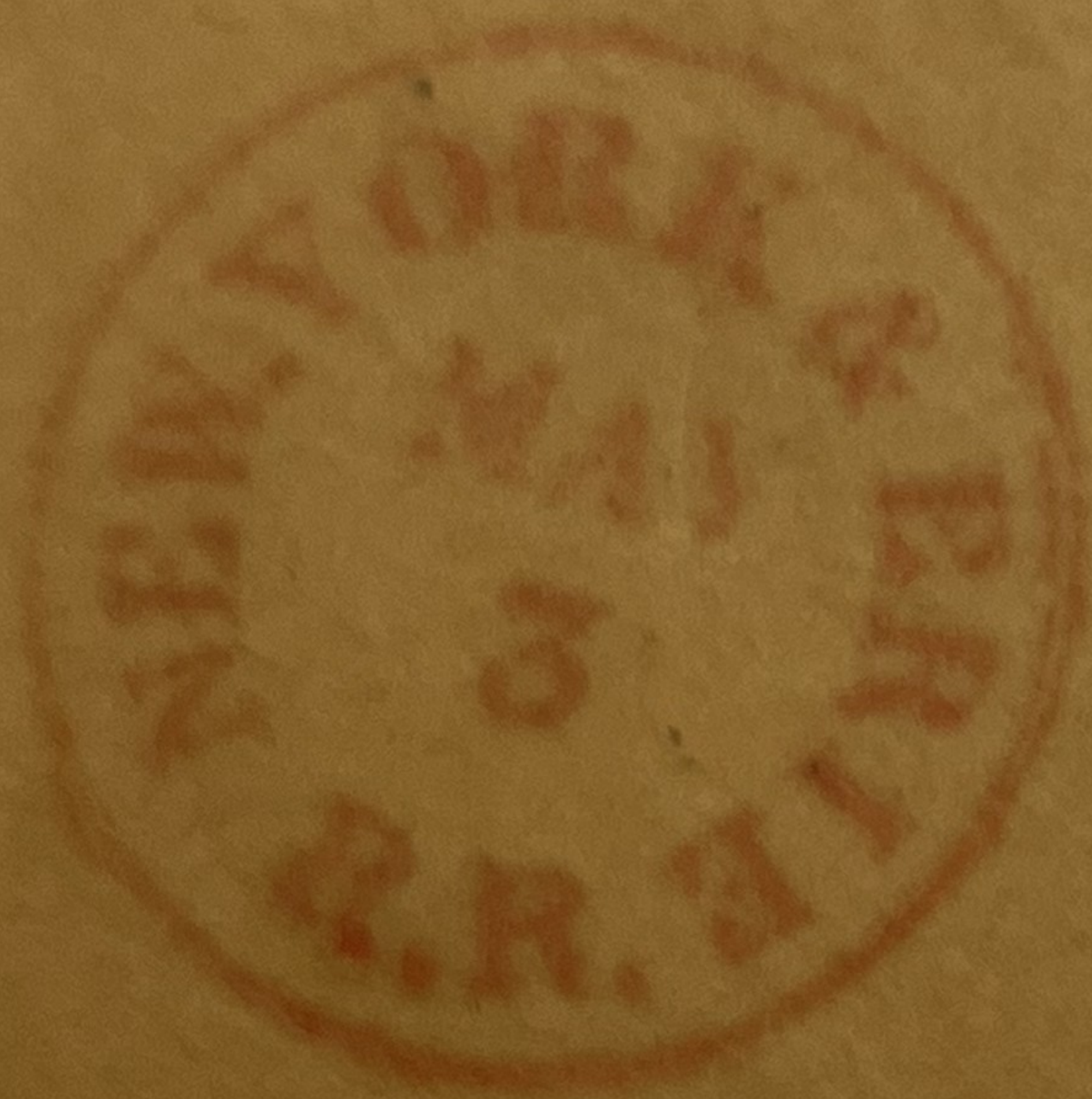

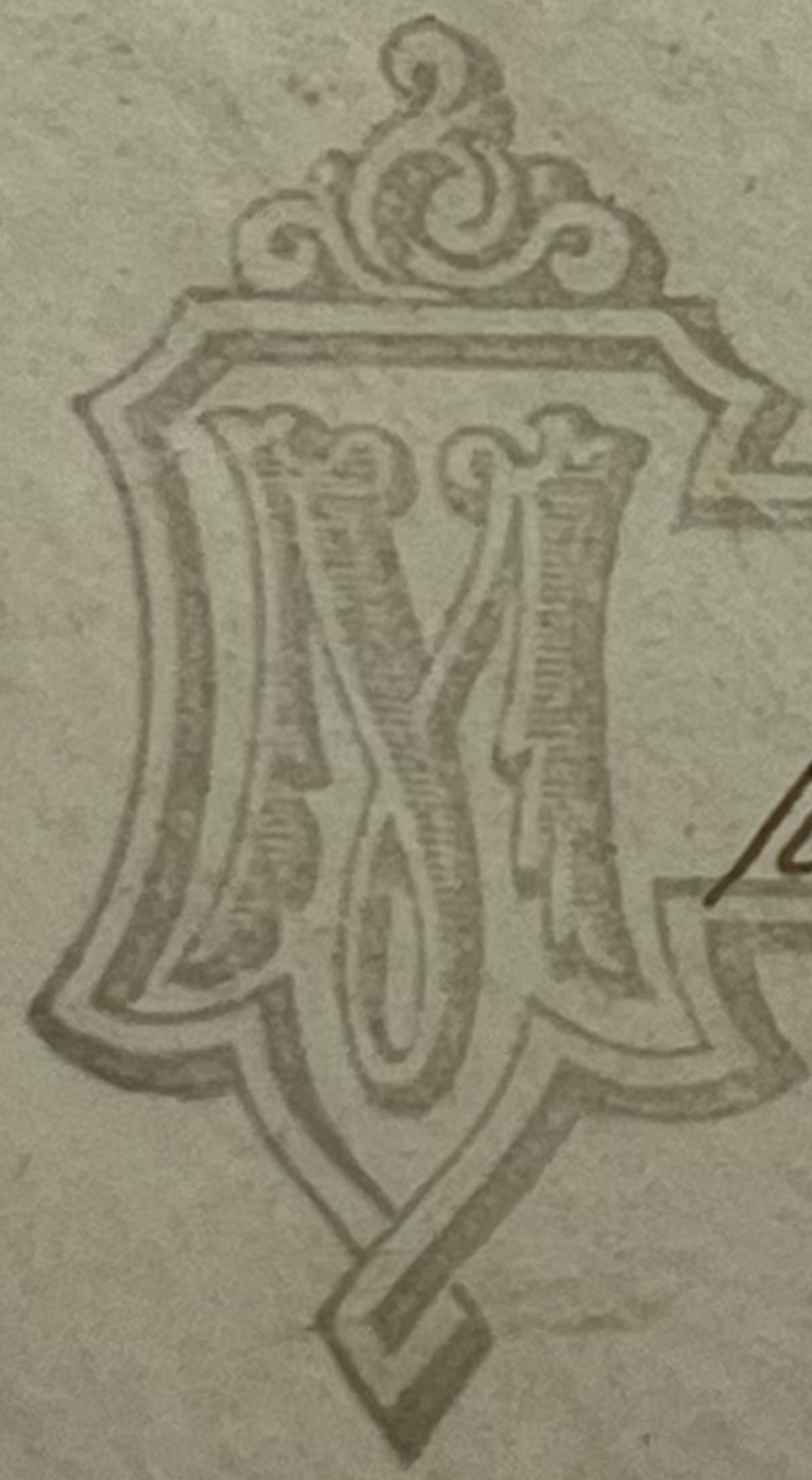

I wrote you several days since
and I supposed the reason you dont
write is you are very busy about these
times I would like to see you very
much I wish you could find time
to visit me here as I shall not have an
opportunity to come out and see you
to come to the point at once. I have come
to the conclusion to go to California neck
or no point and by the overland route to
as I think, it would be much better to go
that way than by sea and that is what
I want to see you for I understand
that you have not redeemed any of your
property yet and therefore I take it you
have not come to some conclusion what you
intend to do I dont want to dictate
no advise you what to do but I believe
it is the best thing we both can do and
for me I am bound to try it you are
the only one I have mentioned it to and
I dont mean I shall go any further
I am ready at any moment and I want
to hear from your intention soon
