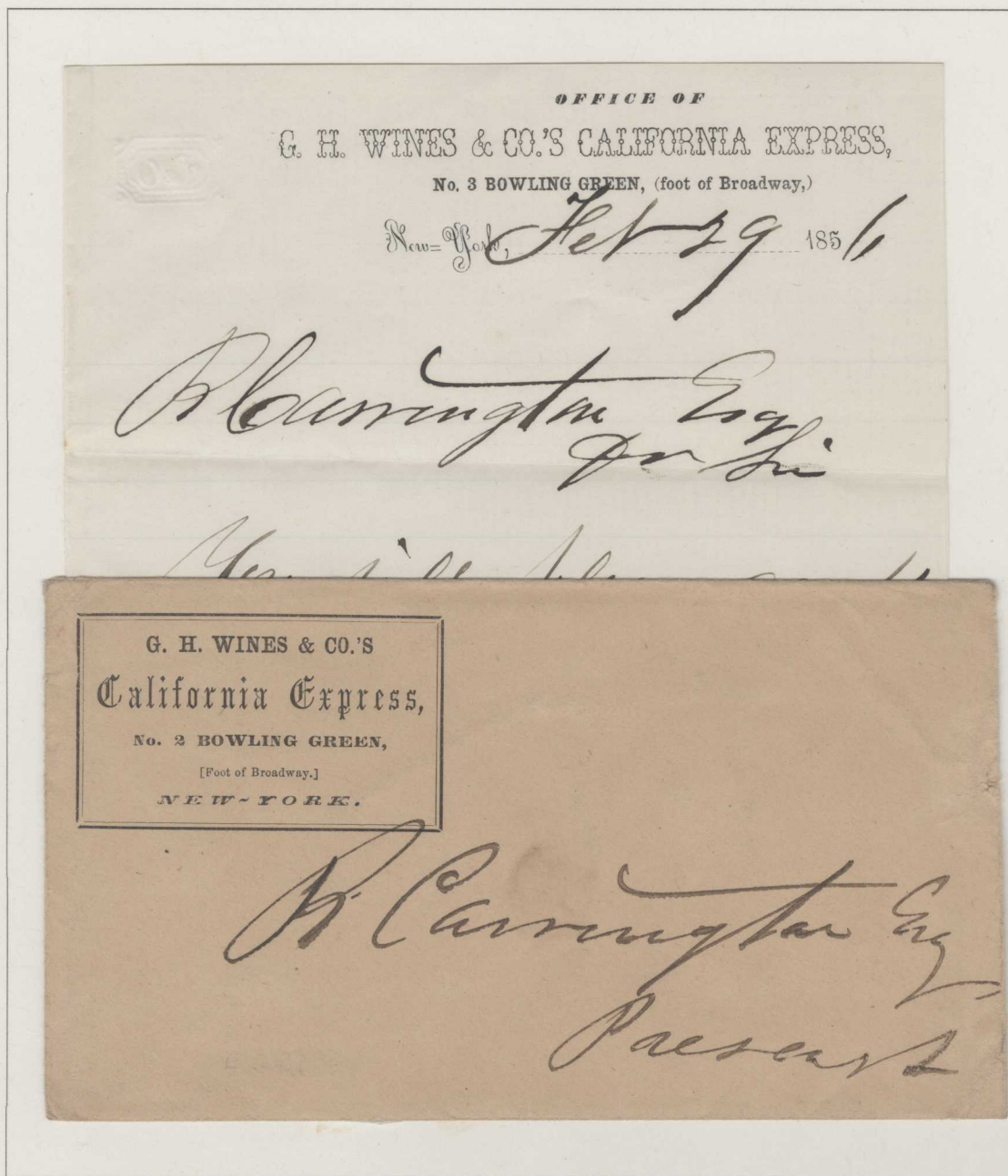


NEW YORK - 1856



29 February 1856 local letter from Wines California Express thanking Robert for “sending our bag.”

In 1857, Robert Carrington contracted yellow fever and died at the age of 29 after a short but very eventful life. Carrington & Co. would no longer compete for the Panama business and would concentrate on their shipping business between New York and Cuba.
