## **NEW YORK - LATE 1855 TO 1856**

Robert Carrington returned to New York in 1855 and found work as purser on the Empire City, now owned by the United States Mail Steamship Company. Isaiah Ward Raymond, formerly San Francisco agent for the Empire City Line, was employed as New York agent for the USMSC.
