Very Dear Mother & Sister

Yours of June the 27th is to hand and happy to hear you all well it little importance. I have to say to you the improvement of my health is in creasing I tried Doctors in Nevada, but without effect Now for the last ten days I have been under the care of a Chinea Doctor in this short space of time he has succeeded in removing all pain and I hope in a short time to be well again. All I at present lack is strength, with regard to my going home this Late it will be impossible.

as my spell of sickness took all the money I had I have made a few trades with success and have sold claims to the amount of four hundred & eighty dollars and prospects beyond that are indeed flattering, with regard to your interrogation relative writing to the young lady mentioned I have written once but have never received any answer the boys here are all well and accept Dear Mother & sisters the warmest wishes of your respected son & brother. also uncle Sam's love to all the children receive the respects of S.
