Has land been secured in Batang for the Mission premises?

The Secretary of State took up the matter with the Chinese government. We have heard nothing since about the purchase of land. We wish to know the facts.

Brother Ogden writes about the need of homes. We agree with him entirely. We have been sending money to Shanghai for buildings right along till we heard that the work had been halted. We shall endeavor to manage to secure and forward money as it is needed. But it is not advisable to send money to Shanghai to lie idle in the bank when the same money can be put to good use elsewhere.
