Dear Sir

I have just returned this day from Talhequah and have succeeded in getting you some of our National Warrants not as much as I anticipated Mr. Foreman had made use of a part of what he had. I could get you more if I had the time being anxious to send you those I got by this mail. I had to come home in a short time I will get more and as fast as I get them I will forward them to you. the Warrant that I got from James Brown. I sent by Joseph Sheppard. to have him Indorse it and for some reason he has not got back home time to send it by this days mail write me where to send it at Vern Buse. or to Philadelphia, there is another matter I wish to consult you on would it not be better to sell these Negroes for Warrants on the Nation I believe they would realise more in that way than any other way they could be disposed of for the reason that they are very unsaleable property in any Country please write me your views on the subject I can sell the here for a large sum and I believe it is the best deal can be made
