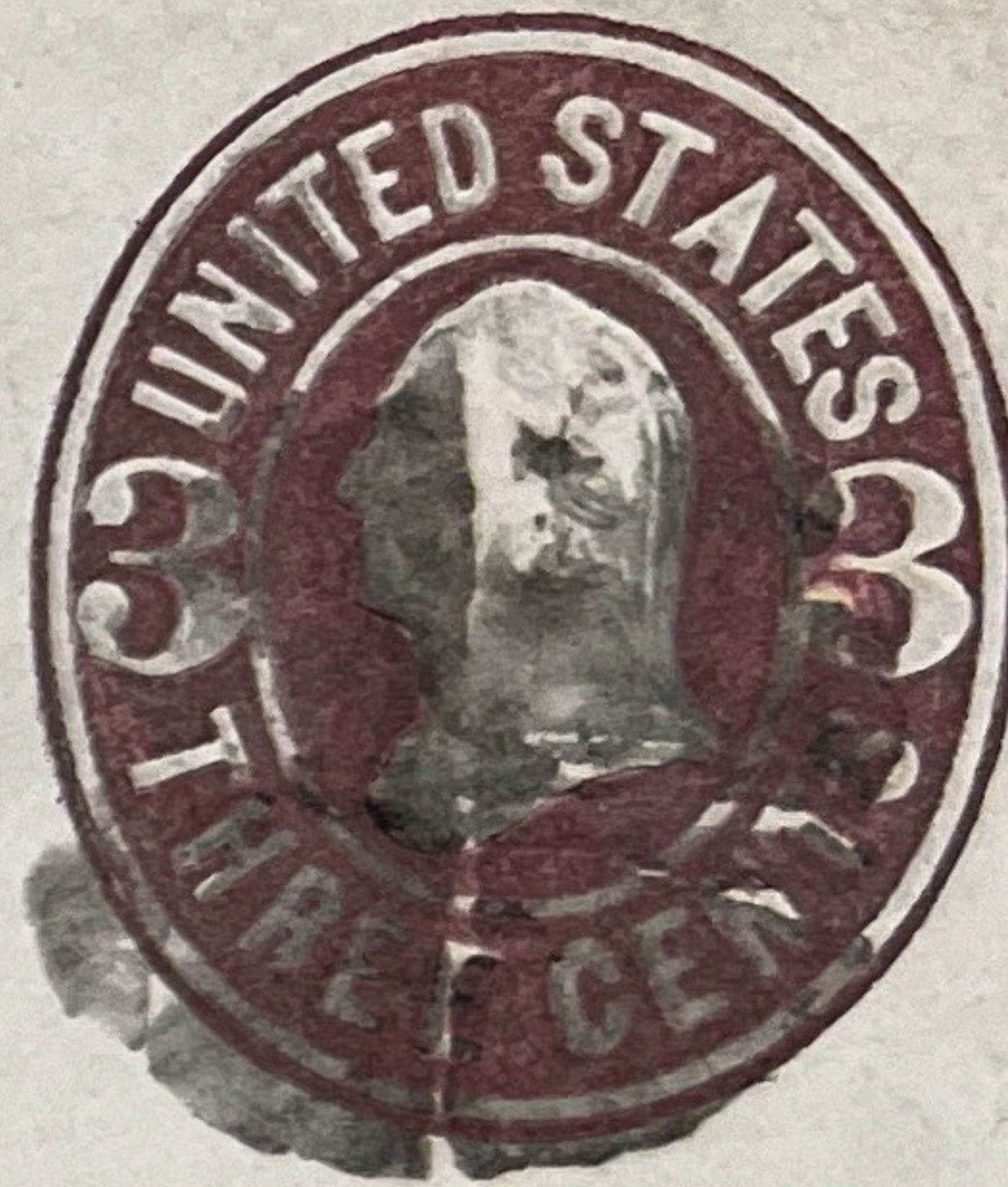
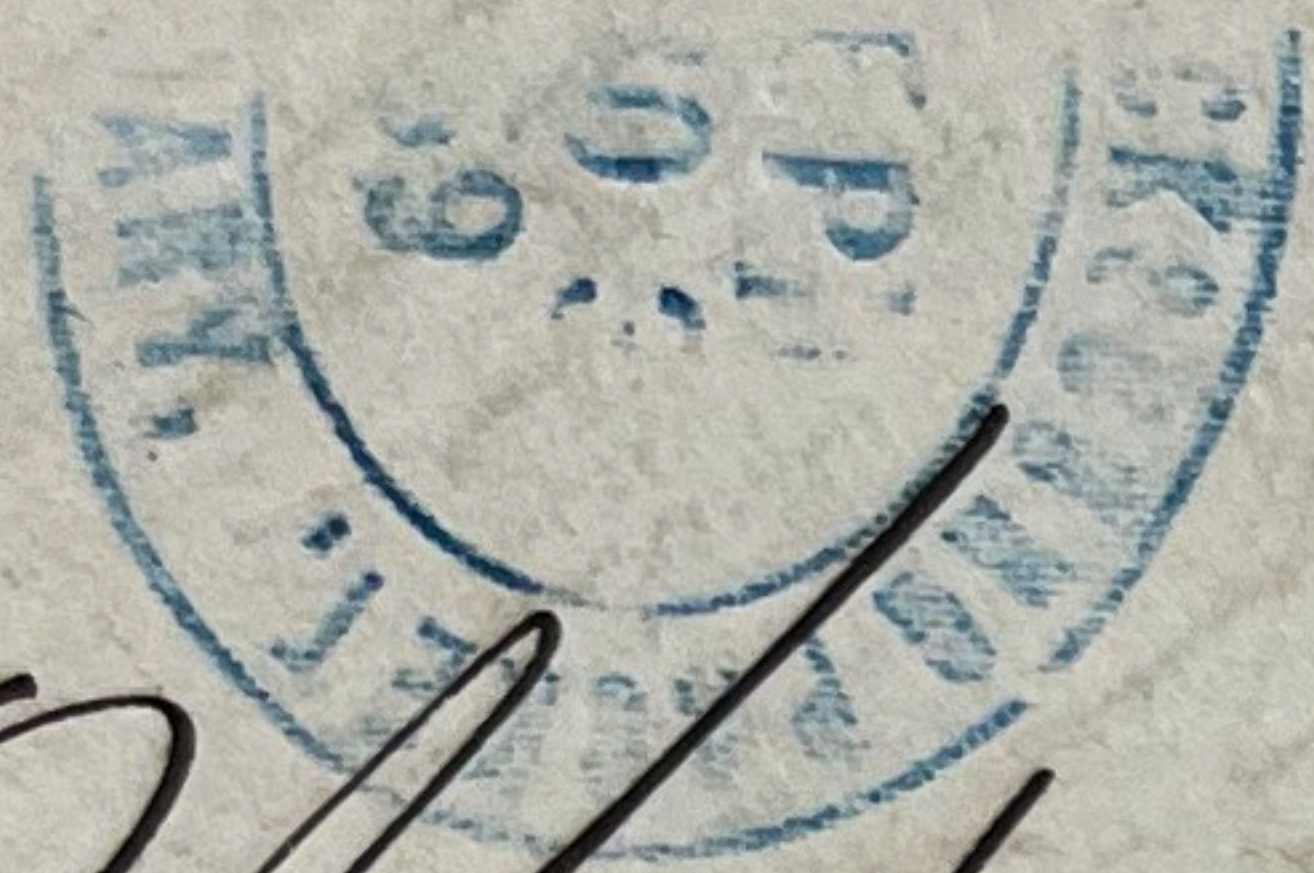
Saint Francis River
