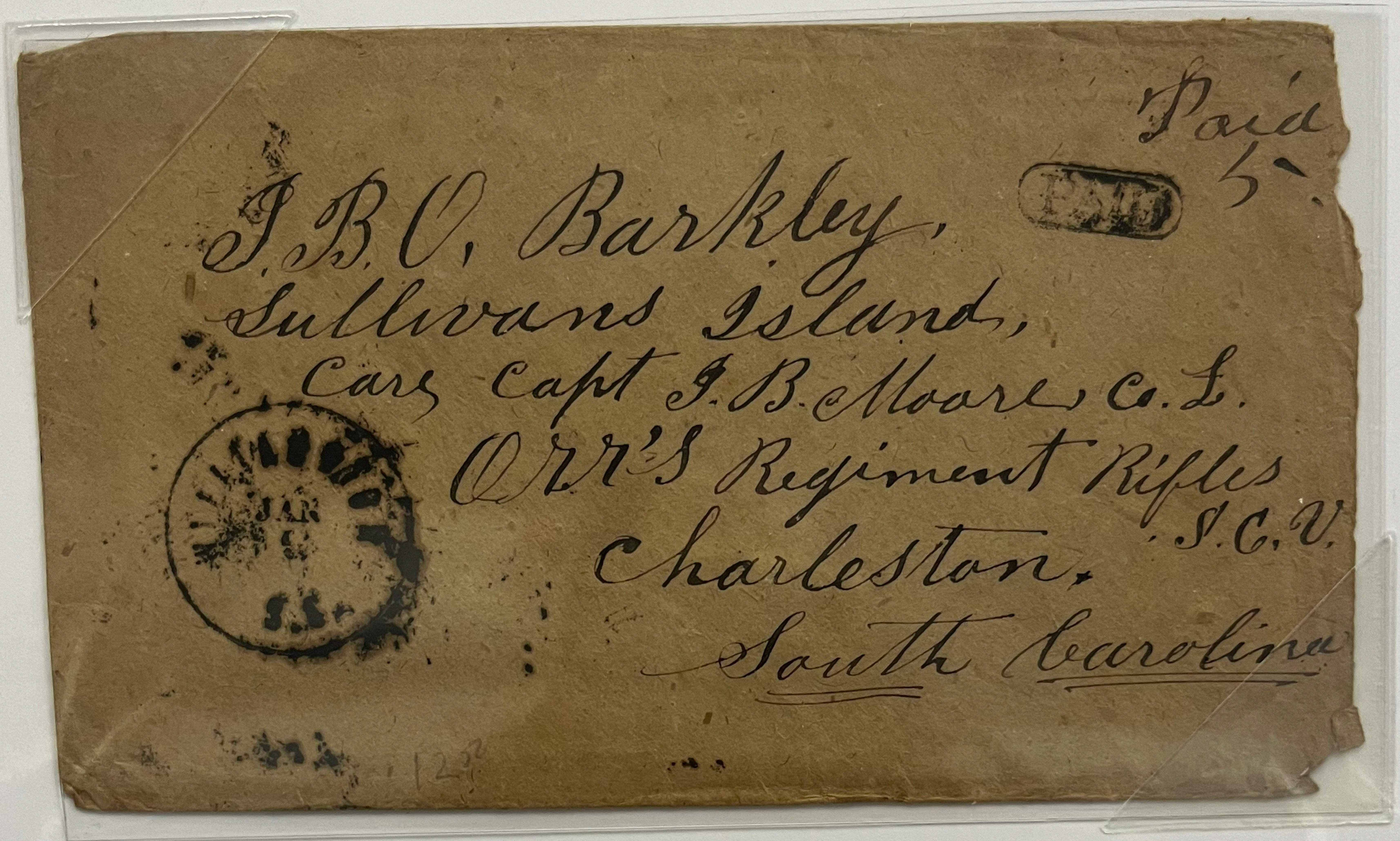

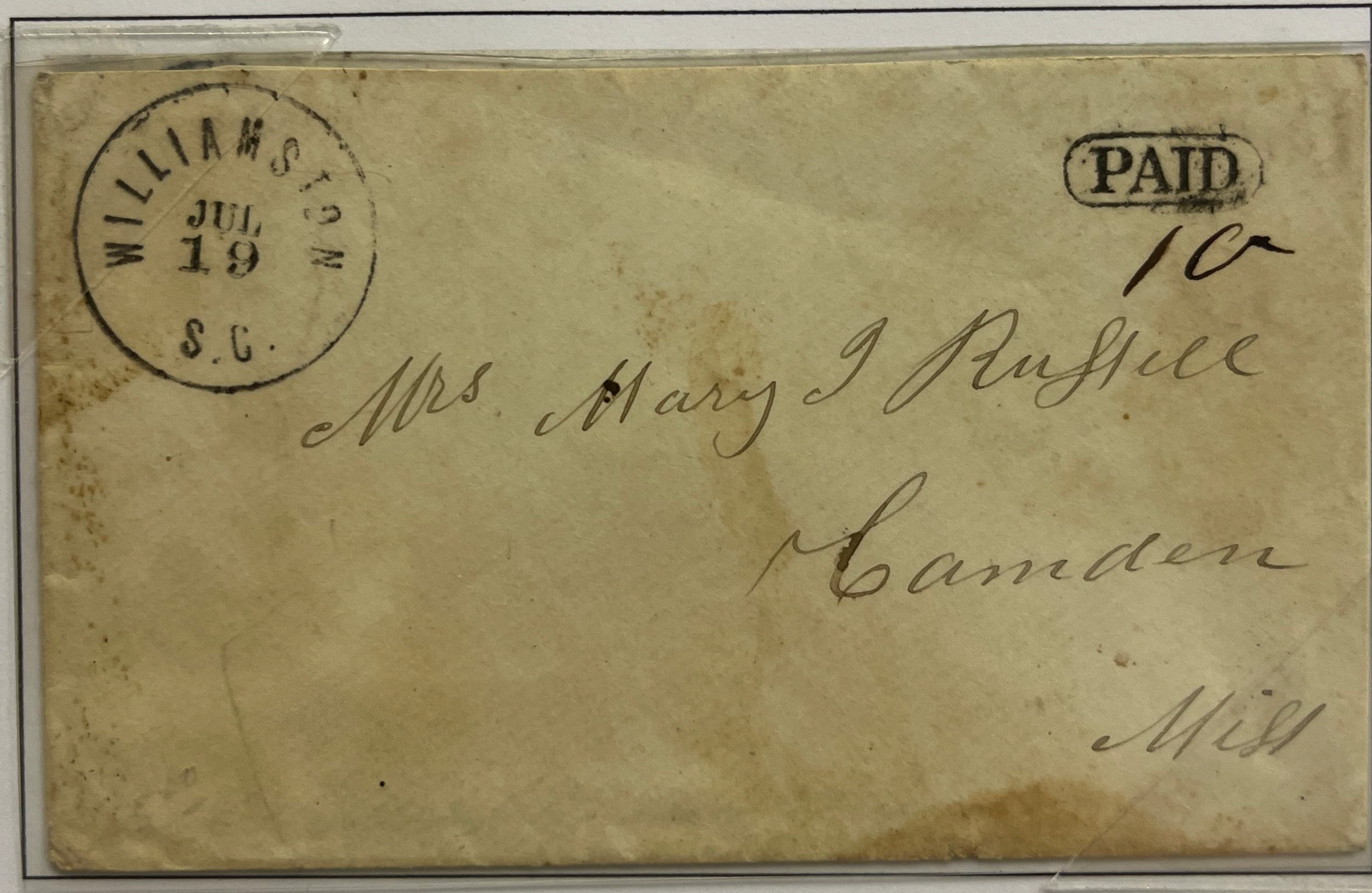

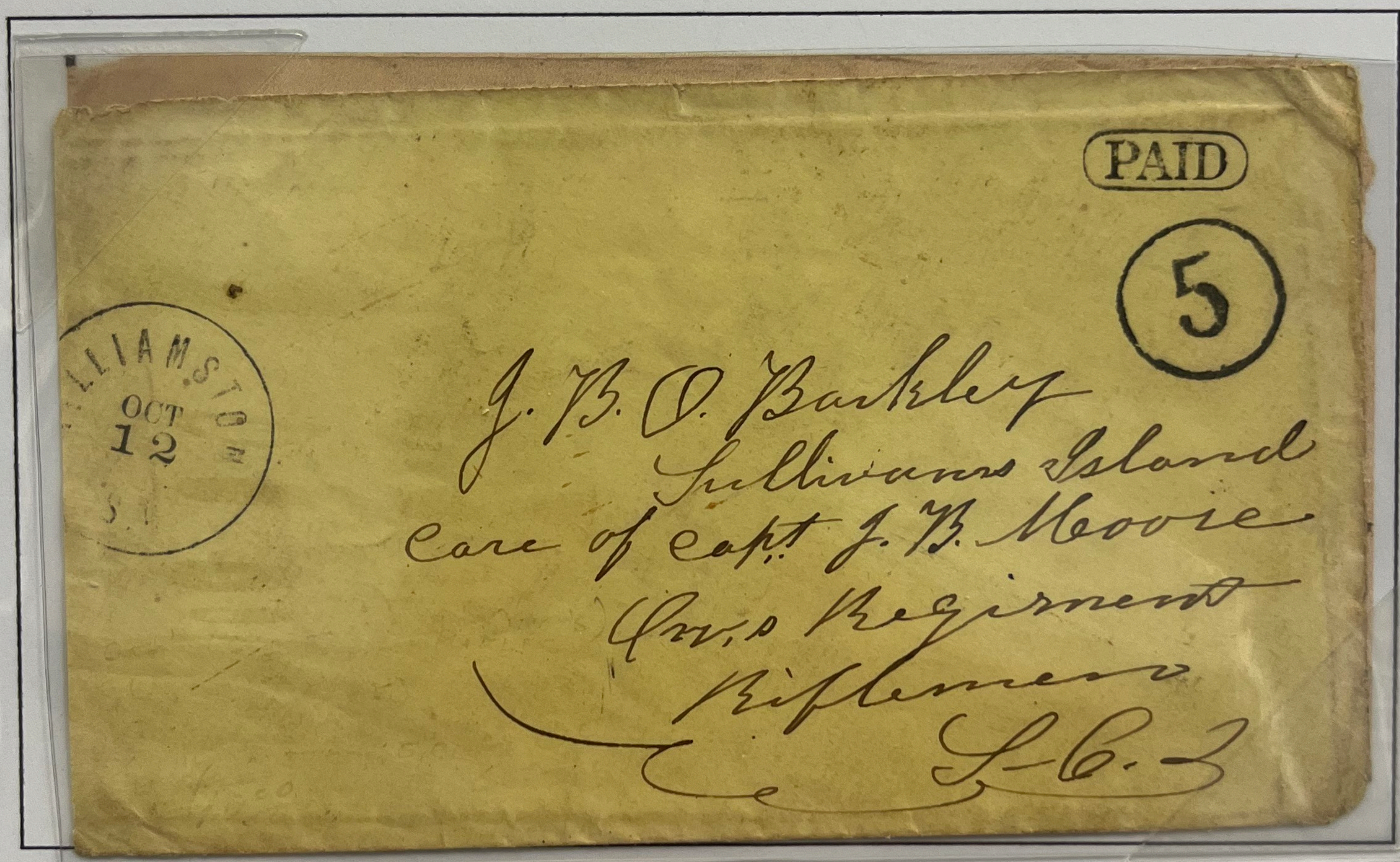

Barkley, SULLIVAN'S ISLAND, Care Capt. J. B. Moore, Co. L, Orr's Regiment Rifles, S.C.V., CHARLESTON, South Carolina. No. 324**

**John B. O. Barkley was a private in Company L, Orr's 1<sup>st</sup> Reg't Rifles. He enlisted on July 20, 1861 at Sandy Springs, Anderson District, SC for a duration of three years. In Mar./Apr. 1862 he was furloughed for severe jaundice. He was promoted to Sergeant on 24 Oct. 1862. He rejoined his Reg't and was severely wounded in the Battle of Fredericksburg; 13 Dec. 1862. He was sent to Chimborazo Hospital # 3. He was discharged from service on 31 Oct. 1864 on account of disability.**
