## Sept 18, 1861 Camp near Germantown


Dear Winnie,

I rec'd your letter yesterday and was quite rejoiced to learn that you and the children were well and judging from the tenor of your letter that things were going on so smoothly at home. I am quite glad to hear you will write twice a week. It does me a great deal of good to hear from you. We have been here at the camp for five weeks and times are getting very dull, though we are expecting them to get lively any day, and I wish that it would commence for we have got them to whip and I would like to be getting through with it. I send you \$40.00, which perhaps you will need. It is all the South Carolina money I can get hold of now. I may be able to get some more soon. I have no news of interest to write I am not able to give you any positive information of what we are going to do. Give my love to Harriet and her children and tell her to write often and kiss my children for me every day and talk to them a great deal about me don't let them forget their Pa.
