## 2 CENT. KAKA DEFINITIVE.

June 1970 N/L.

A plate block of 20 stamps from the right hand corner of the sheet demonstrating varying degrees of pre-printing plate re-touching. R17/6 retouch to the right of the top flower – R18/7 retouch in almost the same area – large area of damage covering two stamps R20/7 and R20/8. The damage appears to have taken the form of a huge plate scratch – R20/9 another more prominent retouch in the area to the right of the top flower – from Plate lalala2a.



## 2 CENT. KAKA DEFINITIVE.

June 1970 N/L.

Imprint block of 16 stamps from the left hand side of the sheet showing further plate damage and the way it is repaired – R17/4 a large crescent shaped area at the middle left hand margin of the stamp has been damaged and later retouched by the use of the burin – R20/1 shows burin-retouched flaws above the word “Kaka” and between the top branch and the margin of the stamp – R19/2 strengthening of design to area top right of the stamp – from Plate 1b1b2b

- R16/8 Retouch below 2 1/2c Thirkell C2.
- R20/4 White stroke above second A of ZEALAND.
- E 2A2A2A3A R1/4 Touching up above top flowers.
- R3/3 Extra serif on c of 2 1/2c.
- R13/8 Speckled blue print around stalks of two left-hand flowers (only on some sheets).
- R20/2 Deformed left stroke of N of ZEALAND.

(From Plates 2a2a2a3a & 2b2b2b3b of both values)  
 Four blocks of twelve from the above plates - printed by the sheet, showing peculiarities in the double comb perforating head. The verticle rows of perforations in row 17 and 18 show irregularities recurring in every second row. These sheets are normally perforated in double sheets working from right to left. Where sheets from these plates have been turned round during the printing process for technical reasons these irregularities may be expected to appear in rows three and four.

- R19/1 Retouched plate scratch under 3 of 3c.
- R13/1 White blob flaw on top of Z of ZEALAND.
- R14/10 Touched-up plate scratch to right of top right flower.
- R15/8 "Gnome's Head" flaw. A white flaw on back of top petal of top right flower opposite I of PUARANGI.
- R5/4 White spot above 3c.
- R11/5 White blob on Z.
- R13/9 Large retouch above D of ZEALAND.
- R20/3 White spot just below 3.
- R20/9 White inverted V at top of upper righthand flower.

This plate has been found in two states known as the original and the retouched states. The varieties listed have been found on sheets as follows:
