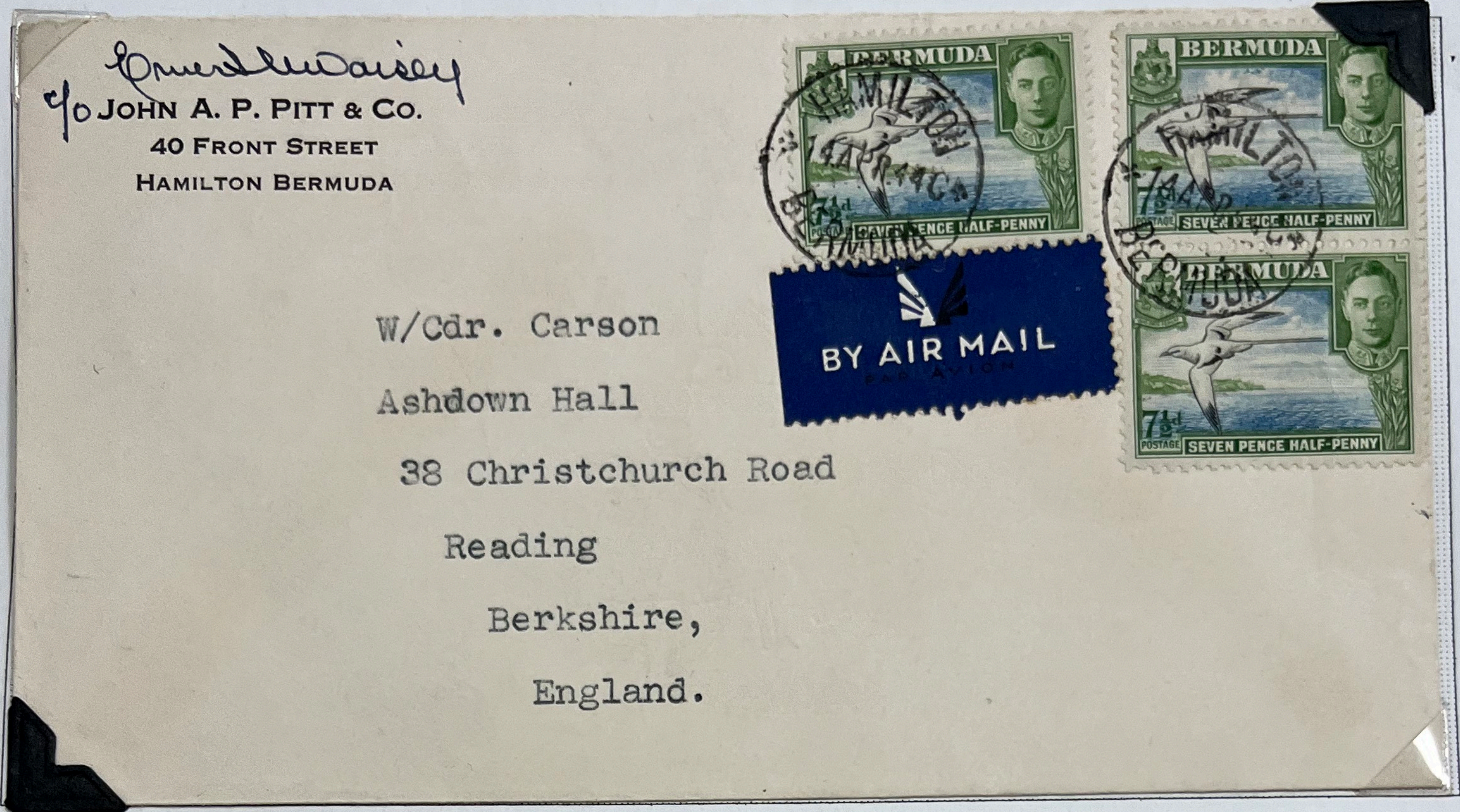

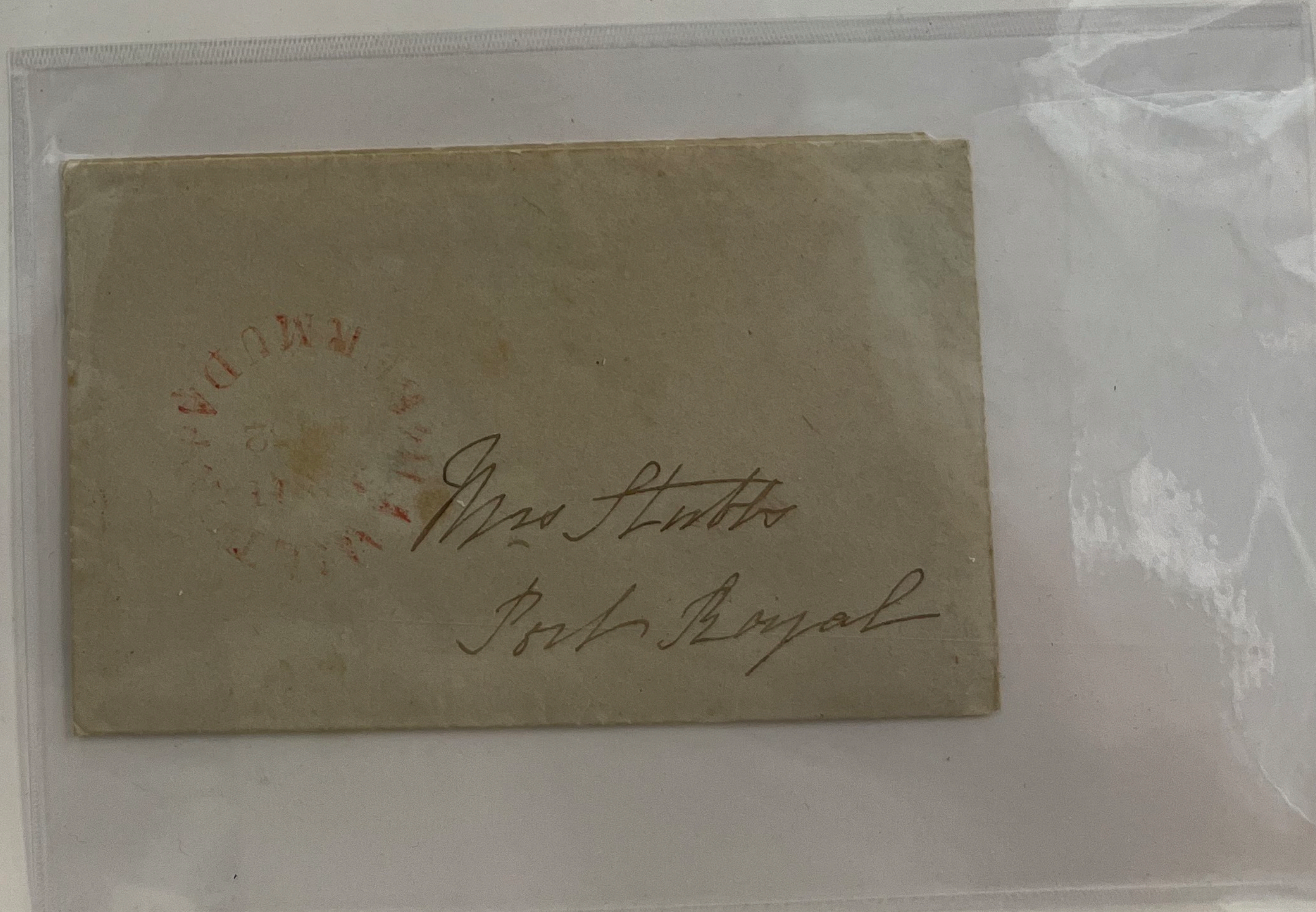
The Hamilton, Bermuda cancel in red, but not with the Postmaster's initials! The date is Mar 11, 1852.

A splendid rare Bermuda Stampless. The addressee Mrs. Stubbs, was the wife of Horatio Stubbs, who in his ship covered the West Indies as far south as British Guiana and north to Brattleboro, Vermont (where there were relatives) all in the period 1840-1860.

His actual home was in the Turks Islands. There in an old barn a trunkfull of his correspondence was found many years ago. Most of the contents were scattered by children and lost.

His descendants moved to Winnipeg and played a notable part in the formation of this city. A great grandson sold me a bundle of covers which did include such as U.S. #1 on cover. But most were stampless like this Bermuda example.



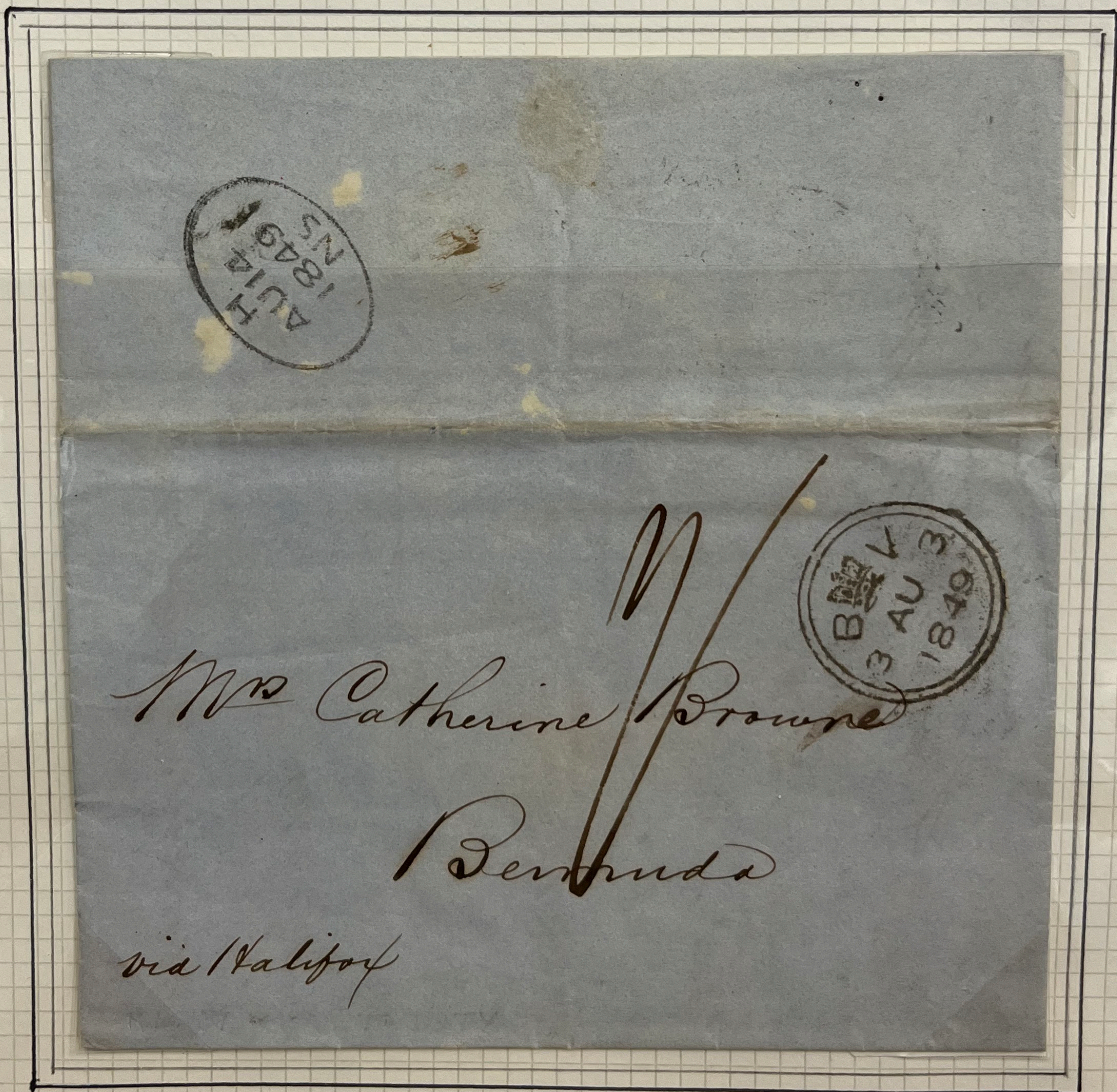

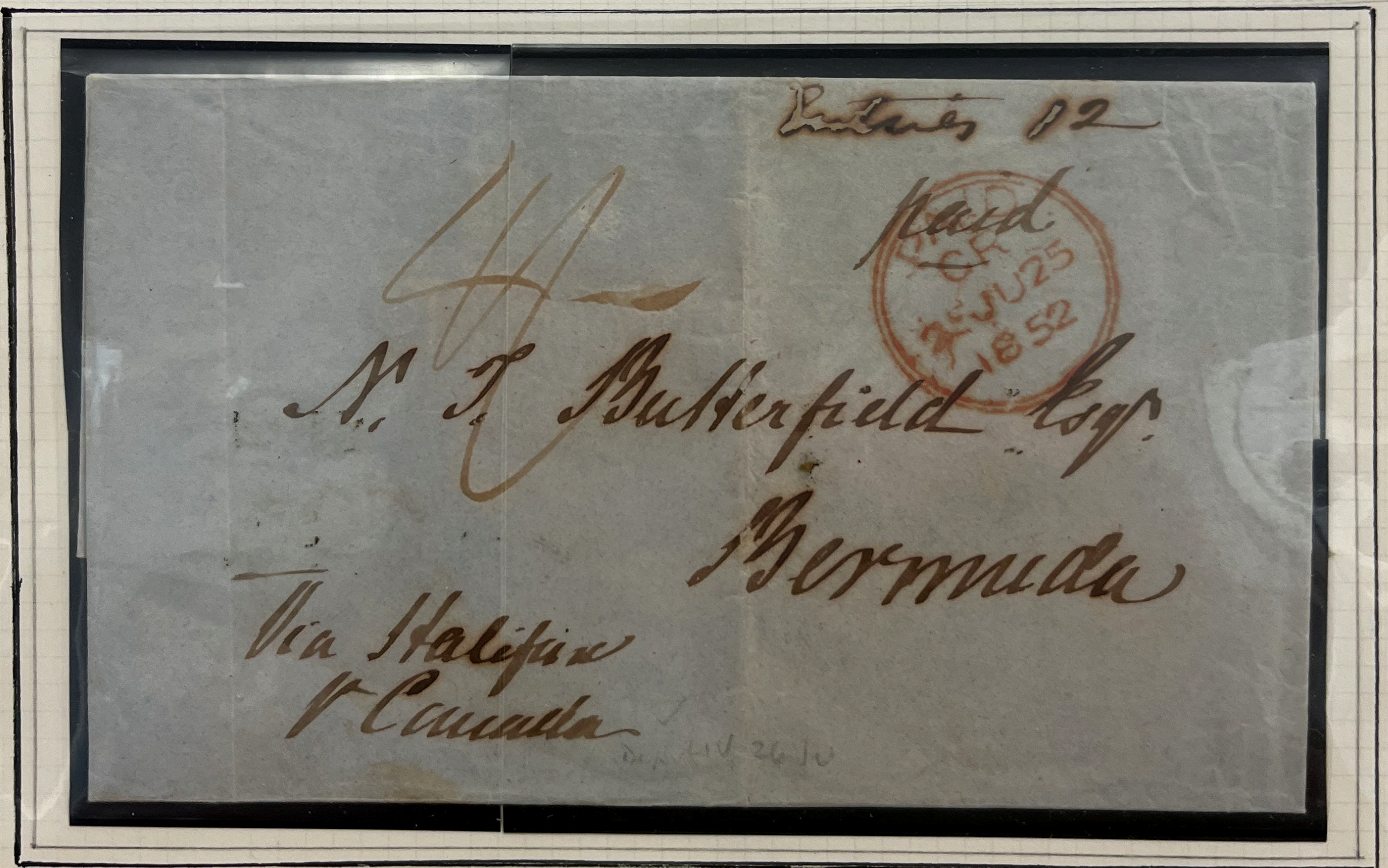


This letter was sent from London on Aug 3, 1849 on the ship Hibernia which sailed out of Liverpool on Aug. 4. It arrived in Halifax on 14 Aug, but was grounded in Halifax harbor. She sailed for Liverpool on 1 Sept. but returned Sept. 7 in leaking condition. She was sent to New York for repairs on Sept. 11 and returned direct to Liverpool on 29 Sept. The Ospray left Halifax on 14 Aug. (apparently carrying this letter) and arrived in Bermuda on 18<sup>th</sup> August.

BETWEEN BERMUDA and NORTH AMERICA

DECEMBER 18th, 1941

The air mail rate to United States, Canada and Newfoundland was reduced to 7½d. from 1s which had been in effect since November 21, 1939. A 7½d stamp was issued for this rate. All covers received Special first day cachet.

A cover sent from the K.E.M. Hospital in Bermuda to Ottawa, Canada franked correctly with a 2 ½d adhesive which was cancelled by a slogan postmark reading “Bermuda Aquarium, One of the World’s Finest” on 19<sup>th</sup> July 1941. It was censored in Bermuda with a B.C.1 label by censor 576. There are no back stamps, but the cover was probably carried to the U.S.A. first, where if it had been addressed there the rate would have been 3d.



A post war commercial cover addressed to Cardiff. It was franked 2 ½d from the 2<sup>nd</sup> reprint, the colour having changed slightly from the colour above, and cancelled at Ireland Island on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 1947. There are no back stamps.

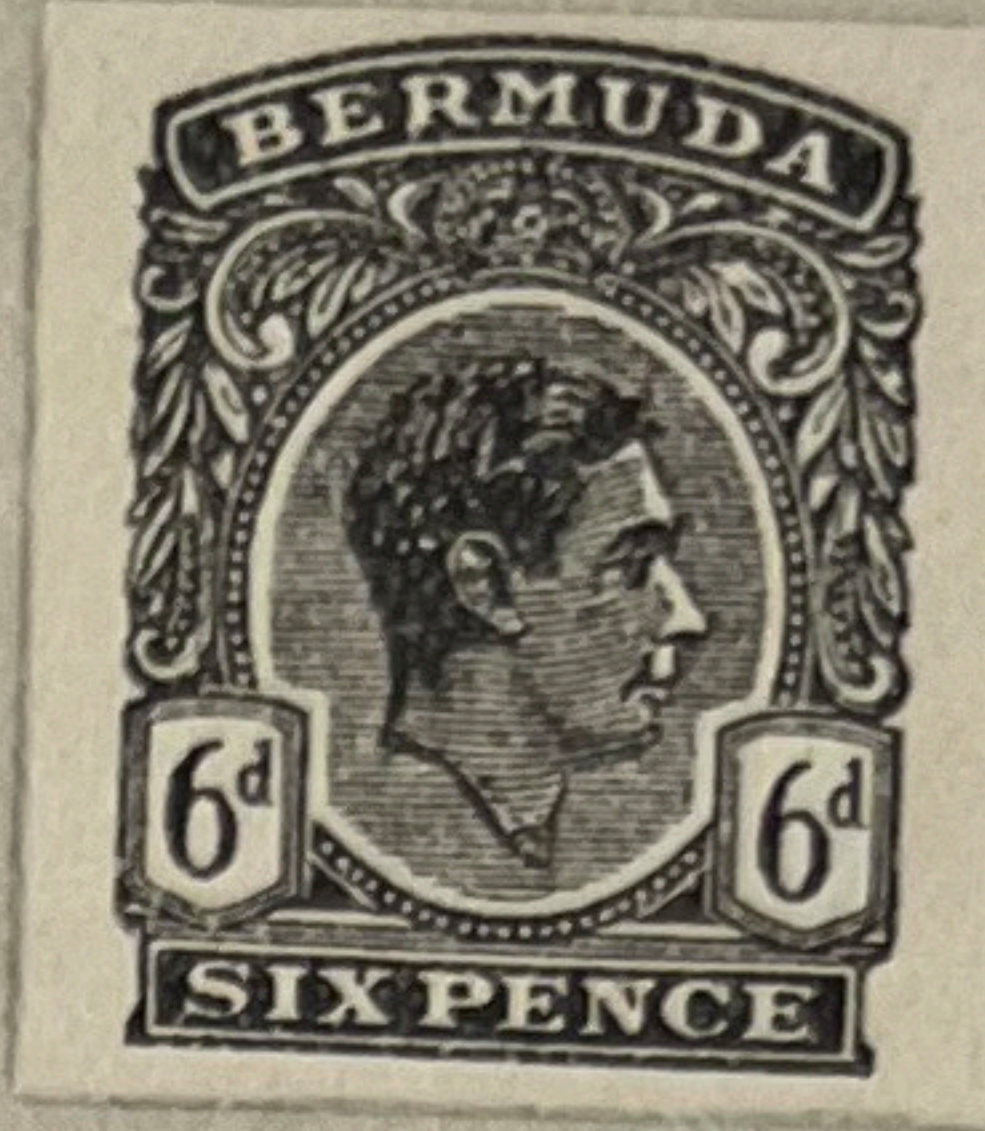
