Karelia's Only Stamp

During the four year occupation of Karelia by the Finns, the postal service there relied on Finnish stamps, albeit reprinted in different colors, and overprinted for use in the territory. However, on one occasion a stamp was produced exclusively for the territory. This was in 1943 and it is the stamp illustrated here. It was a charity issue, hence the surcharge, and the additional funds were designated for war victims in East Karelia.

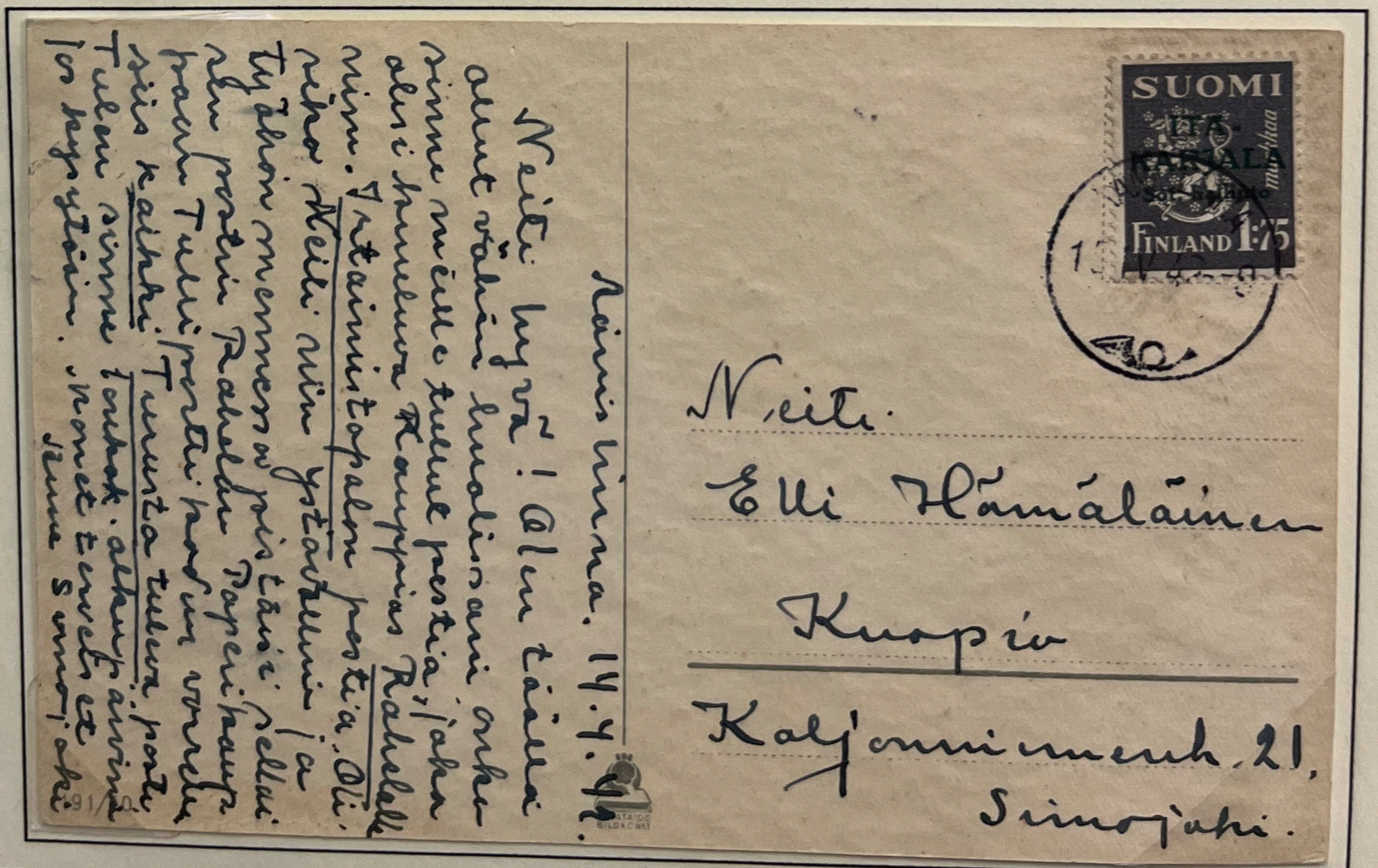
