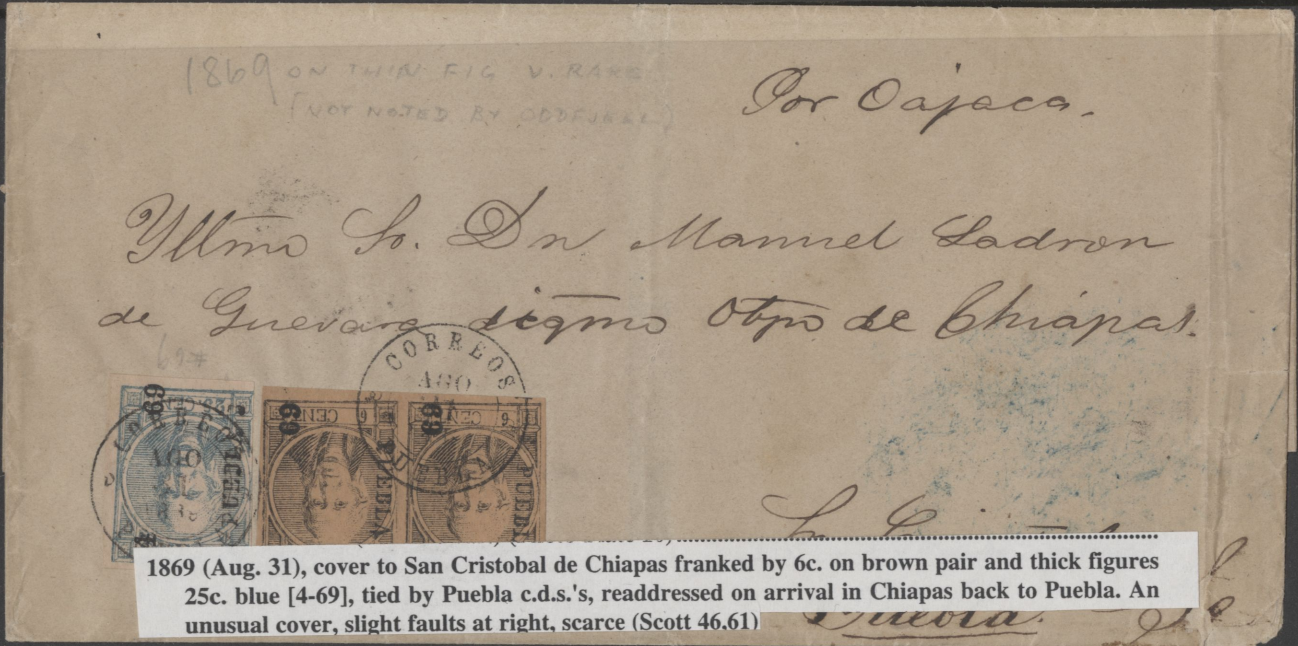

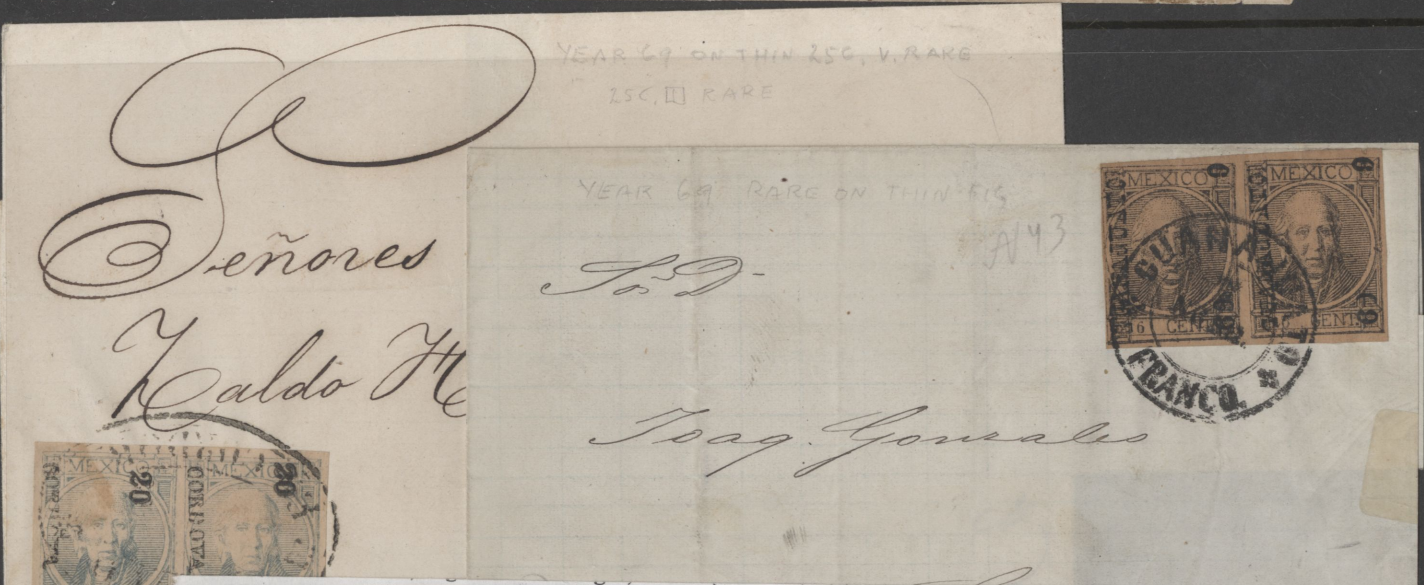

1868 Issue-Imperforate, Thin Figures  
 1868 (Nov. 26), cover to Durango franked by fine strip of four 6c. on brown [13-69] without District name overprint, cancelled by fine straight line Sombrete handstamps in black. A scarce and attractive cover (Scott 46 var.)



1869 (Aug. 31), cover to San Cristobal de Chiapas franked by 6c. on brown pair and thick figures 25c. blue [4-69], tied by Puebla c.d.s.'s, readdressed on arrival in Chiapas back to Puebla. An unusual cover, slight faults at right, scarce (Scott 46.61)



1869, two covers, first bearing 6c. pair, [6-69] used to Leon and cancelled Guanajuato c.d.s., second with late use of 25c. blue, [20-69] pair tied by Cordoba oval cancel. A fine pair (Scott 46.48)
