





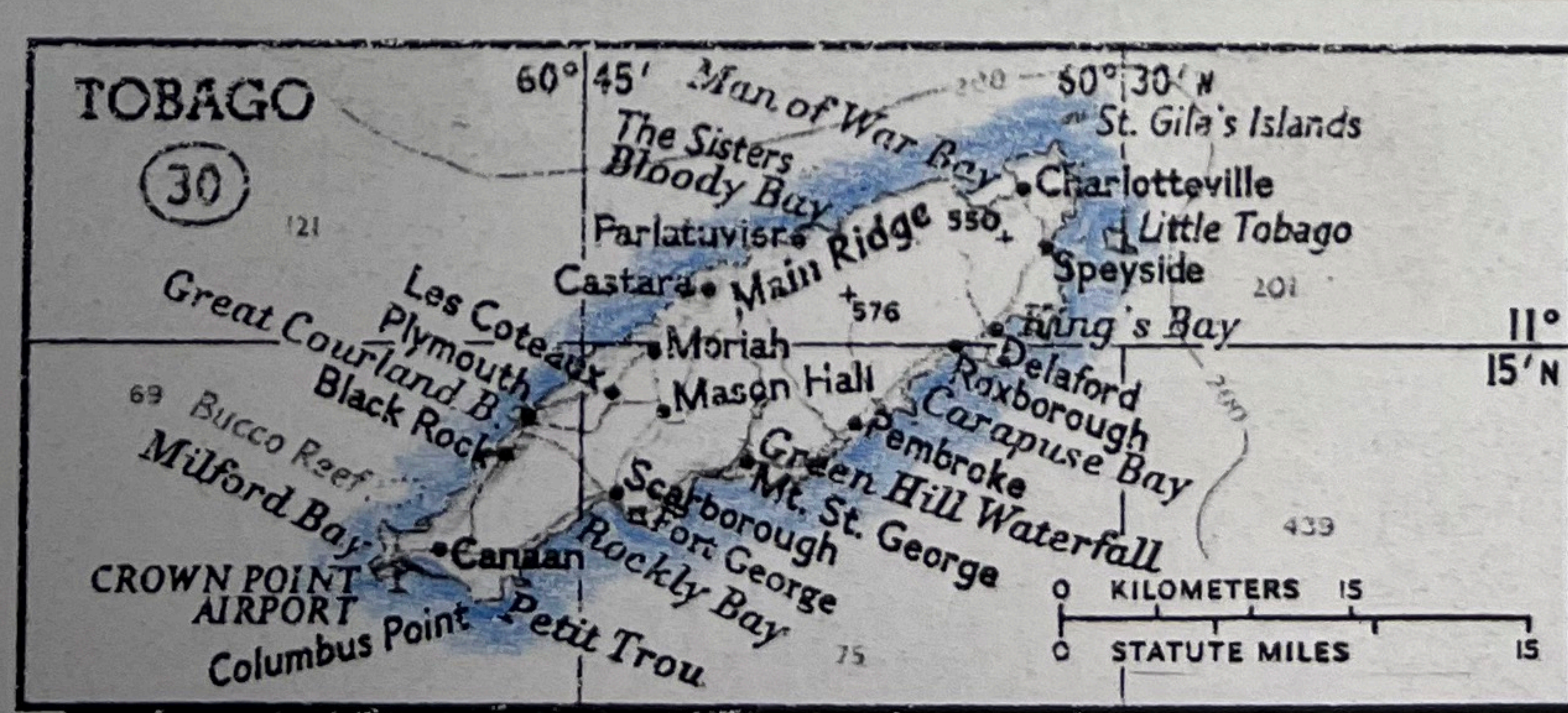
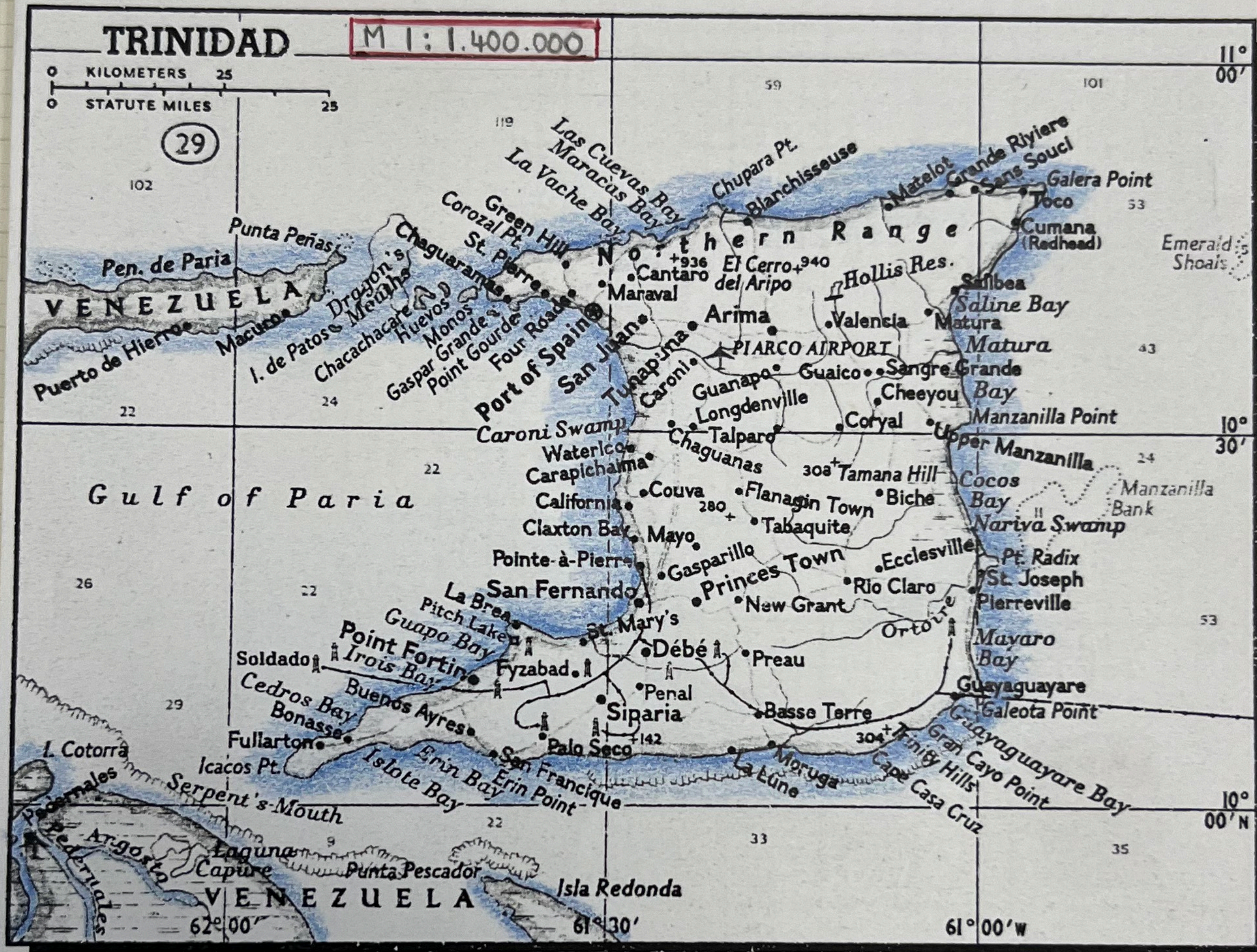


# TRINIDAD

## TRINIDAD

Oil, agriculture, and tourism are the chief supports of the two-island nation of Trinidad and Tobago. Trinidad, after Puerto Rico, is the most industrialized island in the Caribbean, and home to a remarkably diverse population of more

than a million. In addition to Chinese, Arabs, and Europeans, some 83 percent are descended from African slaves or East Indian indentured workers who were brought to Trinidad after Britain abolished slavery in 1834.

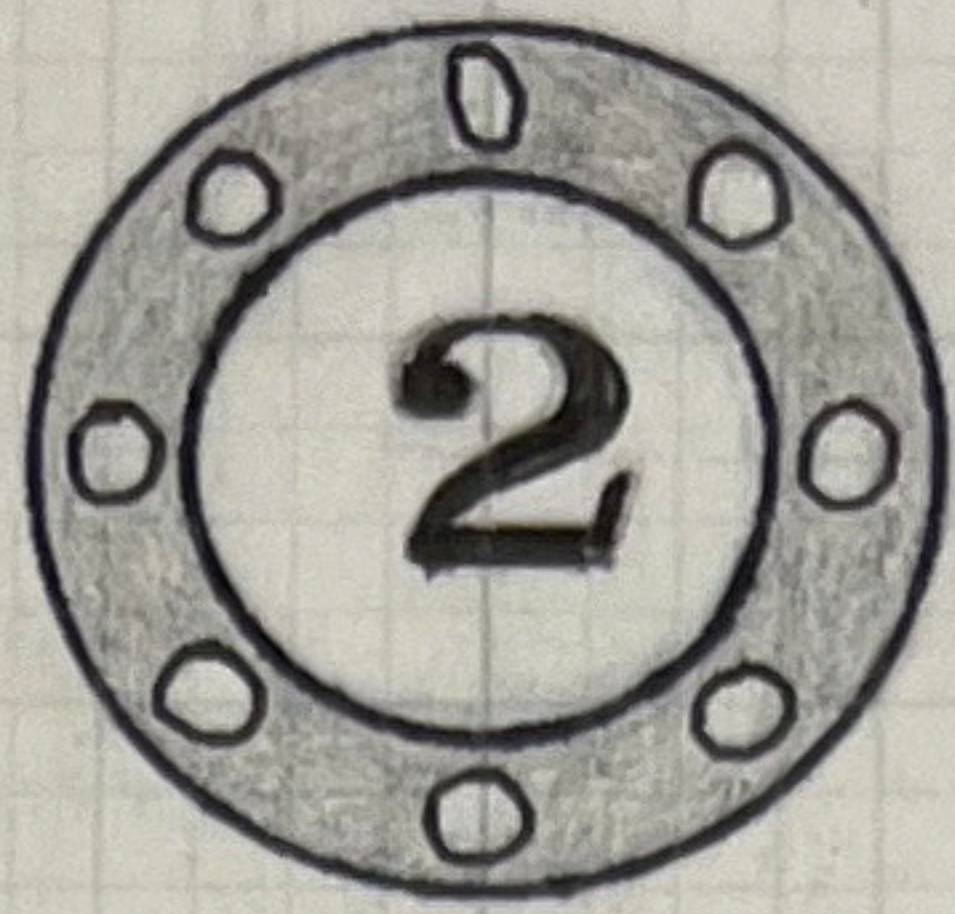


## TOBAGO

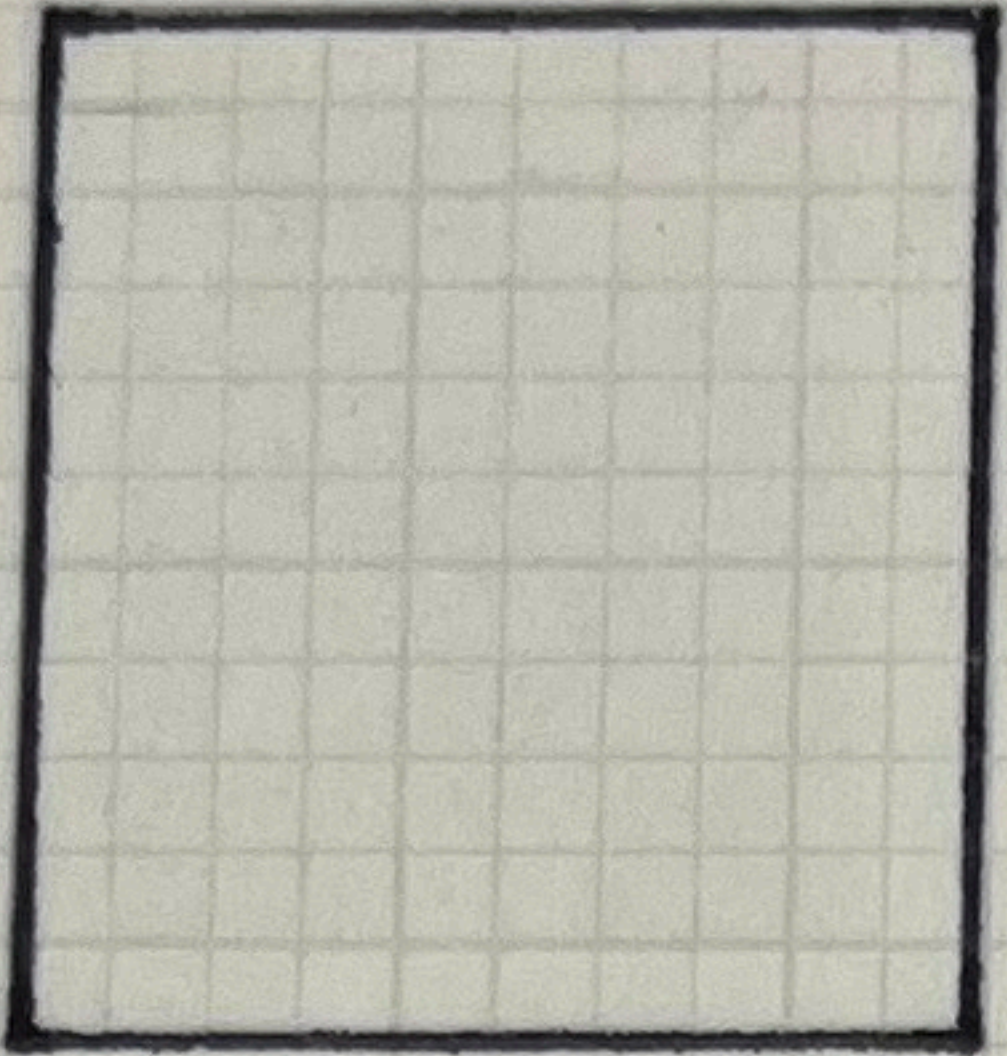
