This first class cover is franked with the 18 cent Surrey coil stamp. The use is nearly ten years after issue. It took at least two stamps to meet the First -class rate. Note the plate number is 3, an early printing. This is a harder number to find on cover, obviously this cover was not mailed by a stamp collector.
