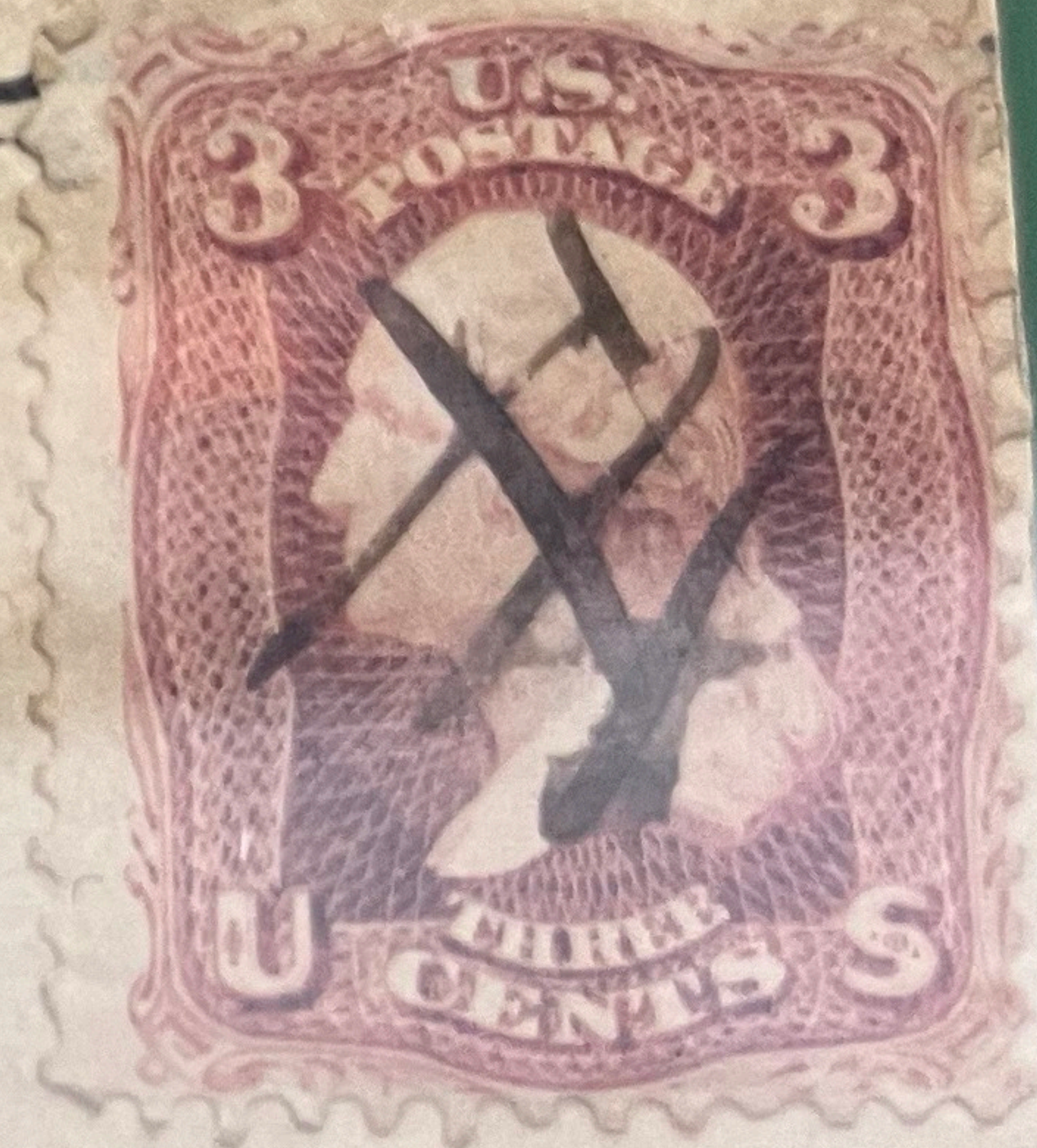
ALL'S FOR THE BEST.
