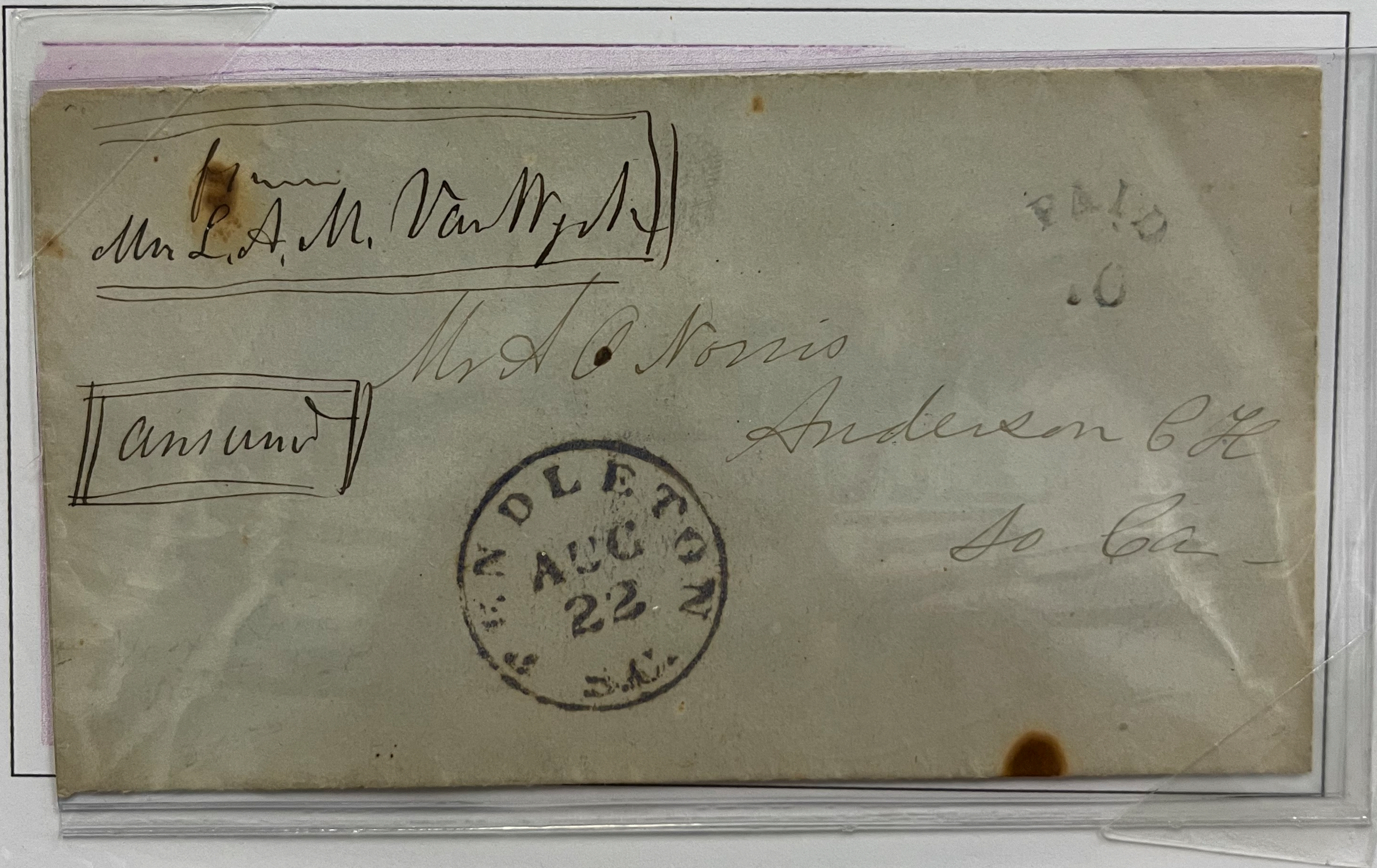

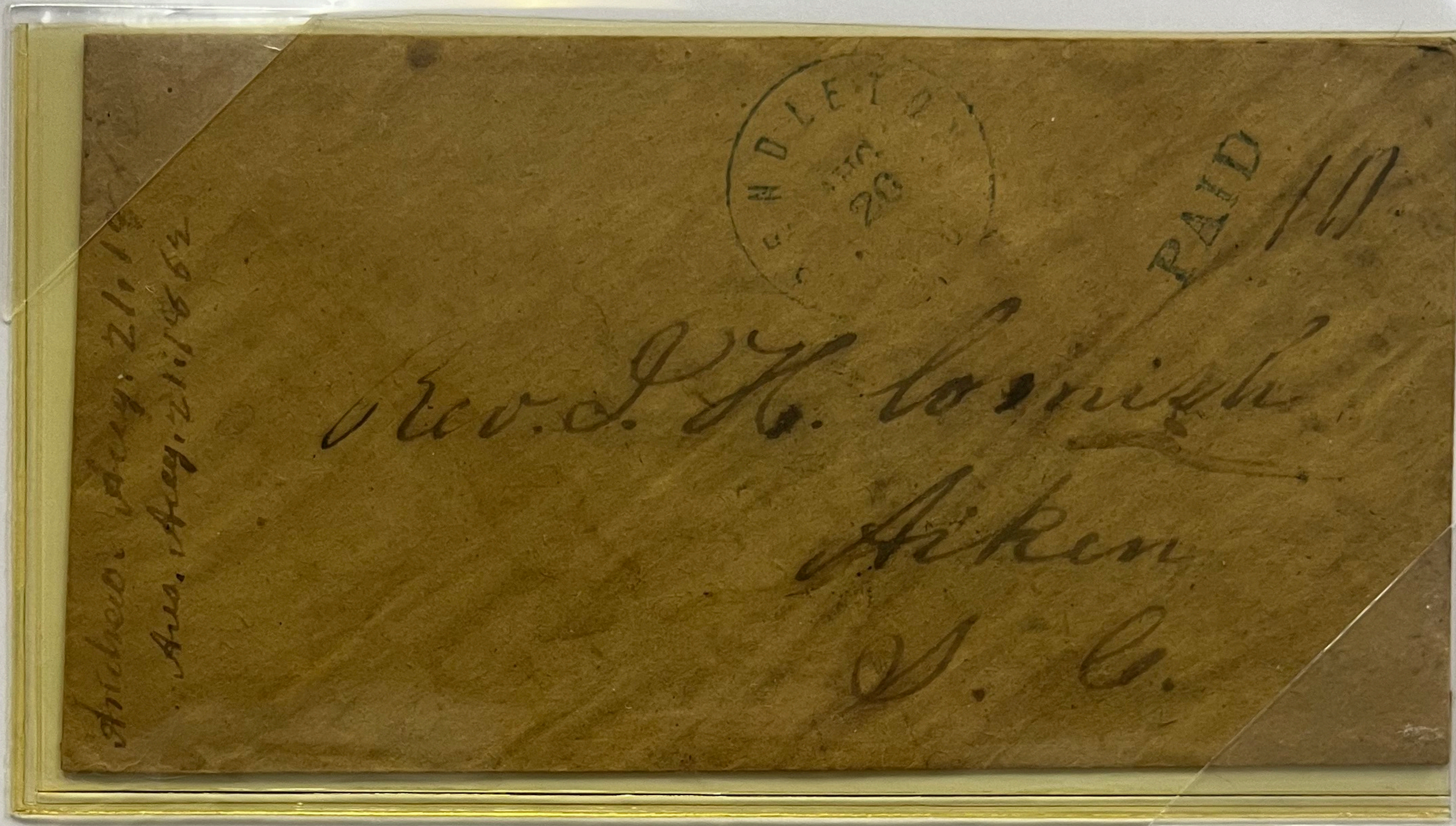

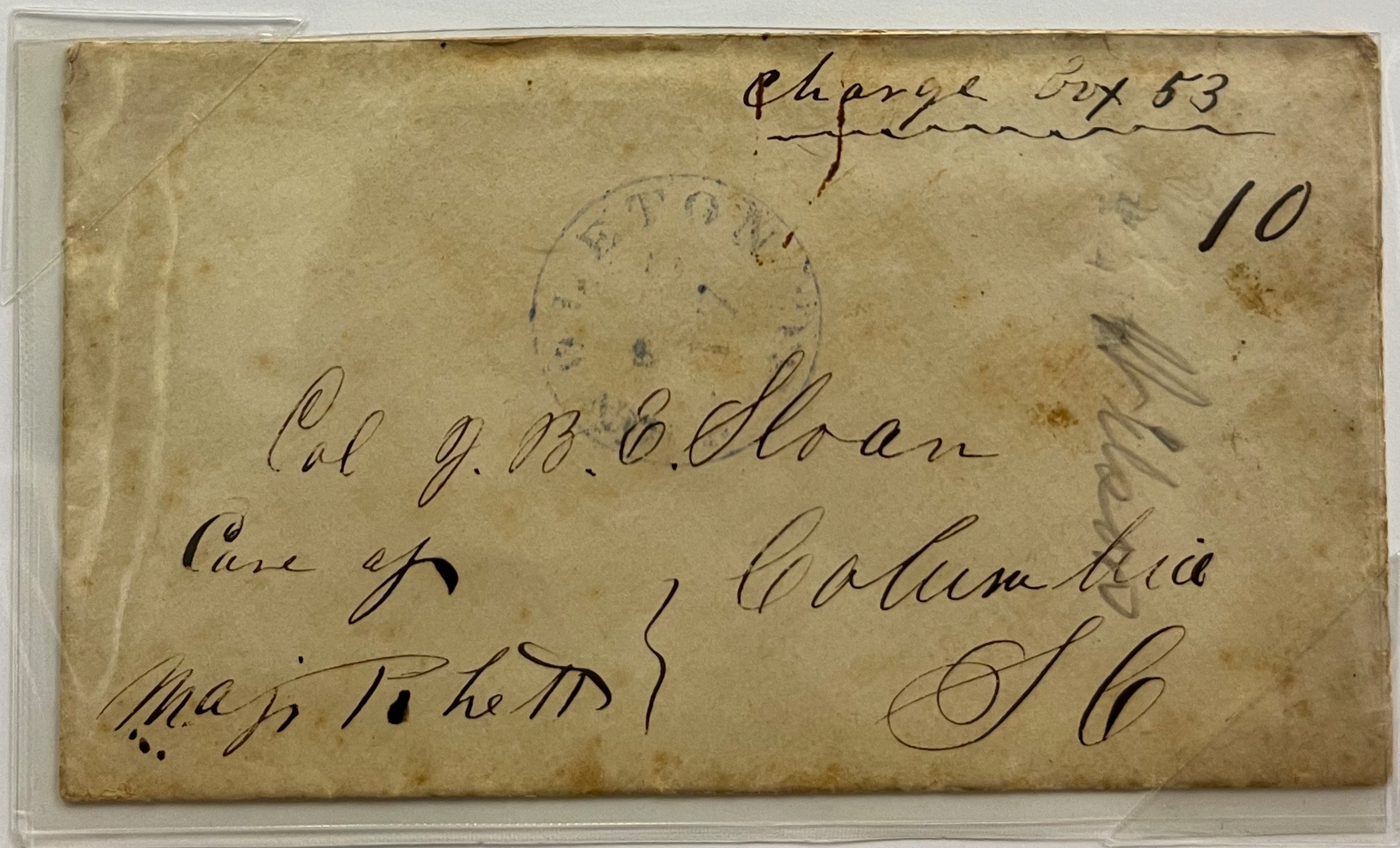

**Benjamin F. Sloan was a Lt in the 1<sup>st</sup> (Orr's) SC Rifles and later served in Greggs, then McGowan's Brigade, A. P. Hill's and later Wilcox's Division, under Stonewall Jackson and the 3<sup>rd</sup> Corp ANV. He mustered in in July 1861 for 3 years. In Feb. 1862 he was relieved of duty with the Reg't and ordered by the Secretary of War to report to Gen. Huger at Norfolk. He was appointed Adjutant of the Reg't in July 1861.**
