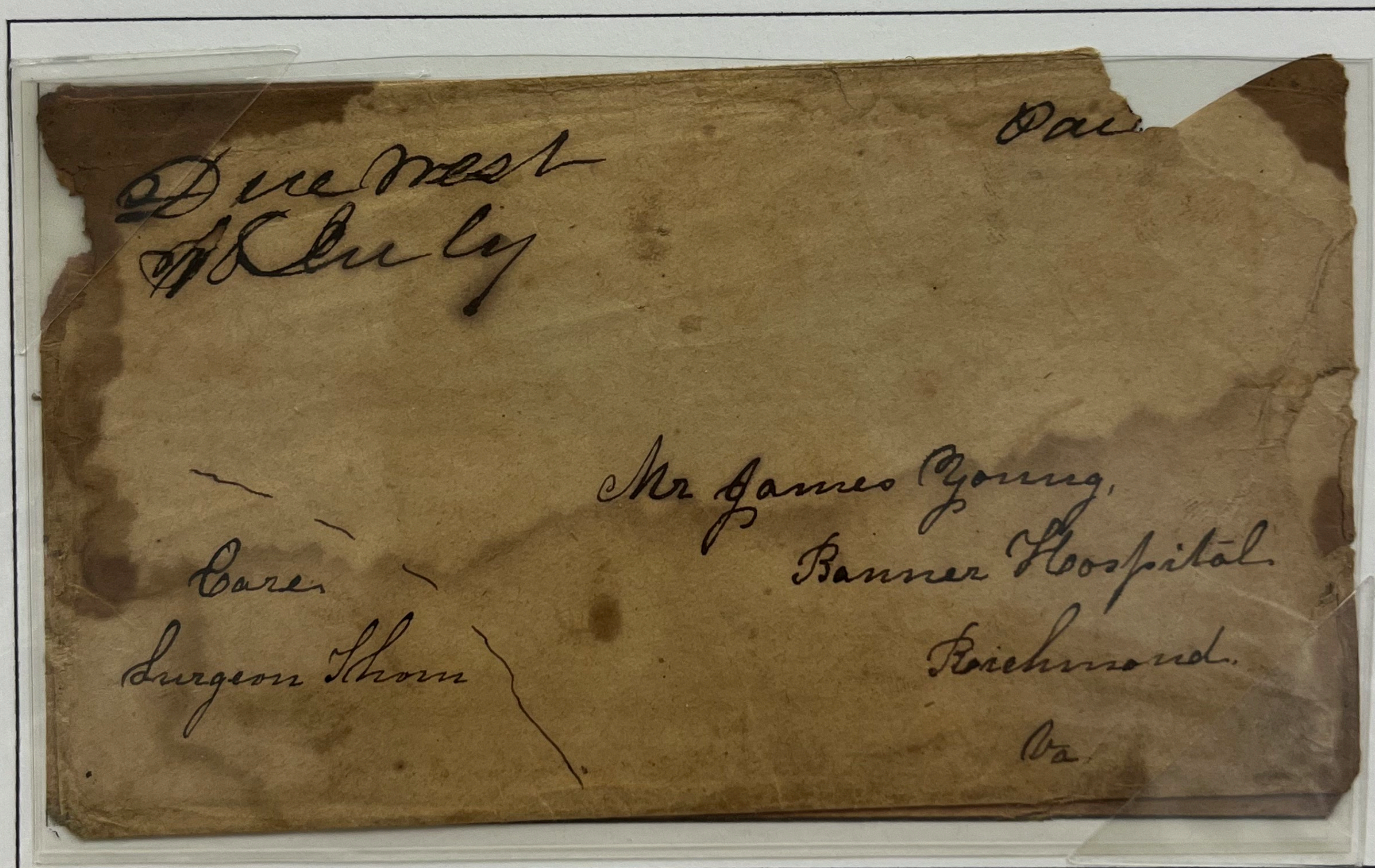

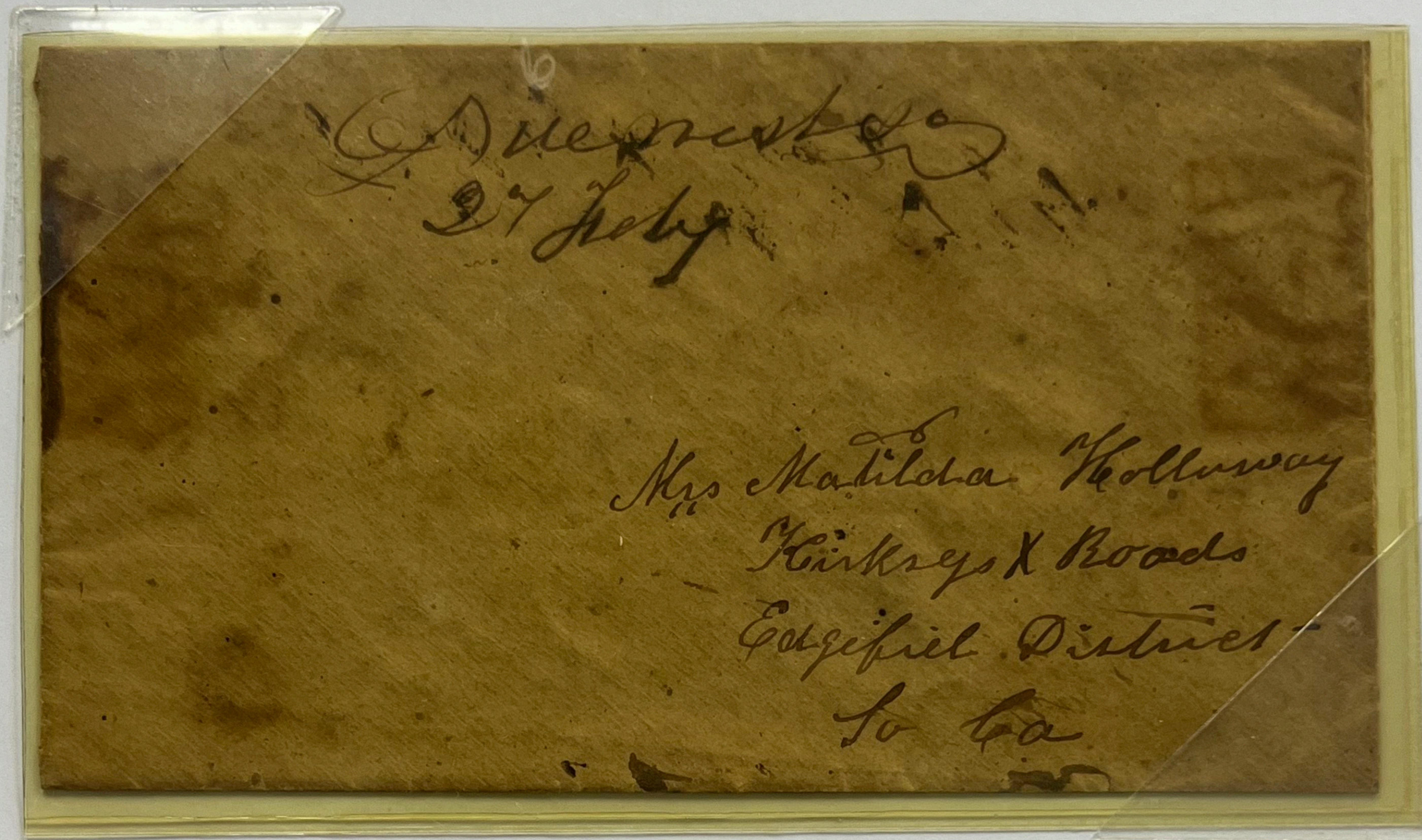
**Manuscript DUE WEST, SC, dated Jul. 18 (no year date), with a manuscript Paid

**James A. Young enlisted in August 1861. He served as a nurse, was wounded in July  
1864 and continued to serve as a nurse in hospitals in Richmond, Va. until captured  
in 1865. He was paroled on June 16, 1865**

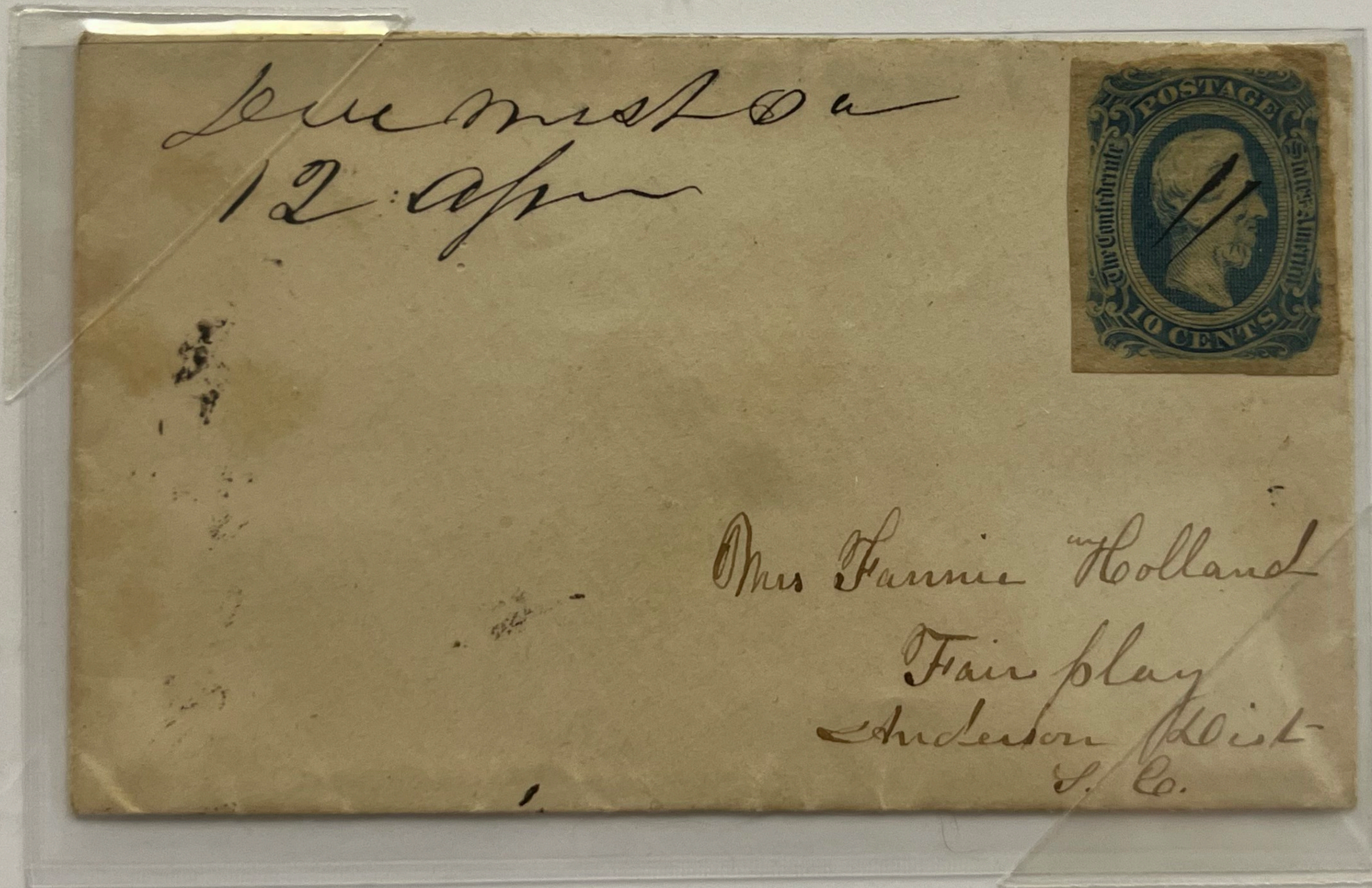
