


Mr. J. E. Hagood,

Dear sir my property was sold to day & did not sell for the twentieth part of its value The hose (house) sold for \$12.50cts the ballence (balance) of the property sold for \$5.37cts the whole amount of \$17.87cts I did not intend to by (buy) any thing that sold for its value nor half its value I suppose Mr Stribling will write to you today Mr Stibling was the auctioneer & Jesse was the bidder I want you to be shure (sure) and arrange matters immediately so that they can't pitch in on me any more You must take A Matgage (Mortgage) on them and make them safe or they will be on me again in less than A weeks time we are painting your buggy, will finish next week I think I will be there soon if I come I will bring it to you if it is necessary for me to be in Pickens let me know & I will come that is about arrangements to secure the property to you
