

G. T. White was a Private in Company B, 1<sup>st</sup> Reg't SC Artillery. He enlisted for the war on June 22, 1864 at the Camp Of Instruction for Conscripts at Columbia, SC. He was then transferred to Company F in August 1864 at the Camp of Instruction. There were no records found after Dec. 1864.

Thomas W. Radcliffe was a Captain on Company G, 15<sup>th</sup> Reg't SCV. He enlisted on Aug. 5, 1861 at the age of 48. He resigned Nov. 1861 as a LT. and QM in the 15<sup>th</sup> Reg't. He then served as a Lt. and Drill Master. He was appointed Capt. & QM on Nov. 26, 1862 at the Camp of Instruction. He was promoted to major and QM for the Camp of Instruction on Aug. 20 1863. No records were found in 1865.
