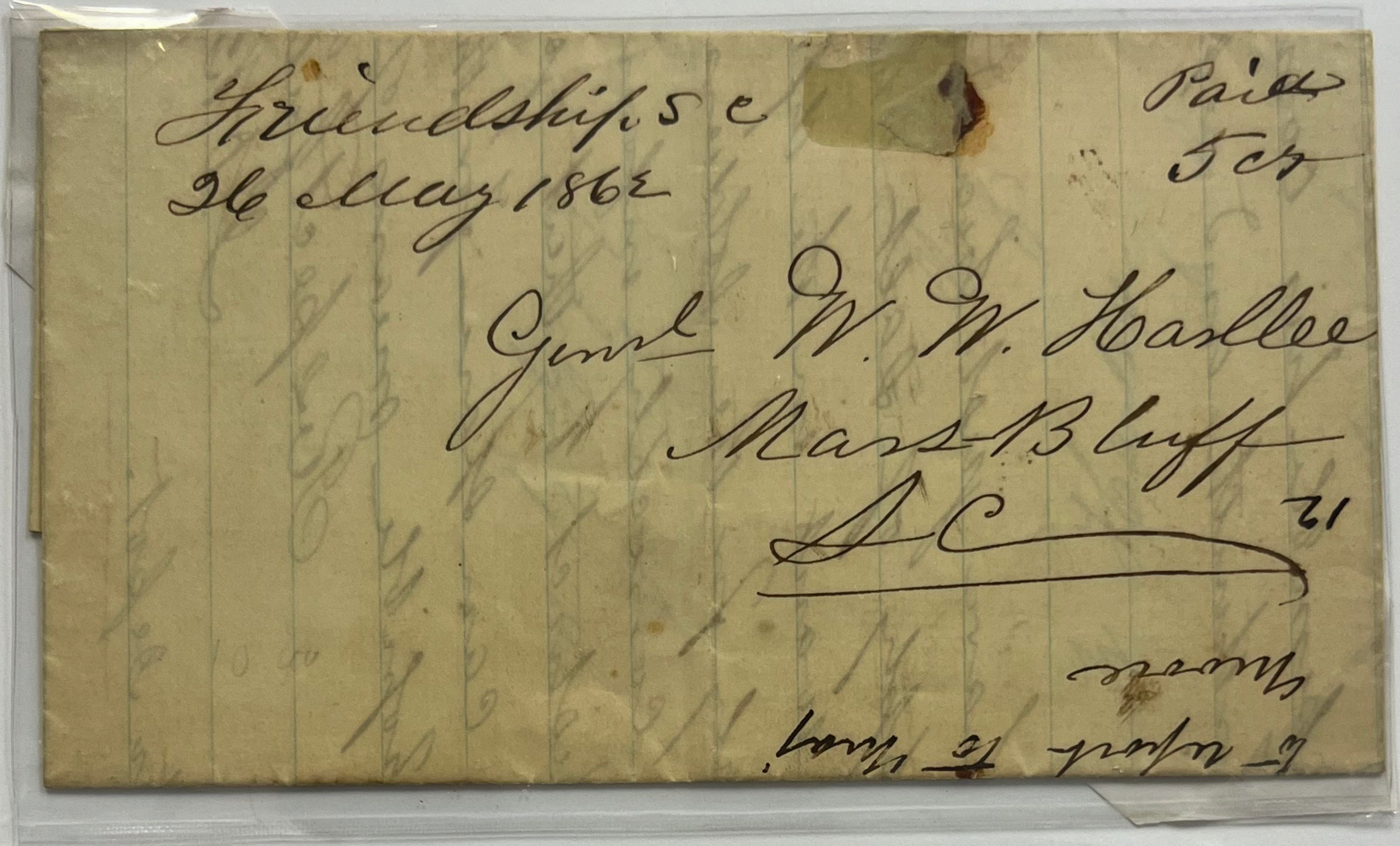


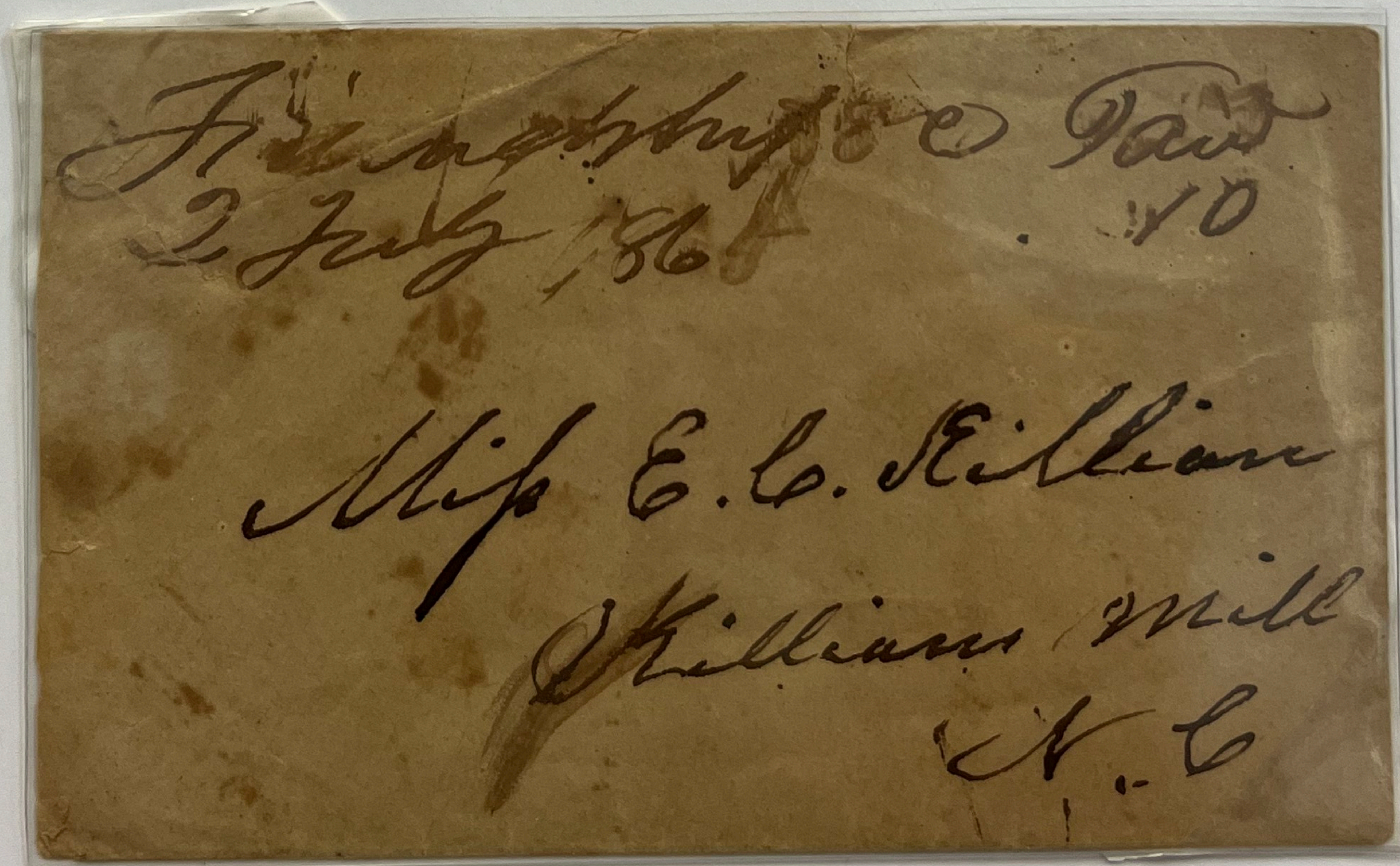

Manuscript FRIENDSHIP SC, 26 May, 1862 (date from military letter enclosed), and manuscript Paid 5ct. Addressed to Genl W. W. Harlee, MARS BLUFF, SC. General William Wallace Harlee was the Head of the SC Militia, signer of the Ordinance of Succession, and SC Lieutenant Governor in 1860-62. FRIENDSHIP is a hard to find town (6).

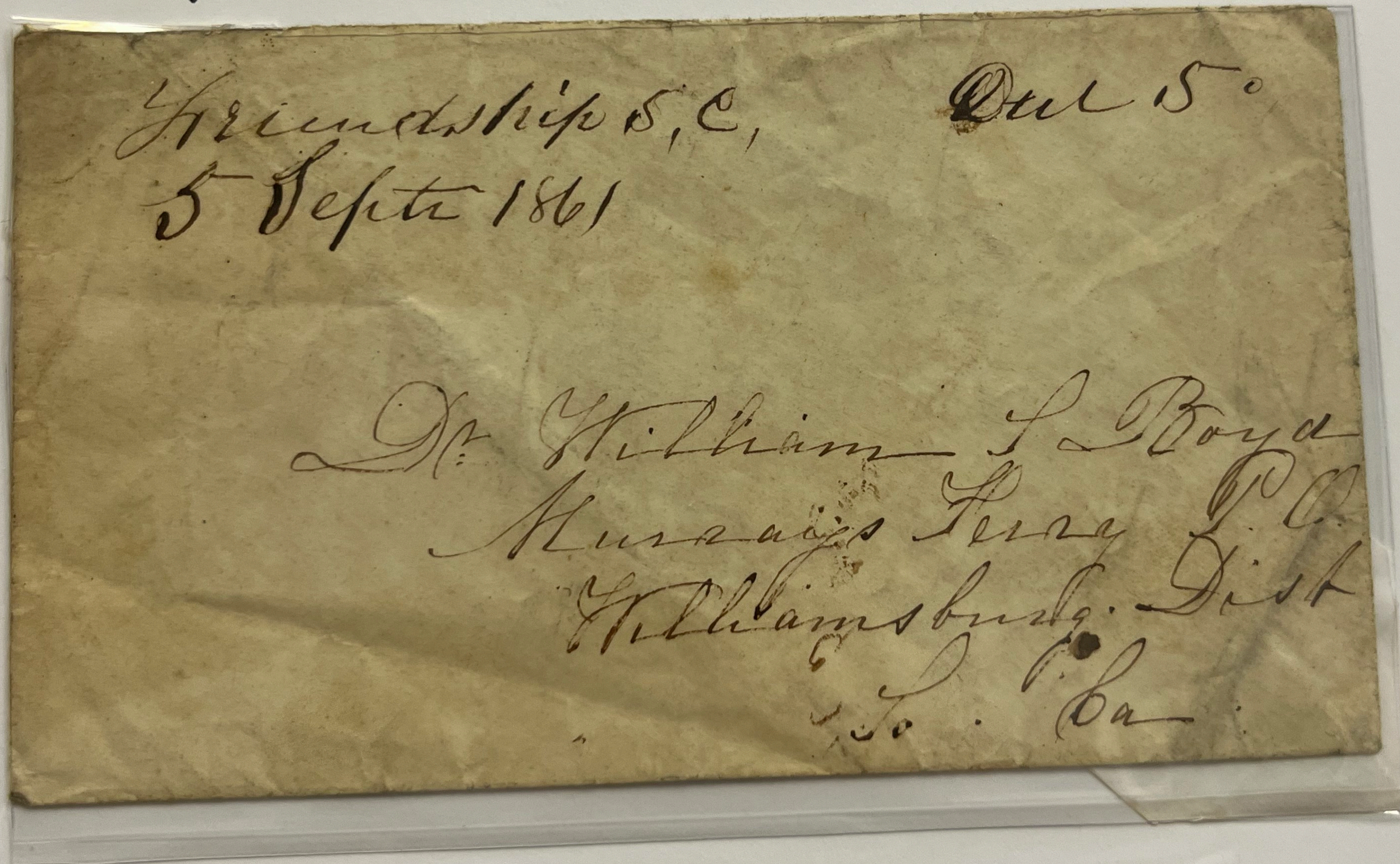
