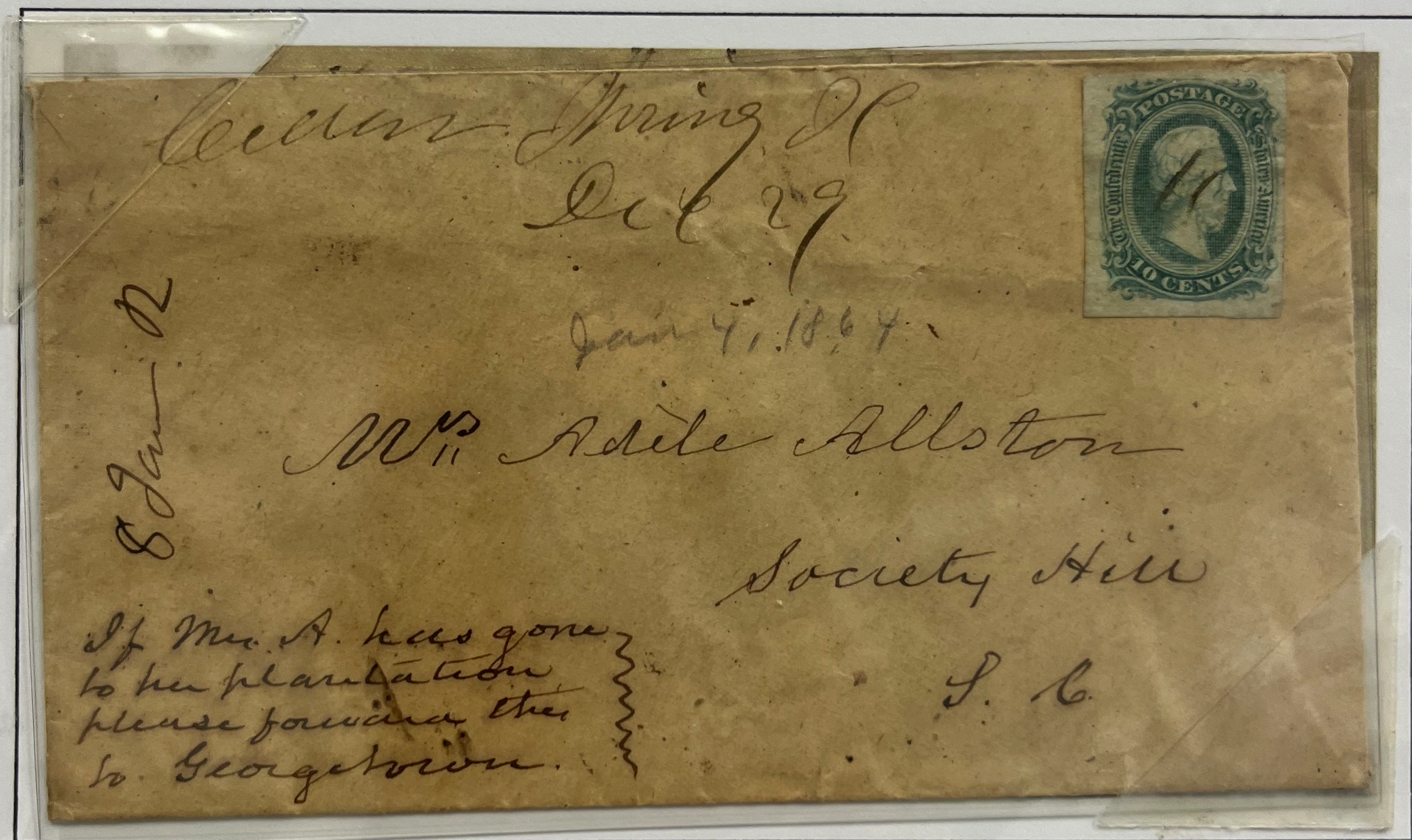

Cedar Springs, Spartanburg District, SC to Society Hill, Darlington District, SC



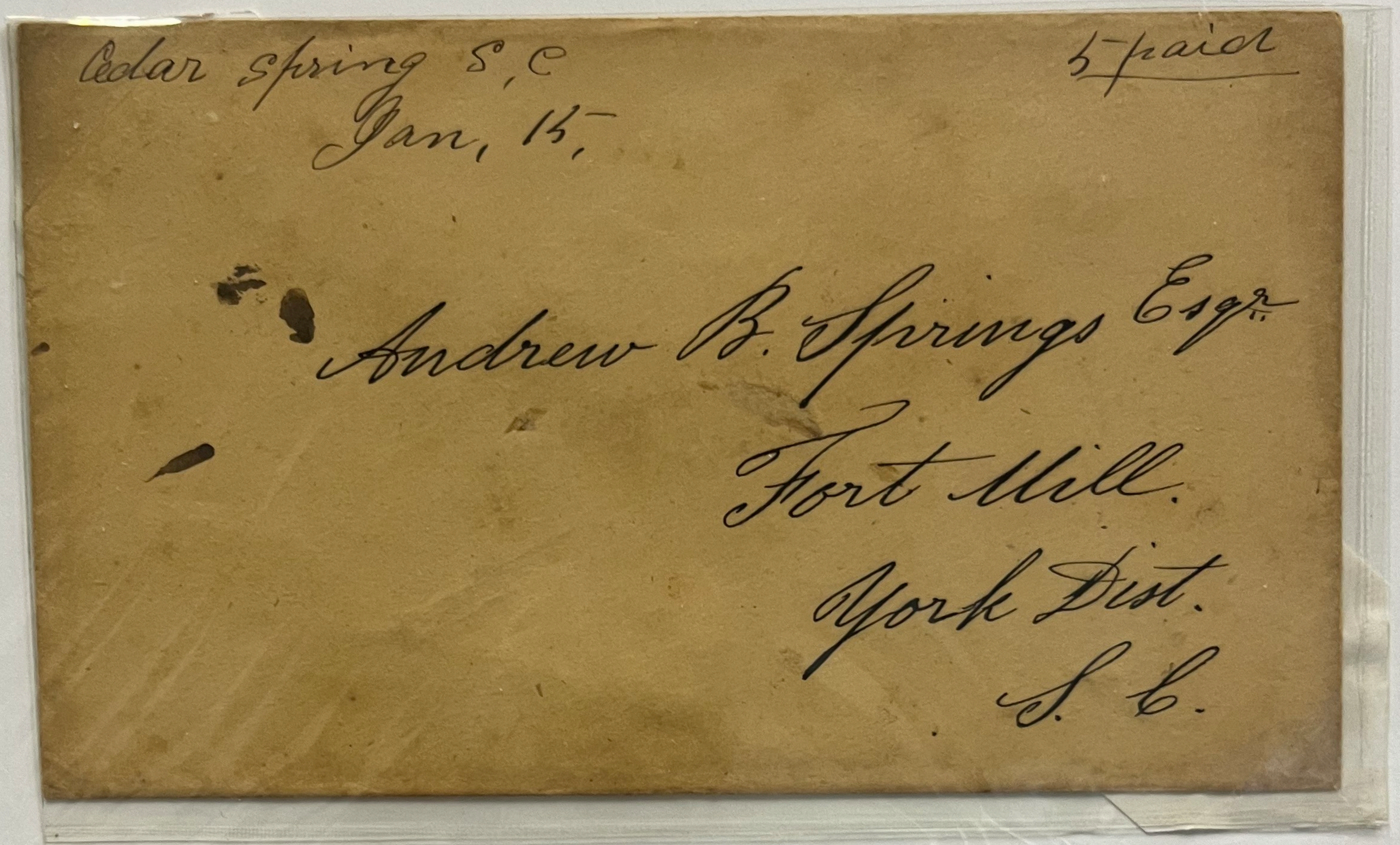

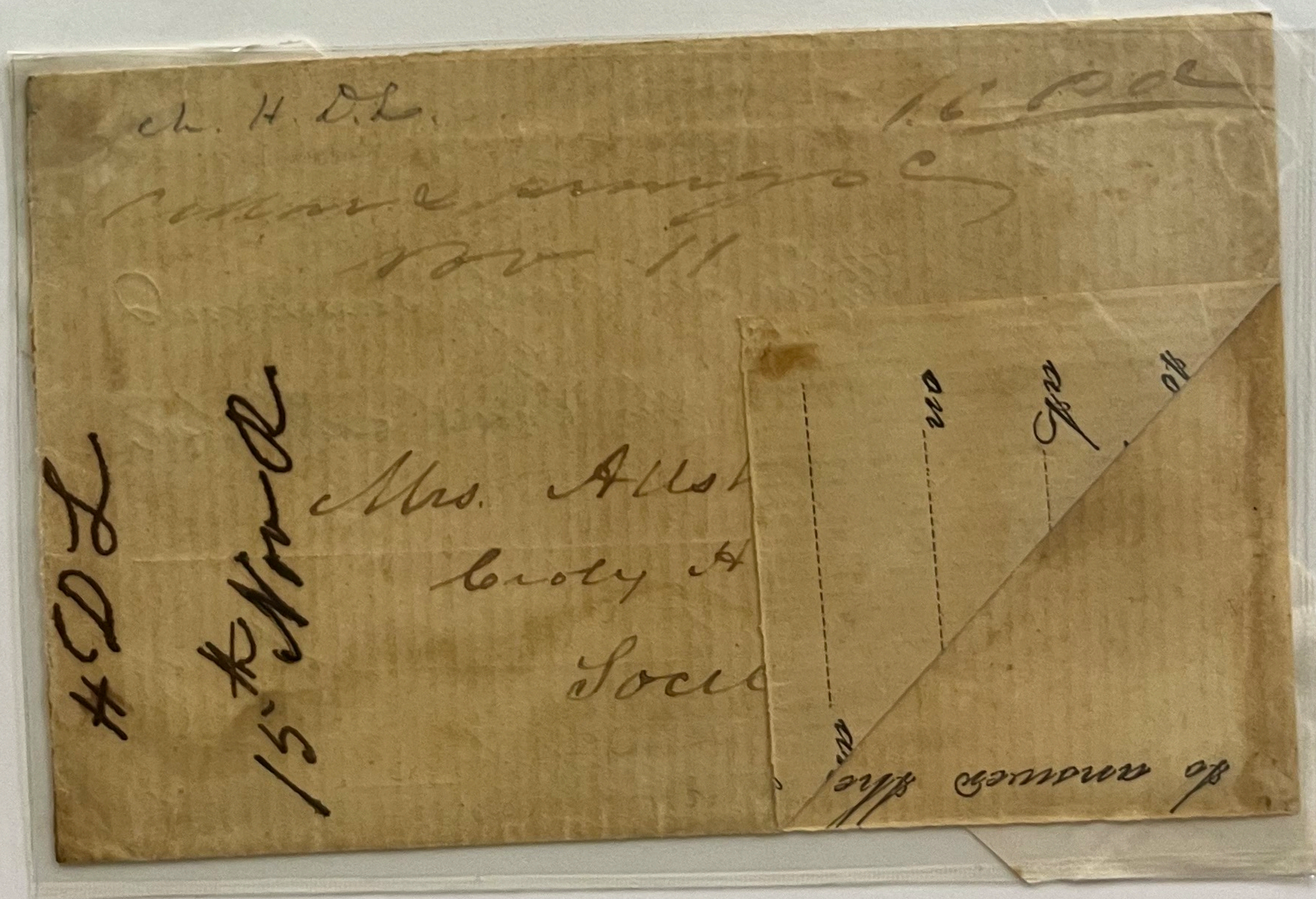
