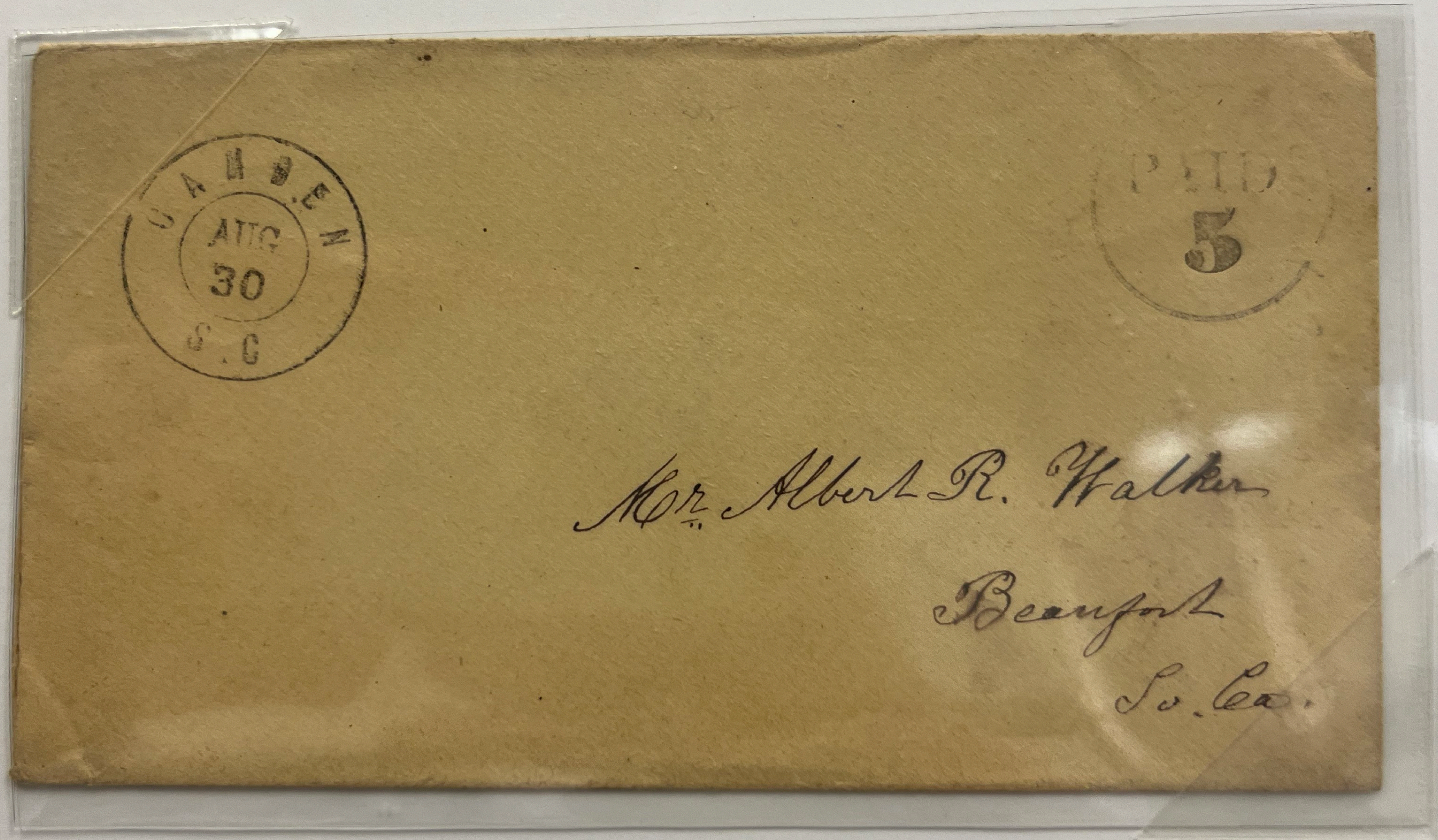

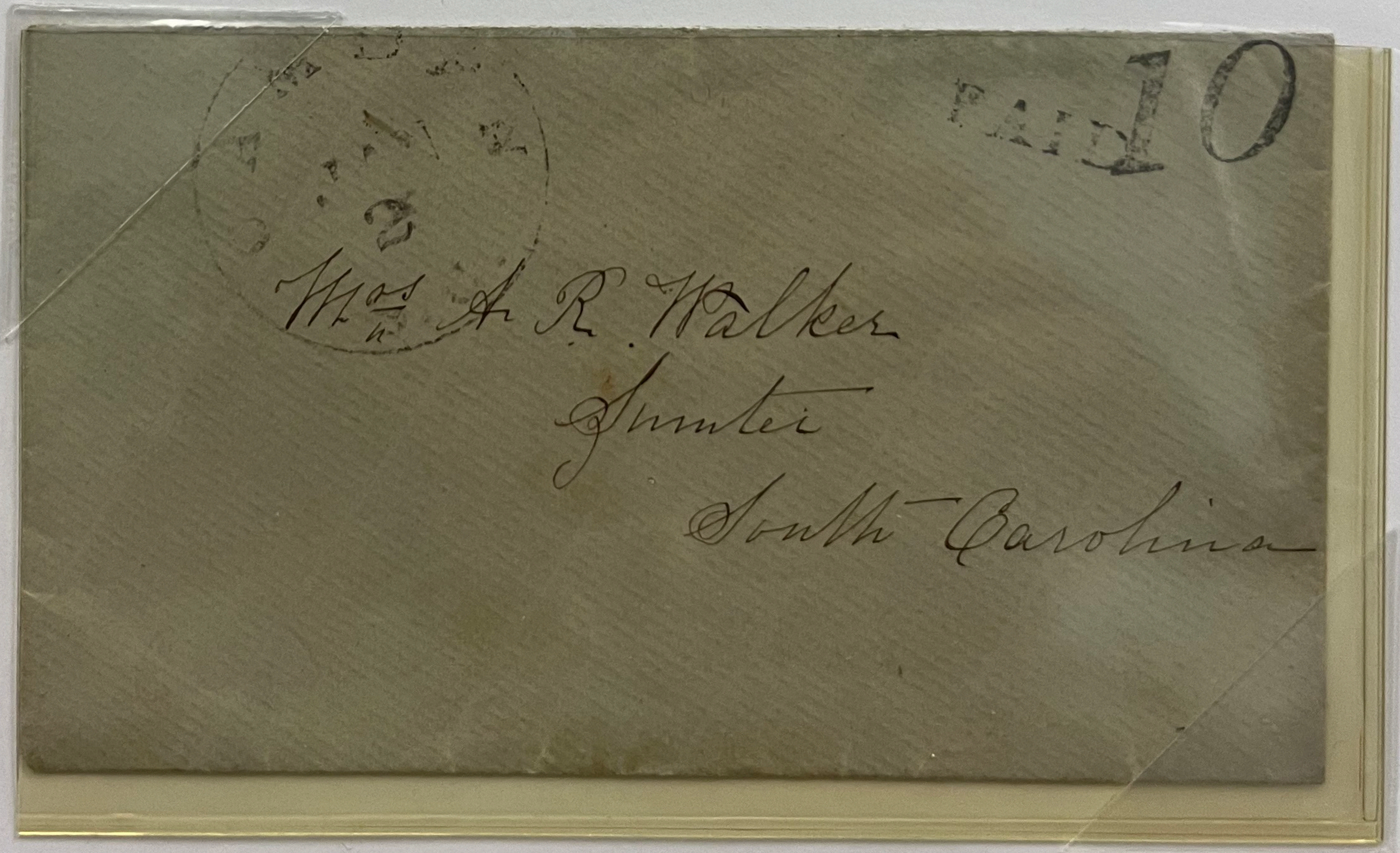

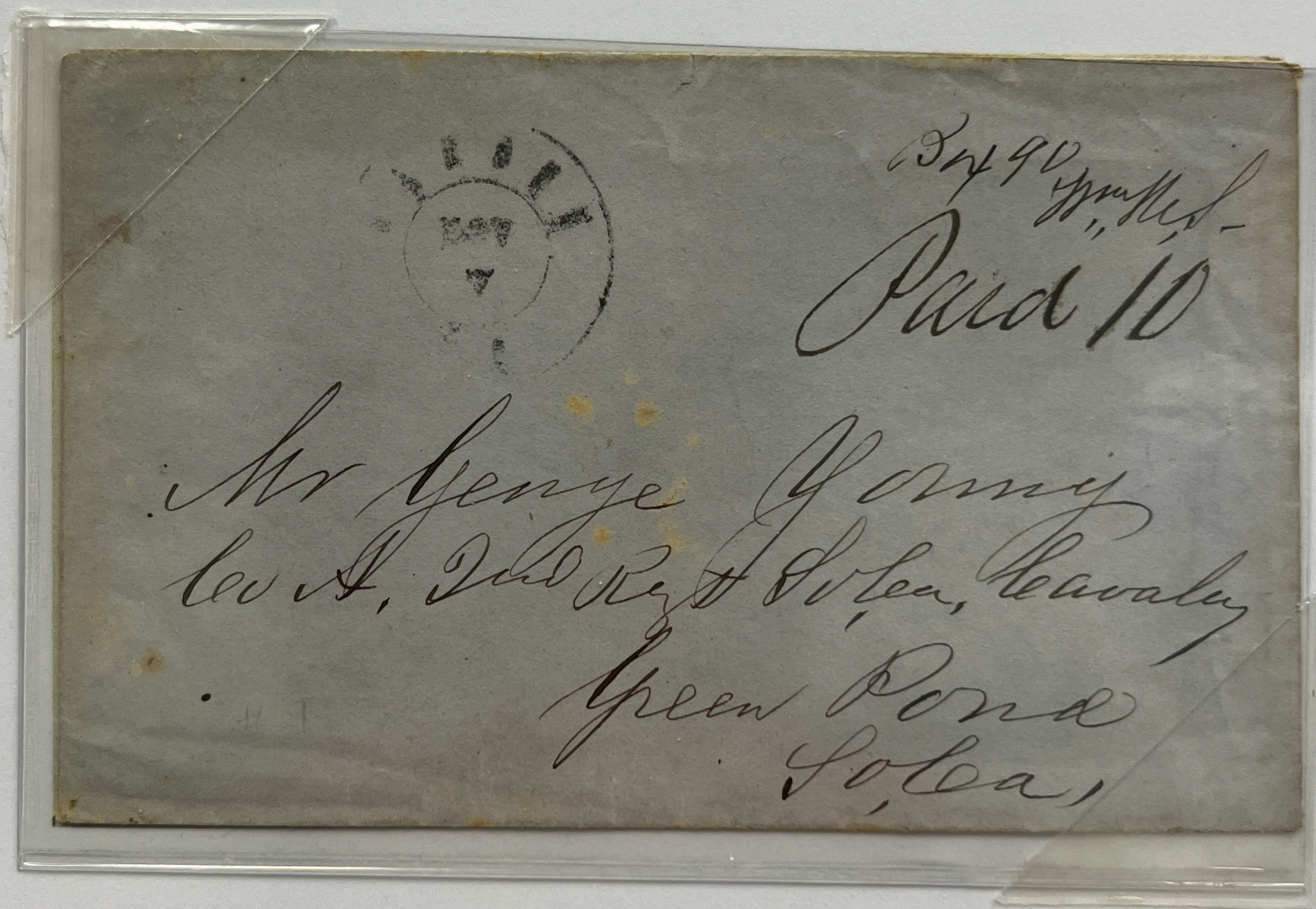

Stampless cover with a 26mm black DC CAMDEN CDS, dated Nov. 7, (docketed 1864). Manuscript Paid 10. Manuscript notation "Box 40 Wm. McS". Addressed to a soldier, Mr. George Young, Co. A., 2nd Reg't So. Car. Cavalry, GREEN POND, So. Ca. ex-Cantey No. 645

George Young was a Private in Company A (Capt. Boykin's Company), 2nd Reg't SC Cavalry. He enlisted on June 26, 1861 for the duration of the war. He served through most of the war until his capture at Kinston, NC on Feb. 10, 1865. He took the Oath of Allegiance on June 26, 1865 at Newport News.

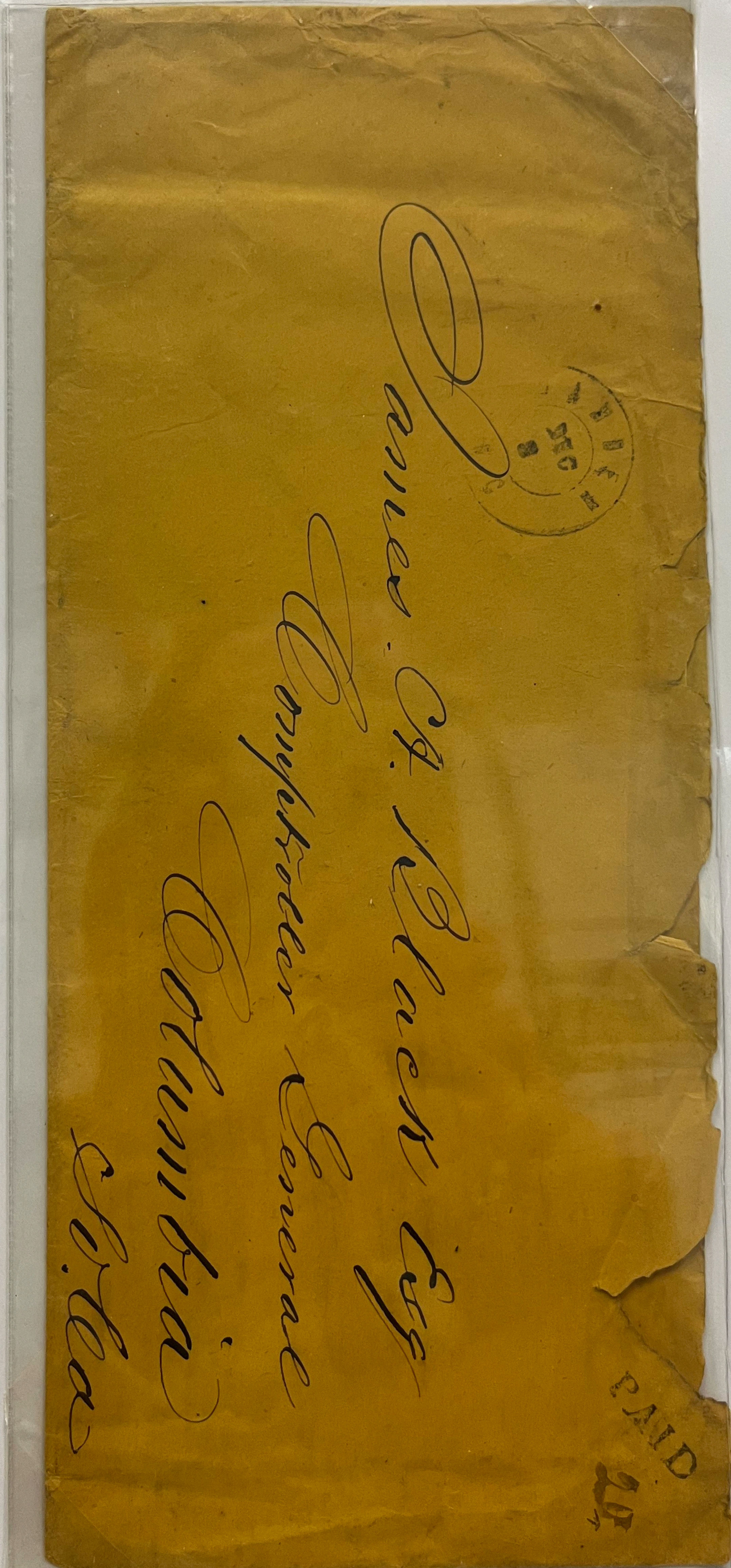
