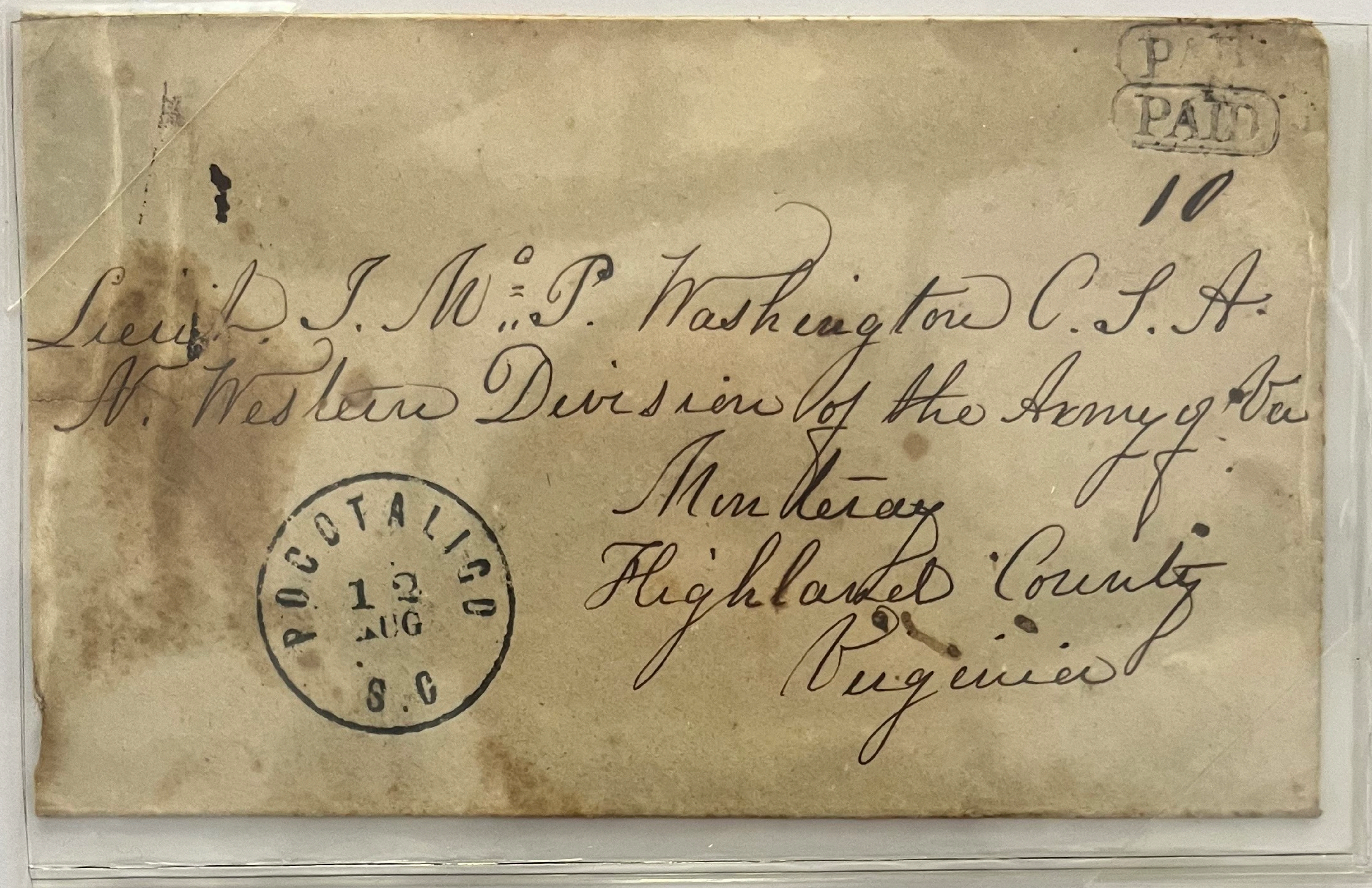


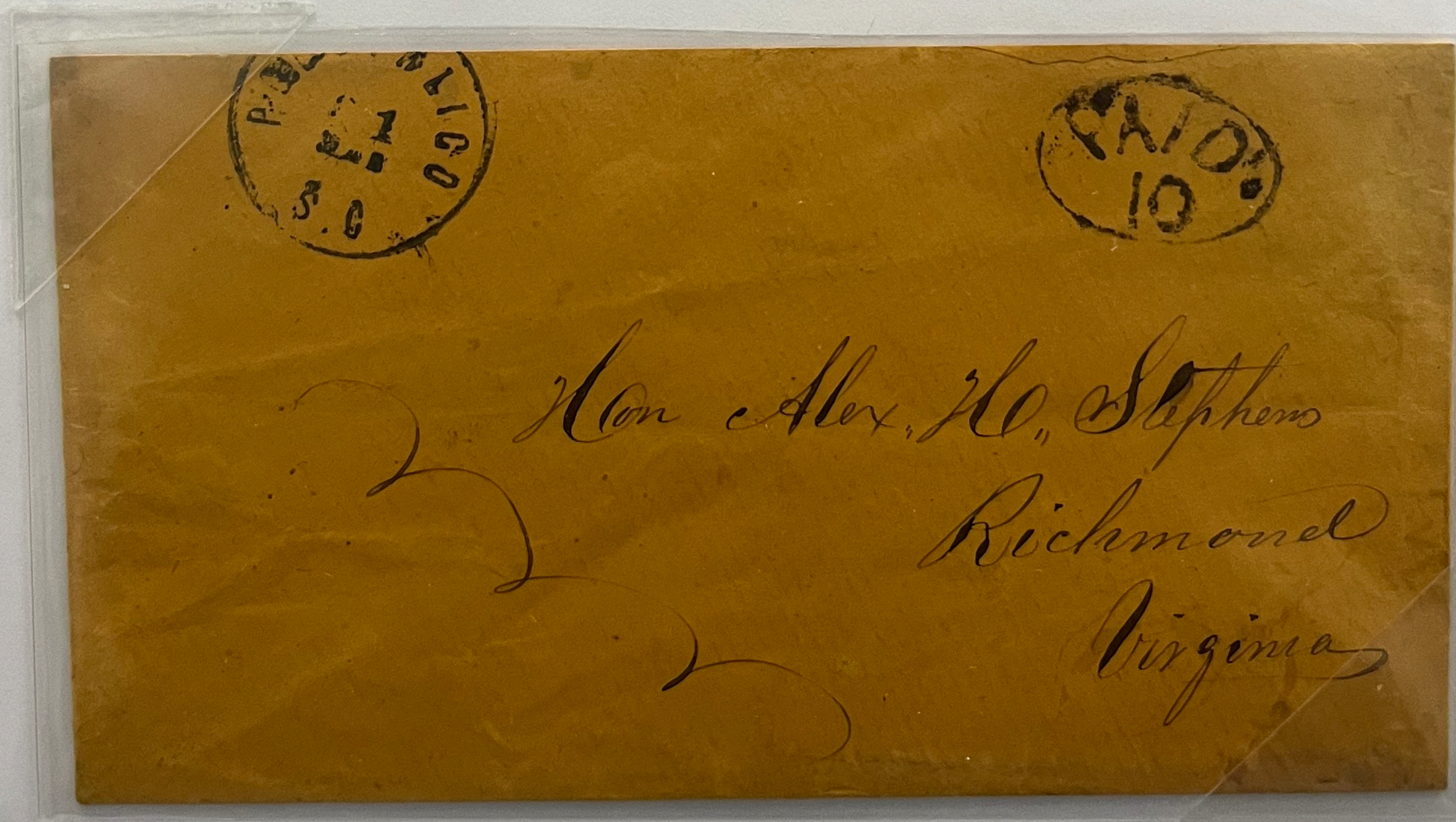

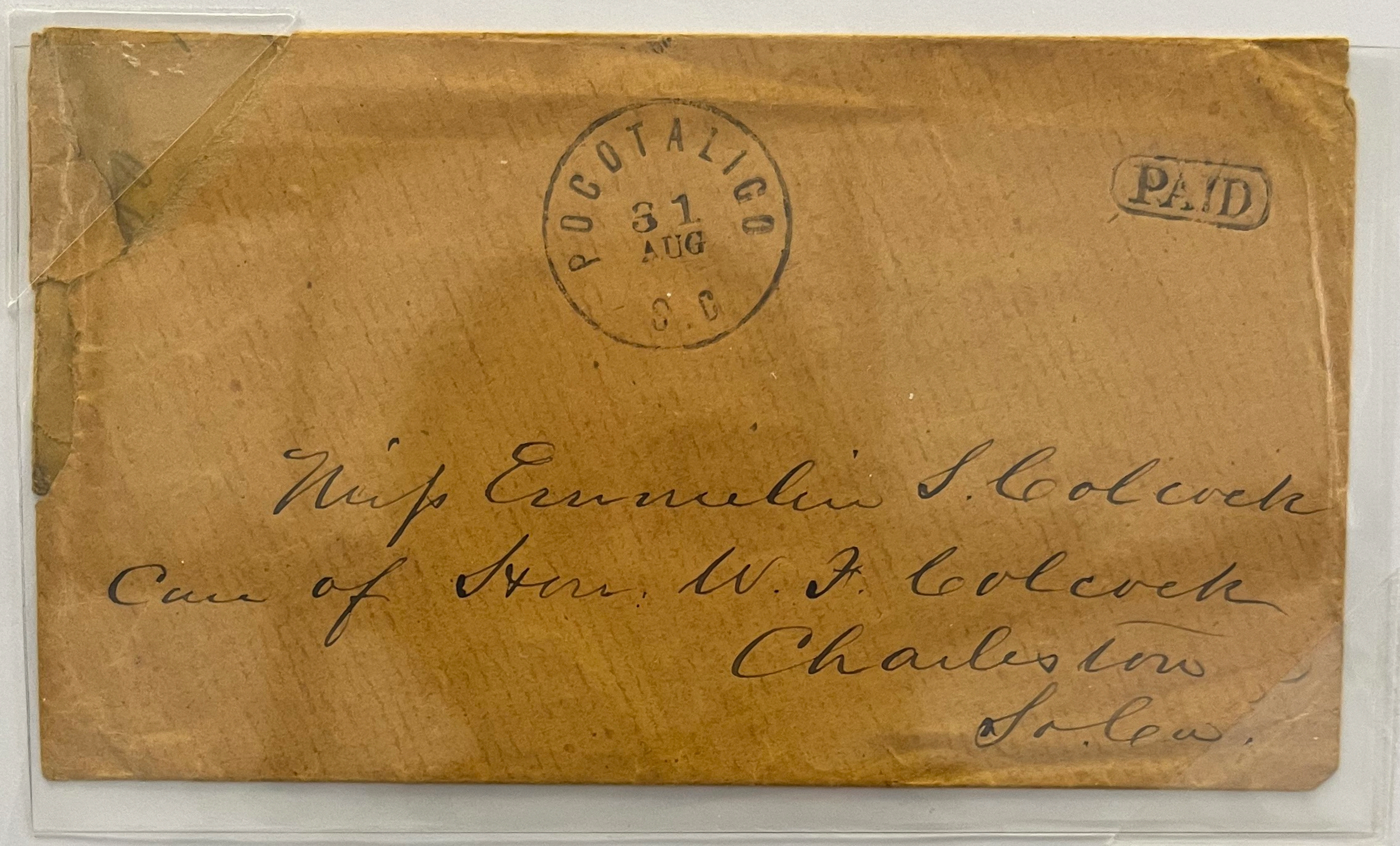

Stephens (VP of the Confederacy), RICHMOND, Virginia. Manuscript notation on rear "Private J. M. Hagerman Company I, 46th Regt GV, Pocotaligo S.C. March 28th 1862. Wants an appointment of some kind wherein he will be relieved from marching, bearing arms, etc ex- Cantey

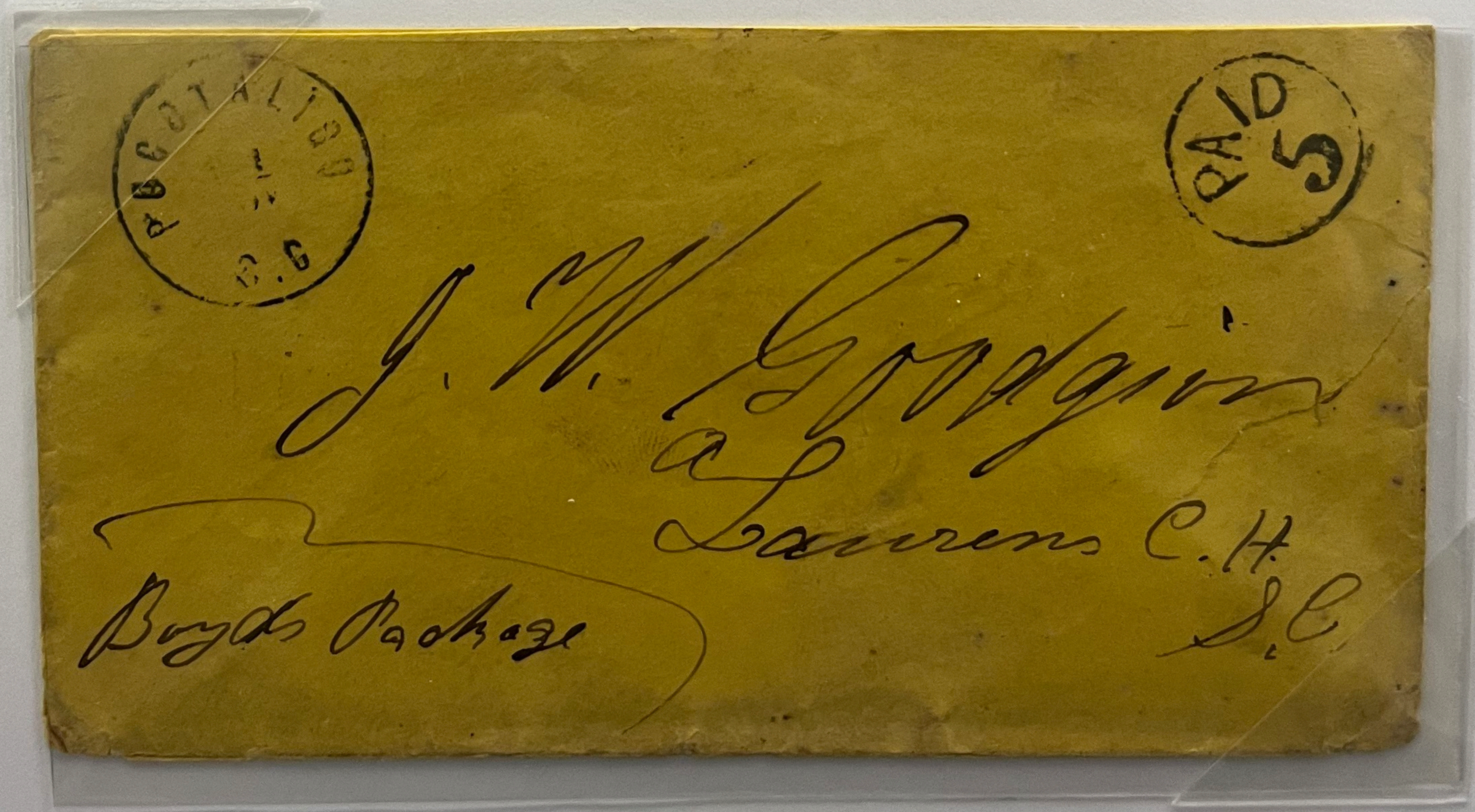

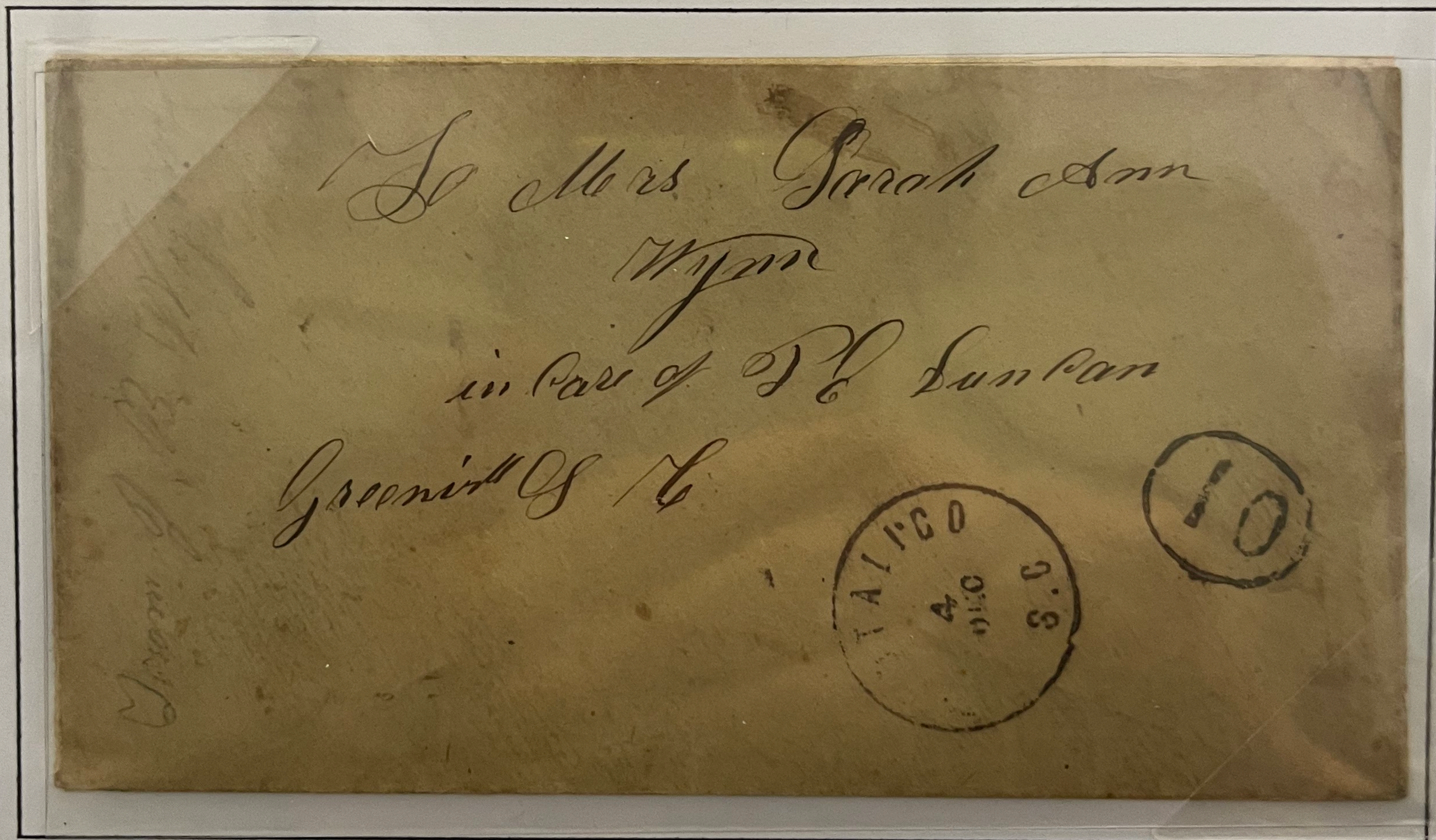

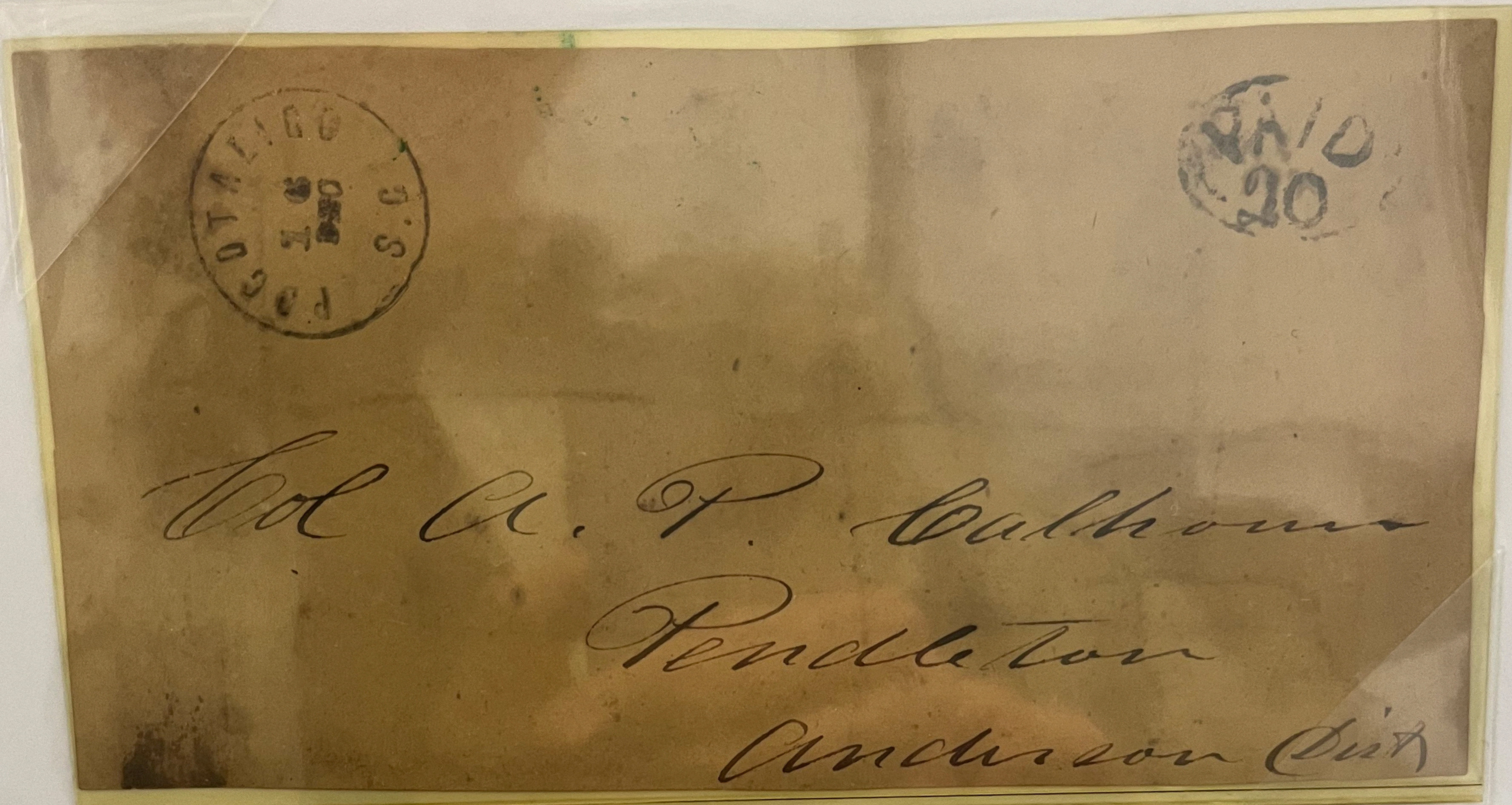

James B. Wynn was in Comp. F, 3rd Reg't 1st SC Reserves. He enlisted in Greenville C. H. in 1862 for 90 days. There are no records after his 90 day enlistment.

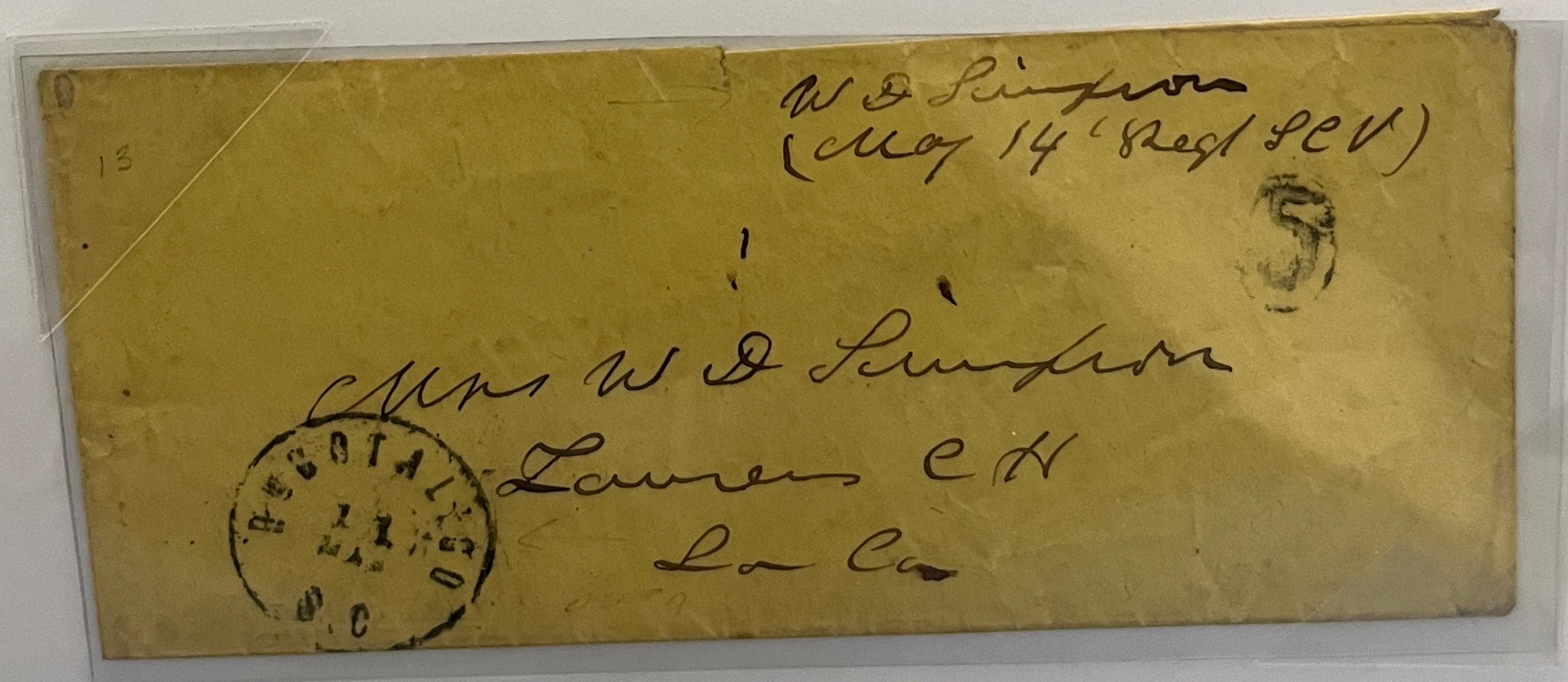

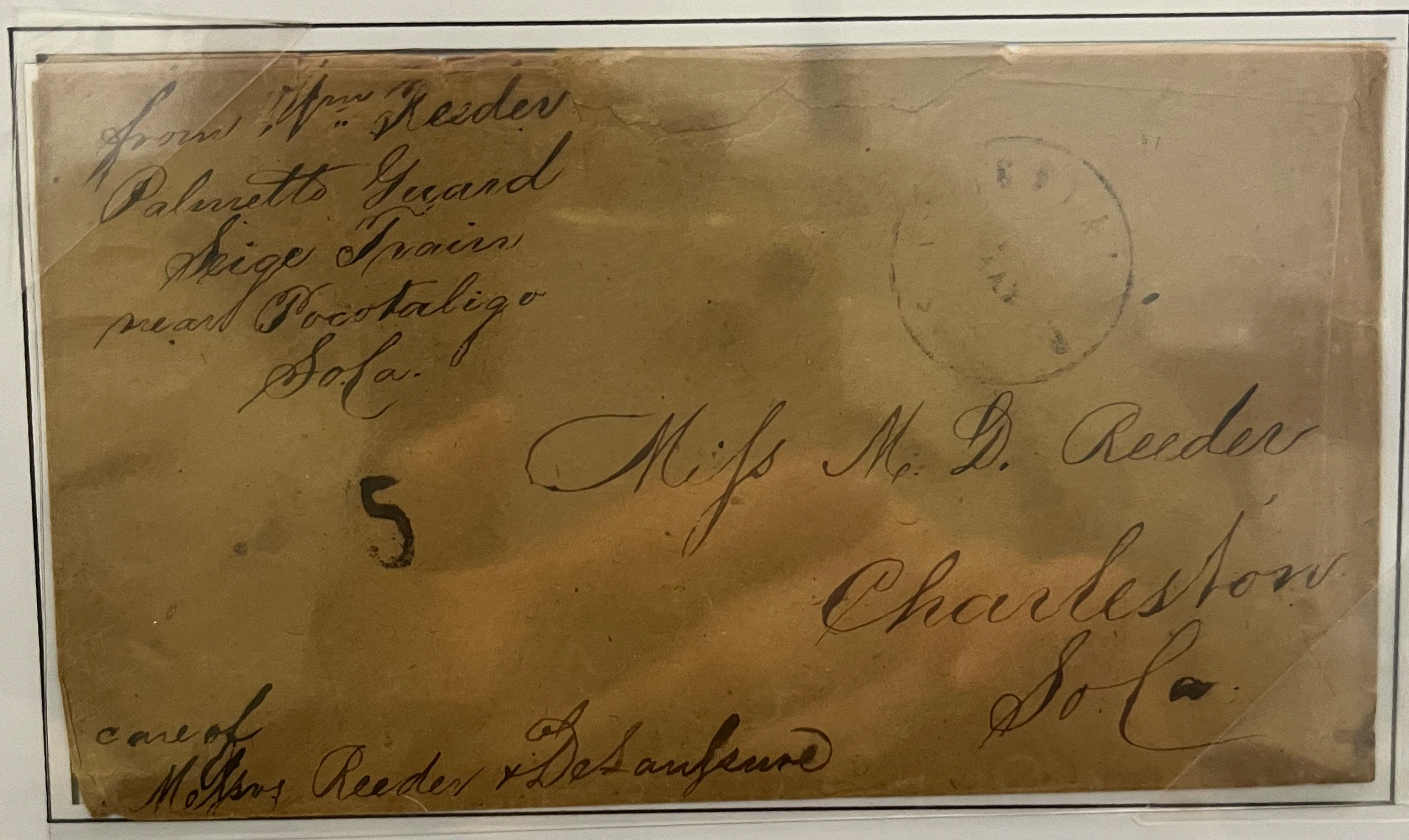

Calhoun, PENDLETON, Anderson Dist, (SC). Cut down envelope docketed Dec. 14, 1863 & newspaper enclosed, thus double weight. ex- Kohn, Cantey



25mm Black POCOTALIGO CDS, dated 11 May. (1862). Handstamp Oval 5, soldier's due from W D Simpson, Maj. 14th Regt SCV. Dietz Type A, New CSA Catalog Type E. Addressed to Mrs. W D Simpson, LAURENS COURT HOUSE, So. Ca. Simpson was a major, member of the CSA Congress, and Gov. of SC in the 1880's. ex- Cantey

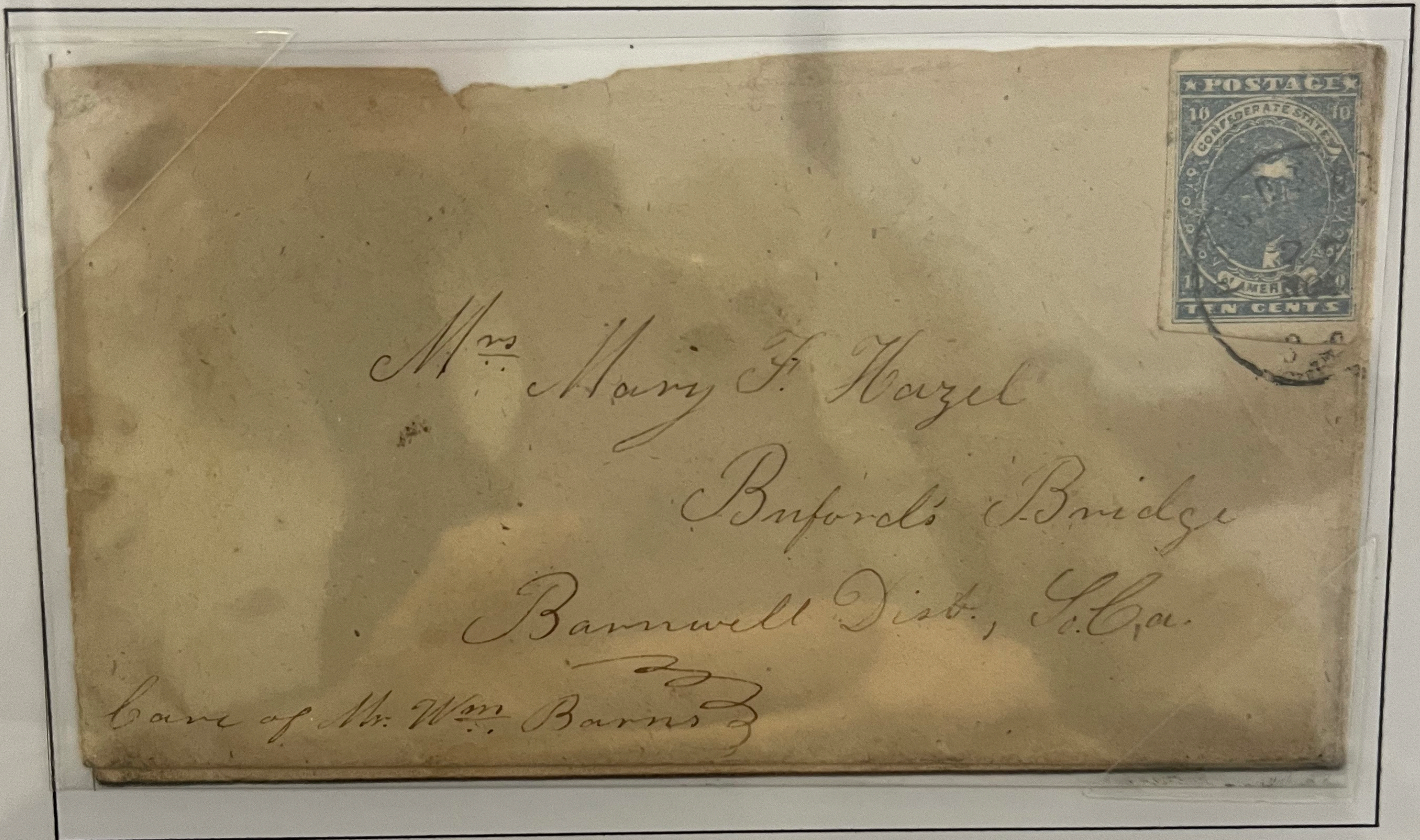


Soldier's due cover with black 25mm POCOTALIGO SC CDS dated MAY 1 (1862). Handstamp "5" (due), Dietz Type A. Cover from Wm Reeder, Palmetto Guard, Siege Train, near Pocotaligo, So. Ca. Addressed to Miss M. D. Reeder, CHARLESTON, So. Ca., care Messrs. Reeder & DeSaussure. No. 182

William Reeder was a Private in Company A, Manigault's Battalion, 17th Reg't SC Militia and then SC Artillery. He enlisted at Pocotaligo at age 18 on Nov. 5, 1861 and mustered in on Feb. 28, 1862. He enlisted for the war. He served throughout the war, was sick in hospital at Cheraw in Feb 1865. After his hospital release, Wm Reeder was killed in action at Sumter, days after Lee's surrender at Appomattox Va.

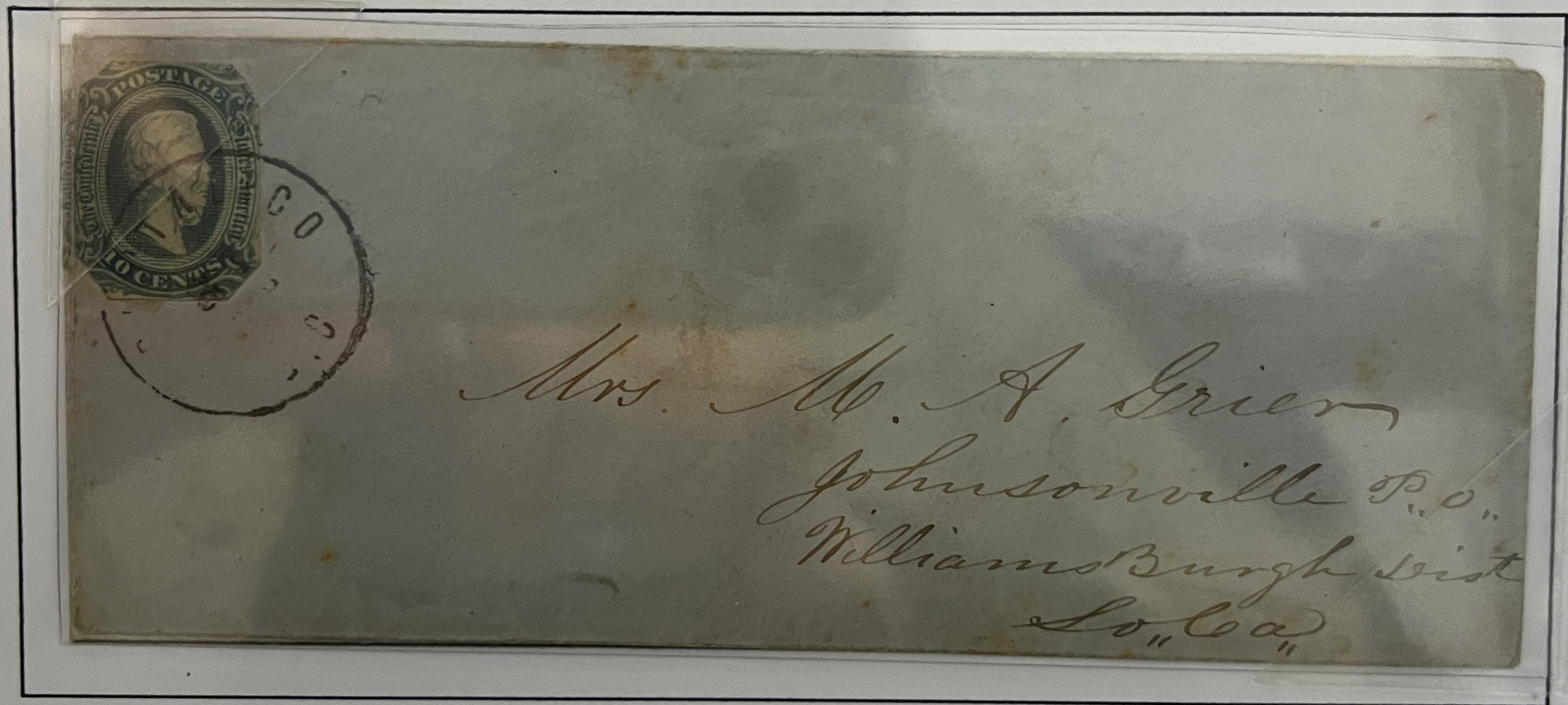

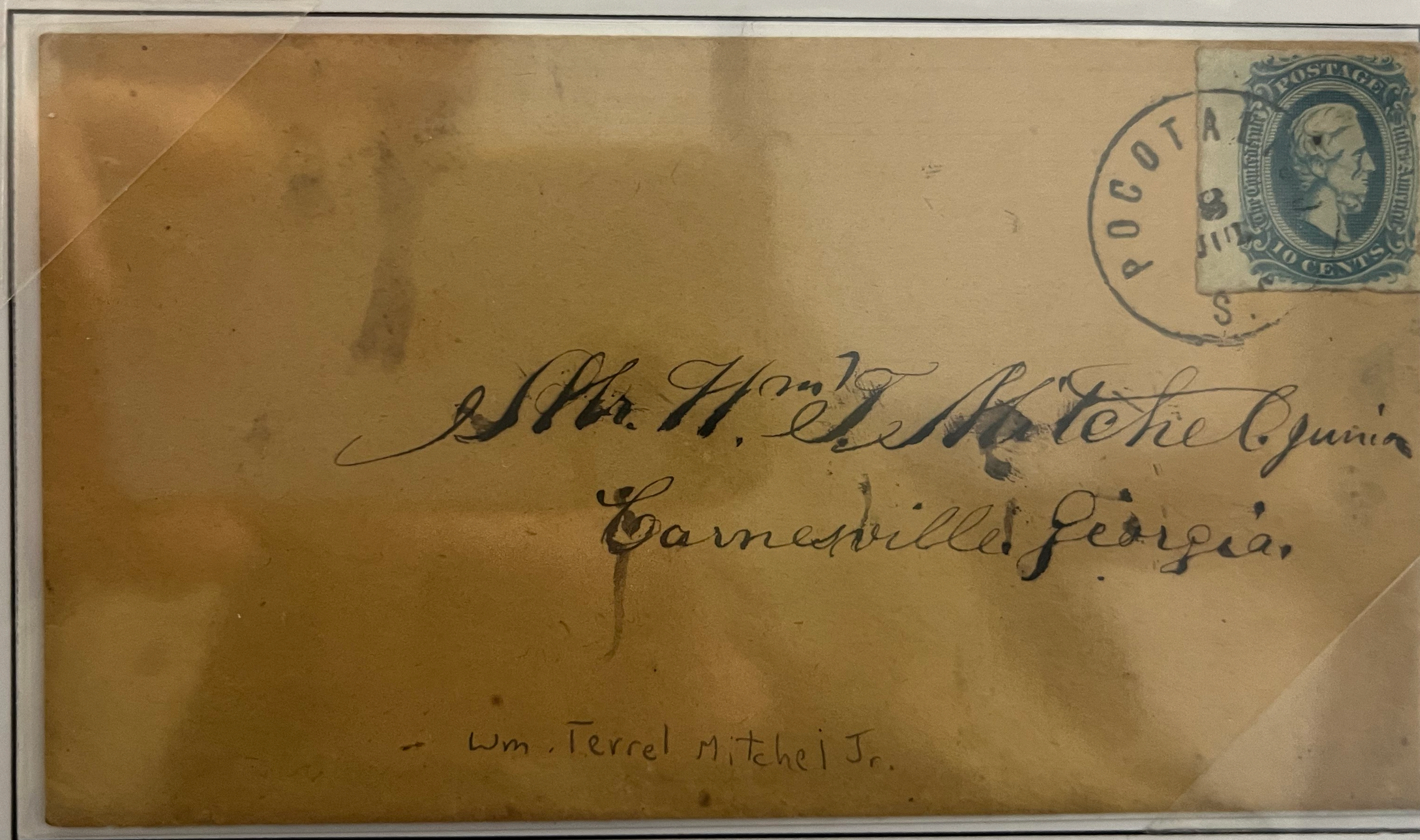
