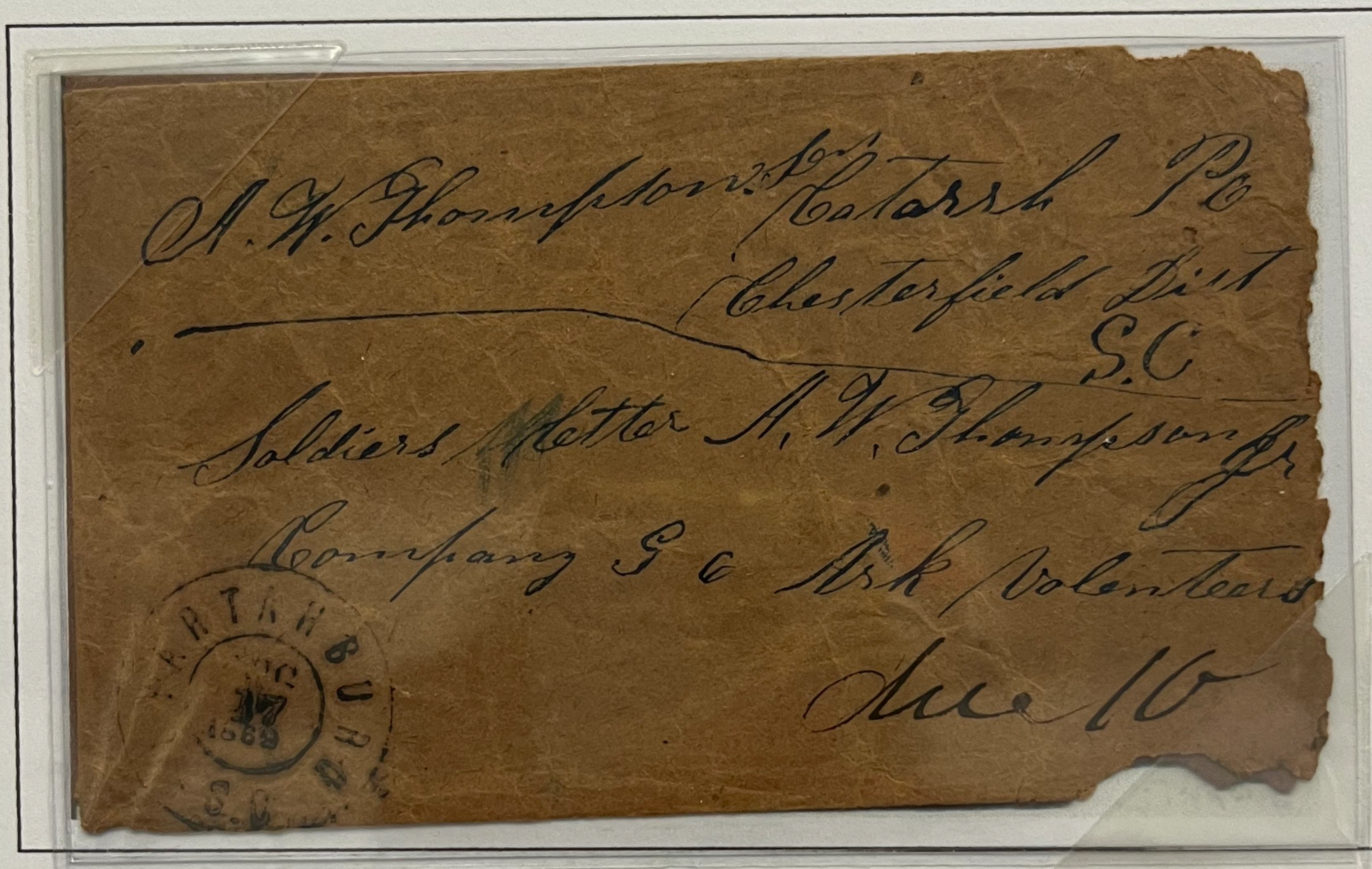

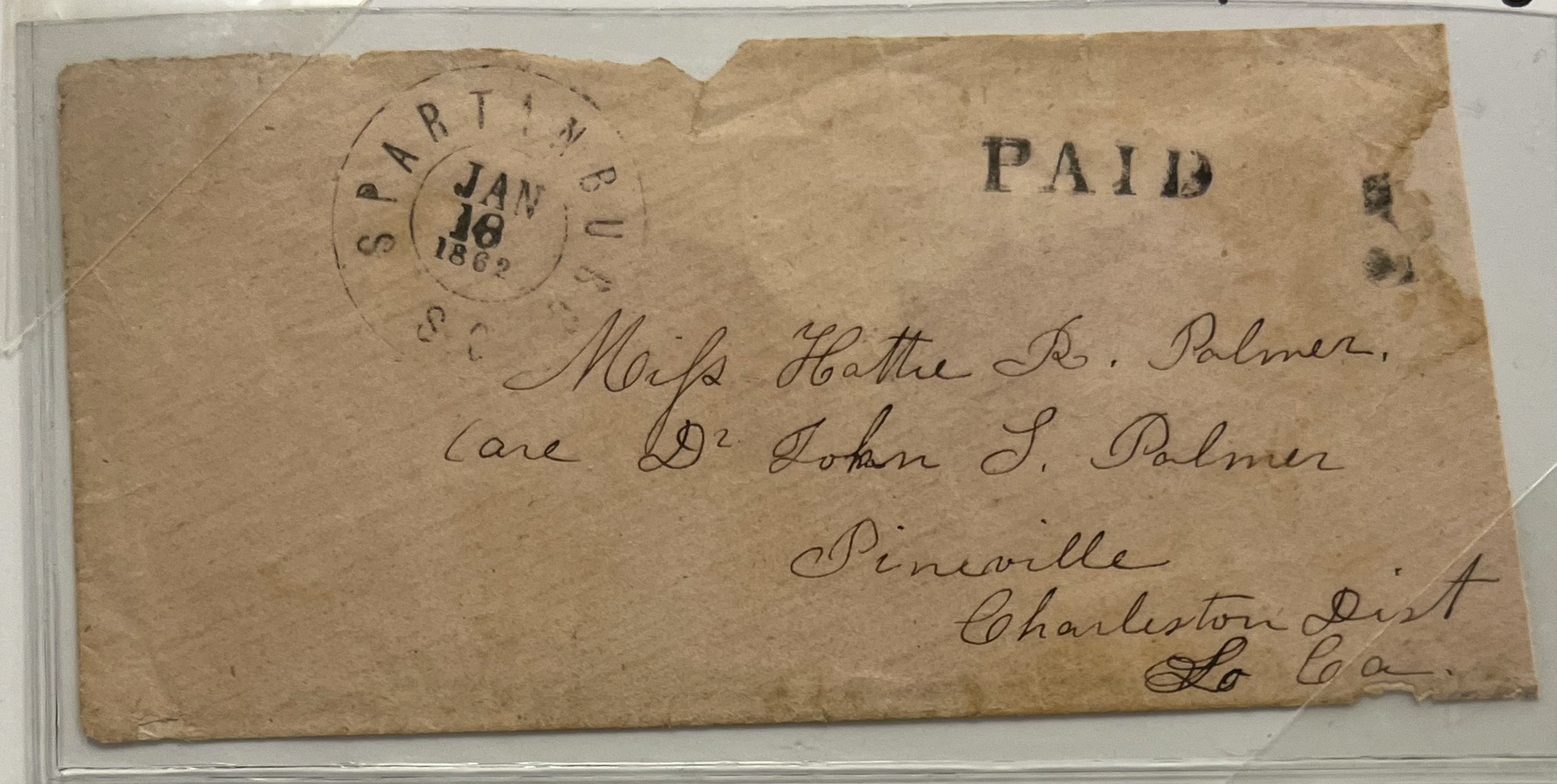
Soldier's Due letter from A. W. Thompson Jr., Company G, 6th ARK (Arkansas) Vols, to A. W. Thompson, Sr., CATARRH P. O., Chesterfield Dist., S. C. A black 26mm DCYD SPARTANBURG SC CDS, dated AUG 17, 1863 is struck on cover with a manuscript "due 10". No. 1068

A.W. Thompson Jr. was a private in the 6th Arkansas Infantry. He enlisted on Sept. 19, 1861 at Petts Ferry, Ark. for a duration of 10 months and 5 days. He was sick most of 1862 in Atlanta, and Montgomery hospitals. He returned to duty in August 62 and again was sick for the last of 1862. He rejoined his unit in Feb. 1863 and was wounded at the battle of Chickamauga and was hospitalized in Columbia, SC No. 1 Hospital. In February, he re-enlisted and was wounded 22 July 1864 and died 25 August 1864; he was 27 years old.

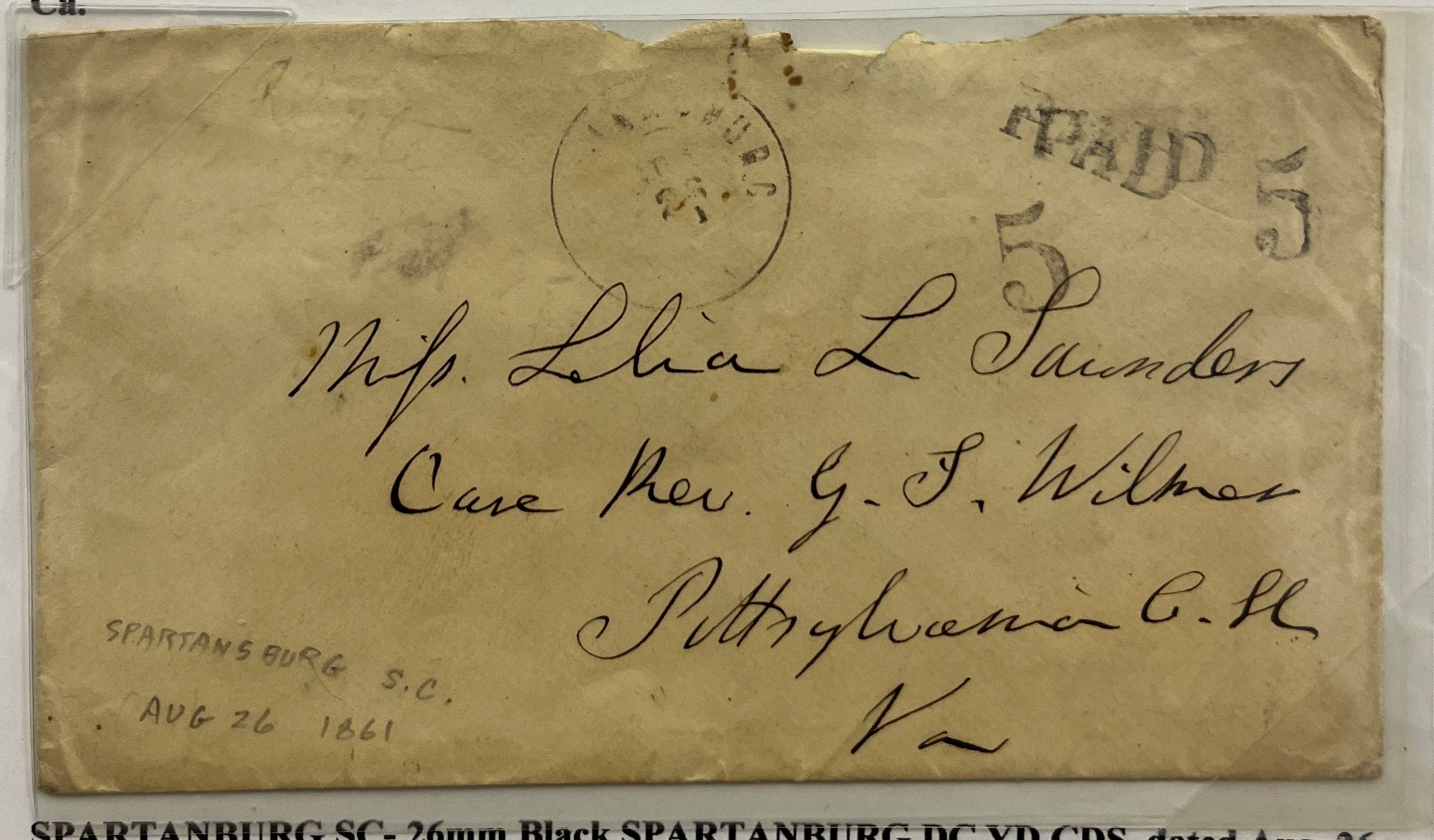

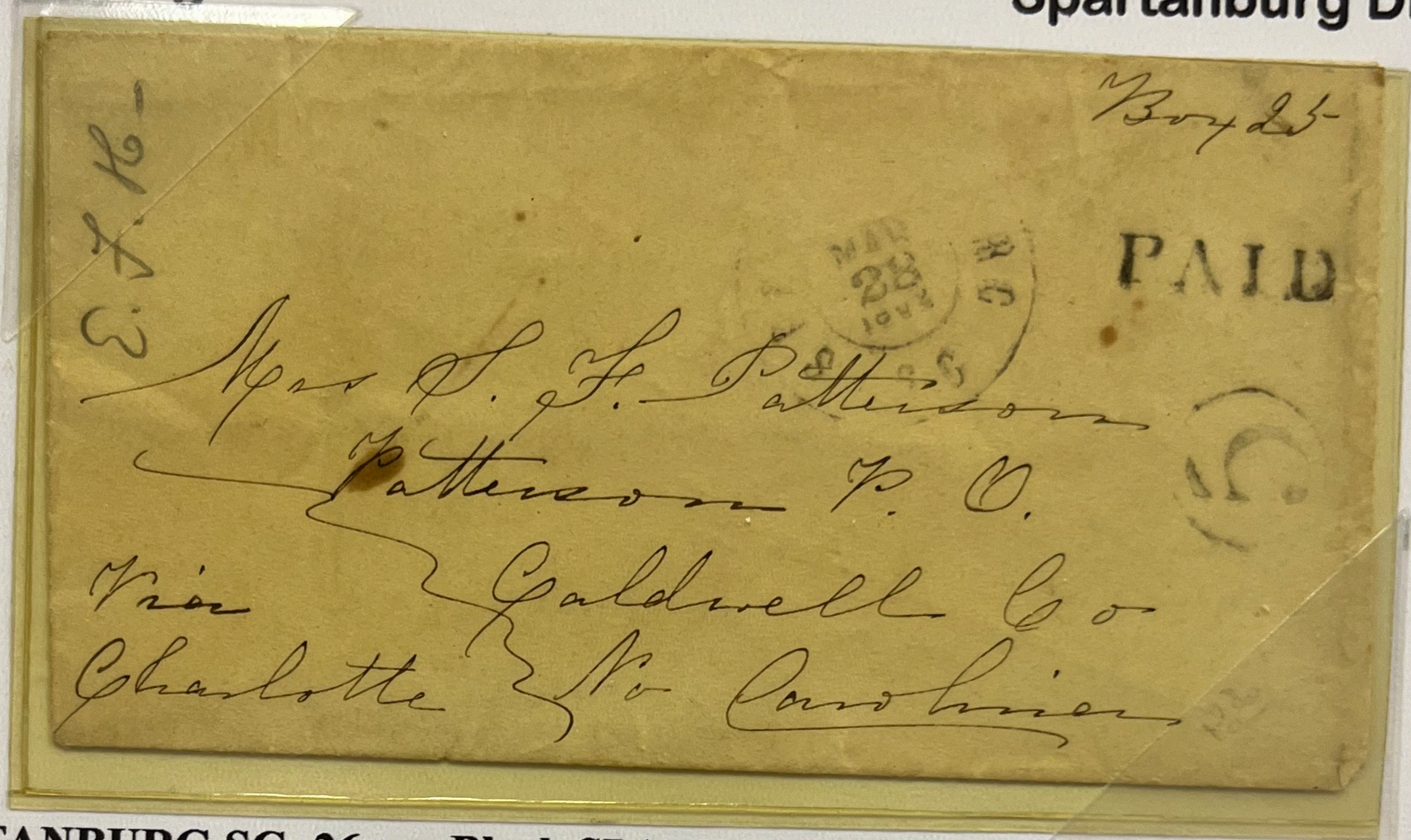

New Stampless Listing Type "G" with "PAID "5". The 5 is 8mm in length as opposed to Type B, which is 10mm in length

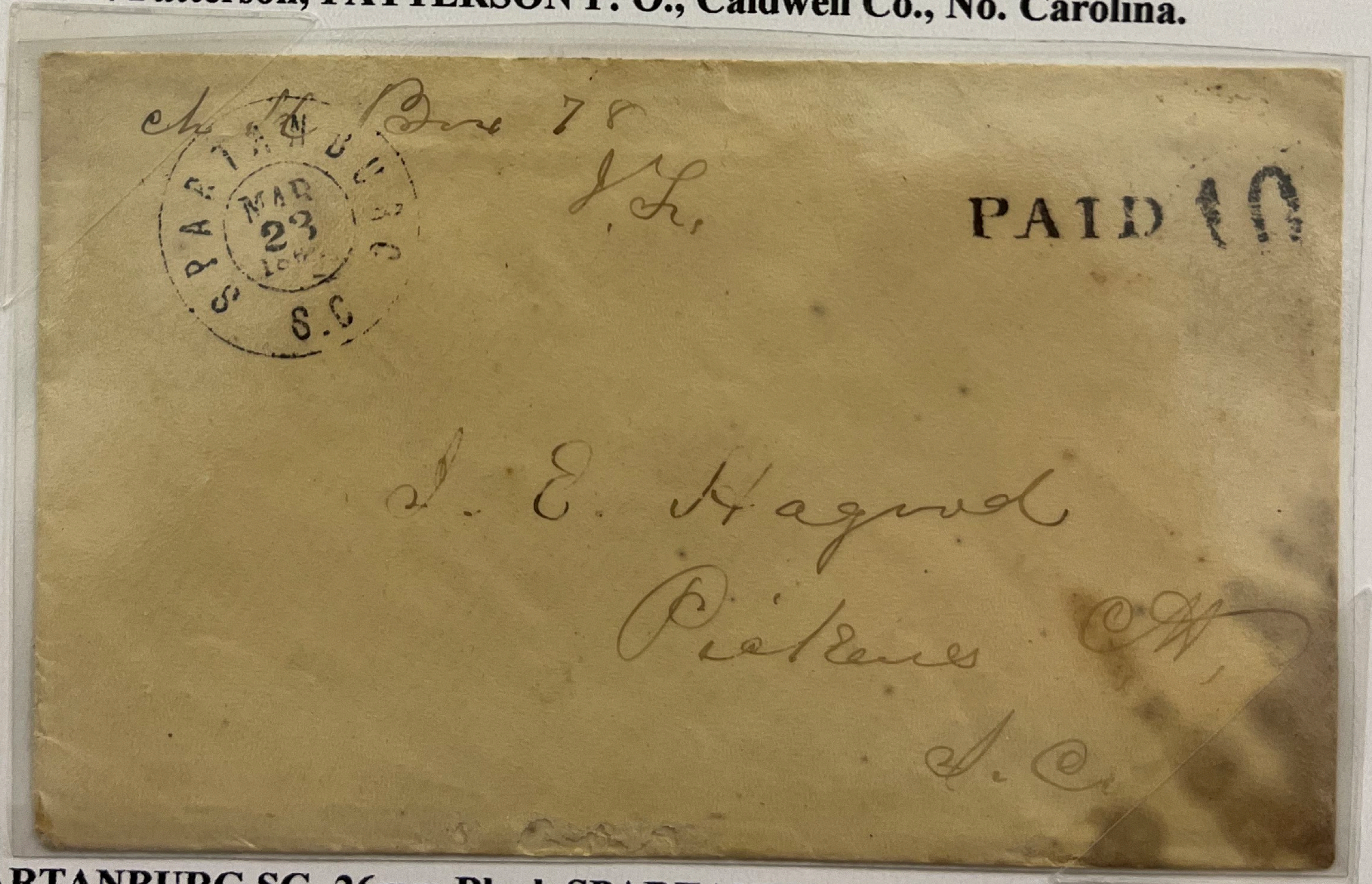

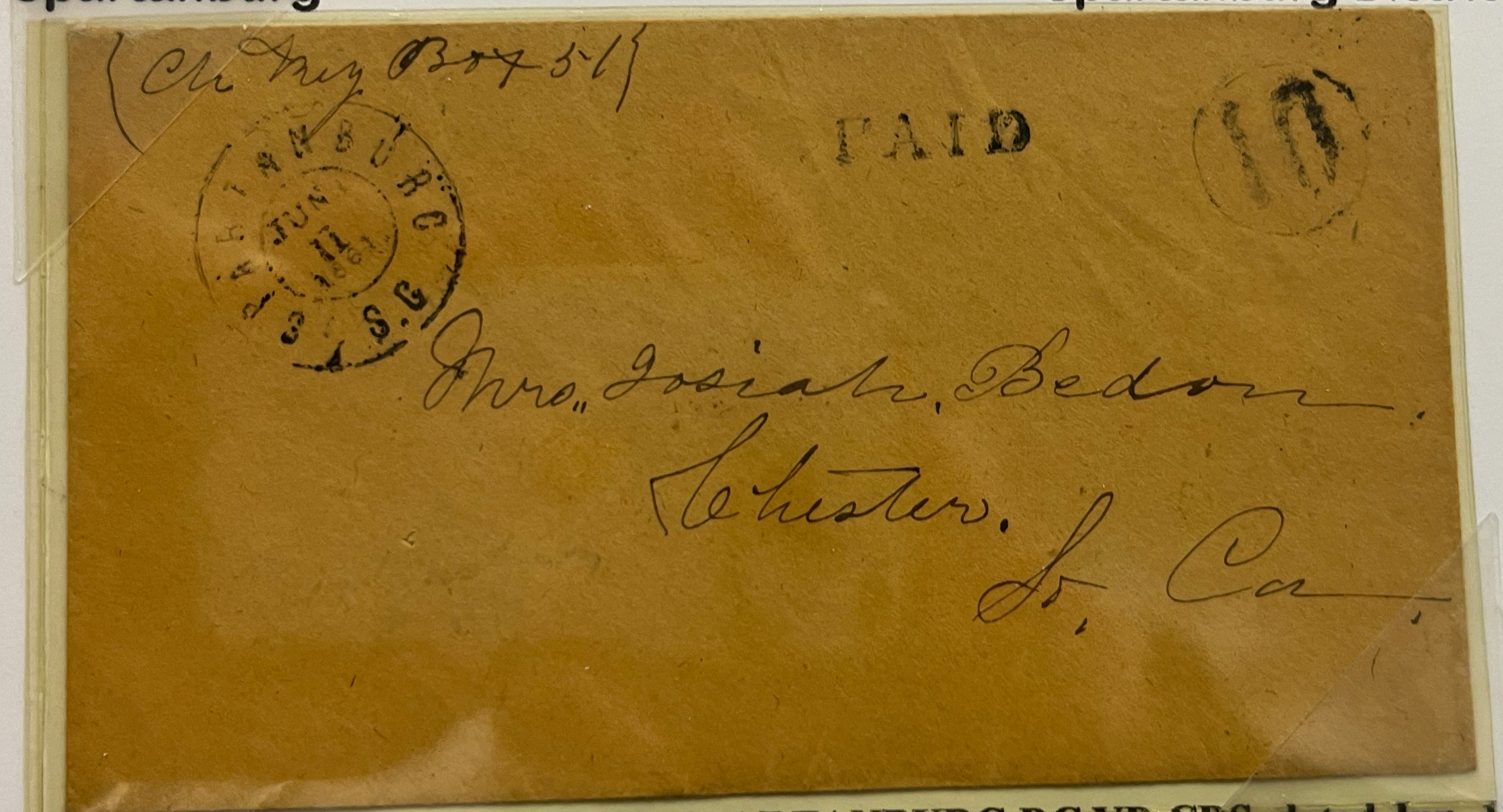

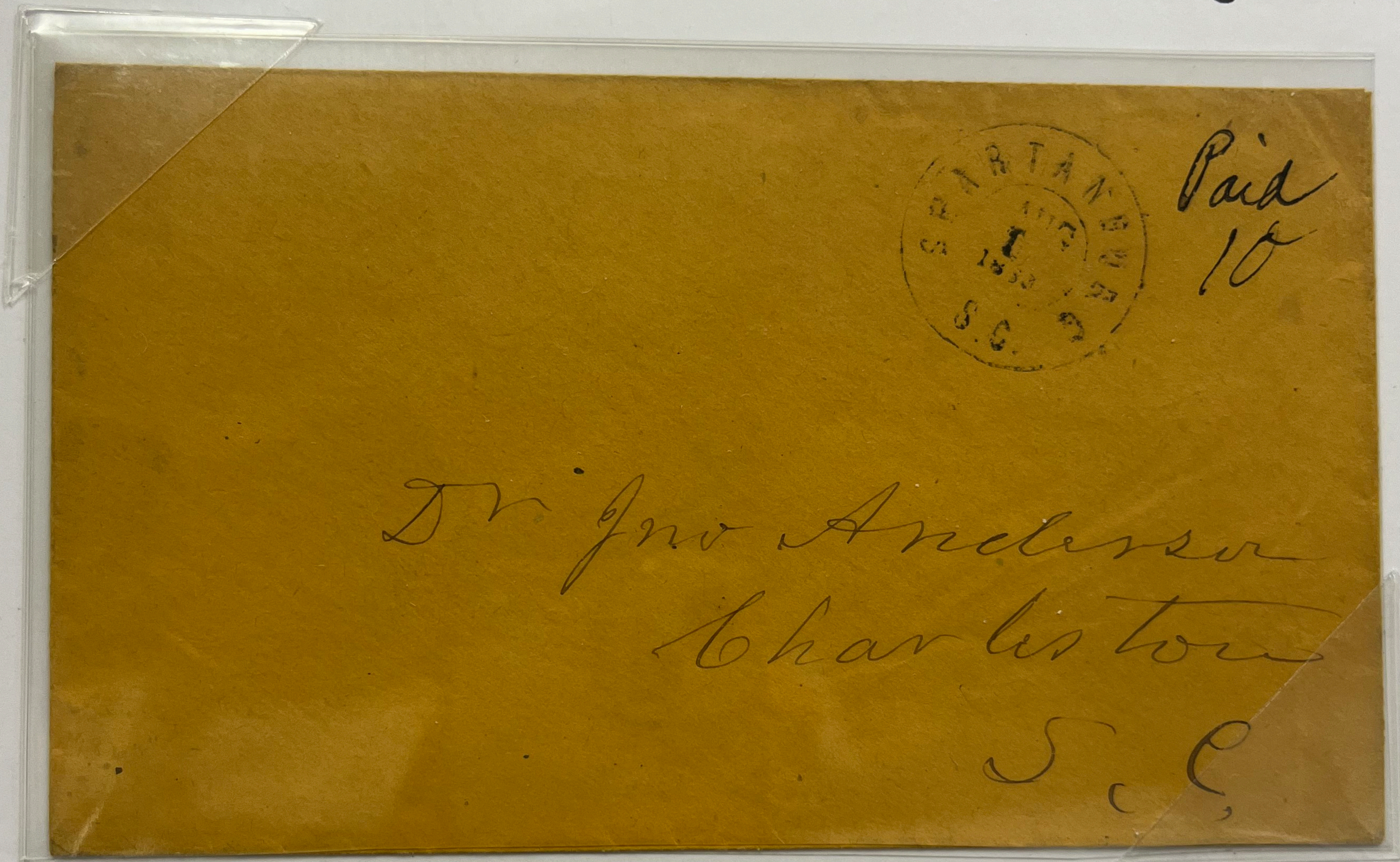
