

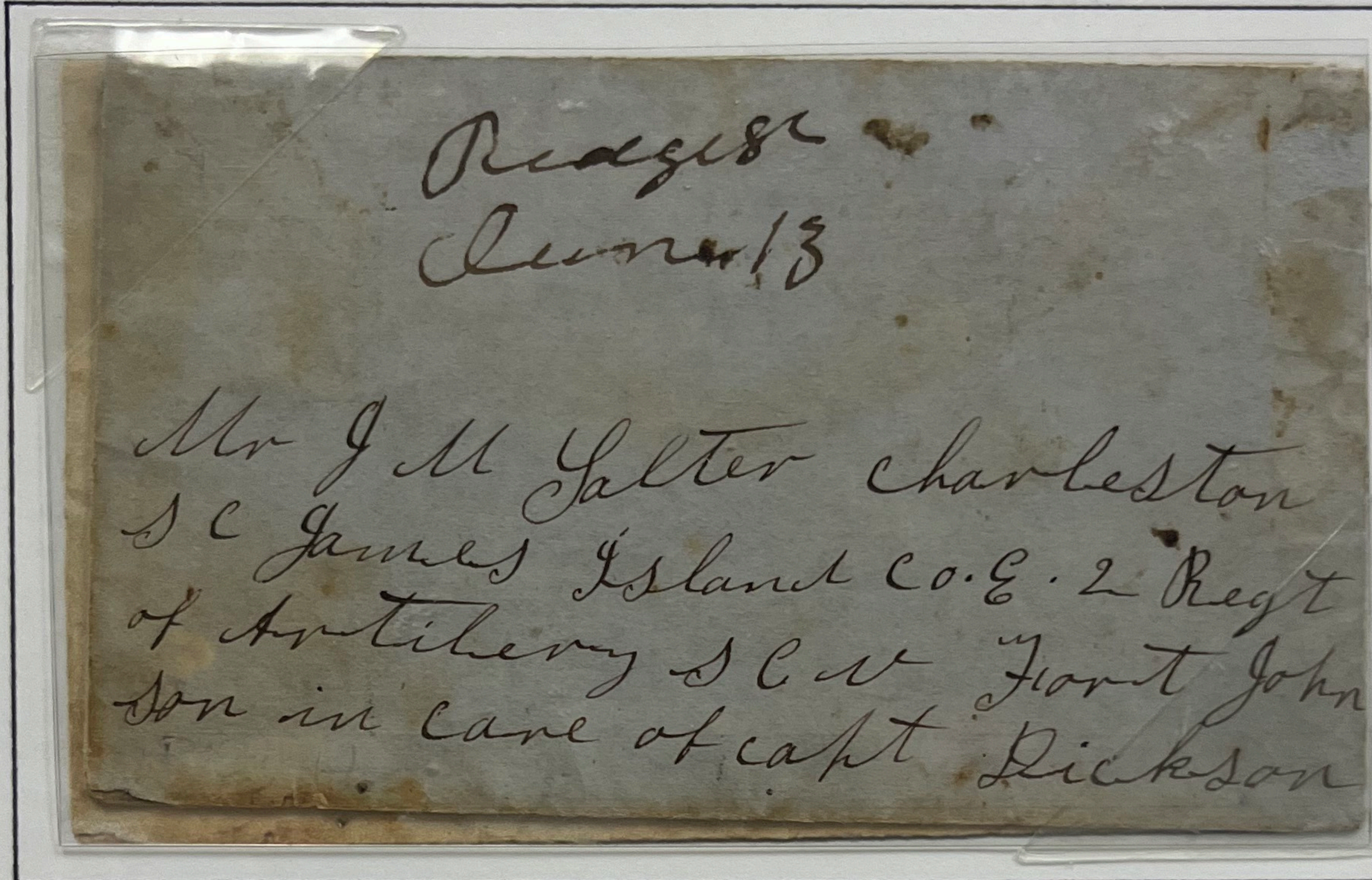

In Care of Capt Dickson. Second usage has a # 12 tied by a black 32mm CHARLESTON SC CDS dated OCT 12. Addressed to Mrs M. R. Salter, MINECREEK P. O., SC. No. 345**



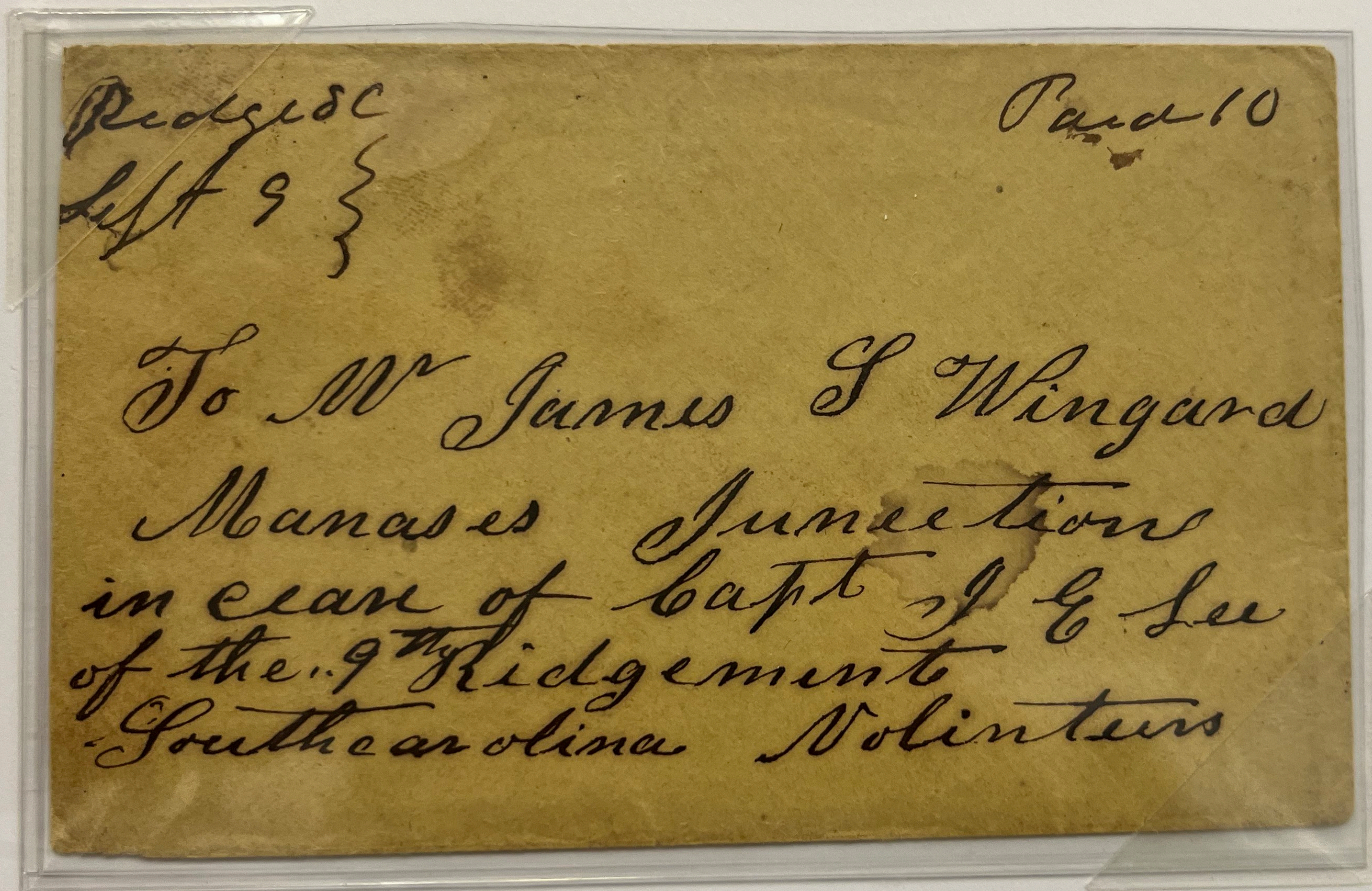
**James M Salter was a private in Co E, 2nd Reg't SC Artillery, who enlisted on March 12, 1863 for the duration of the war at James Island, SC. He served throughout the war in Charleston until its fall in Feb 1865. Salter was captured in Cheraw SC on Mar. 4, 1865. He was released on June 19<sup>th</sup> 1865 at Point Lookout, MD. Hre served under Capt. B.E. Dickson throughout the war.**
