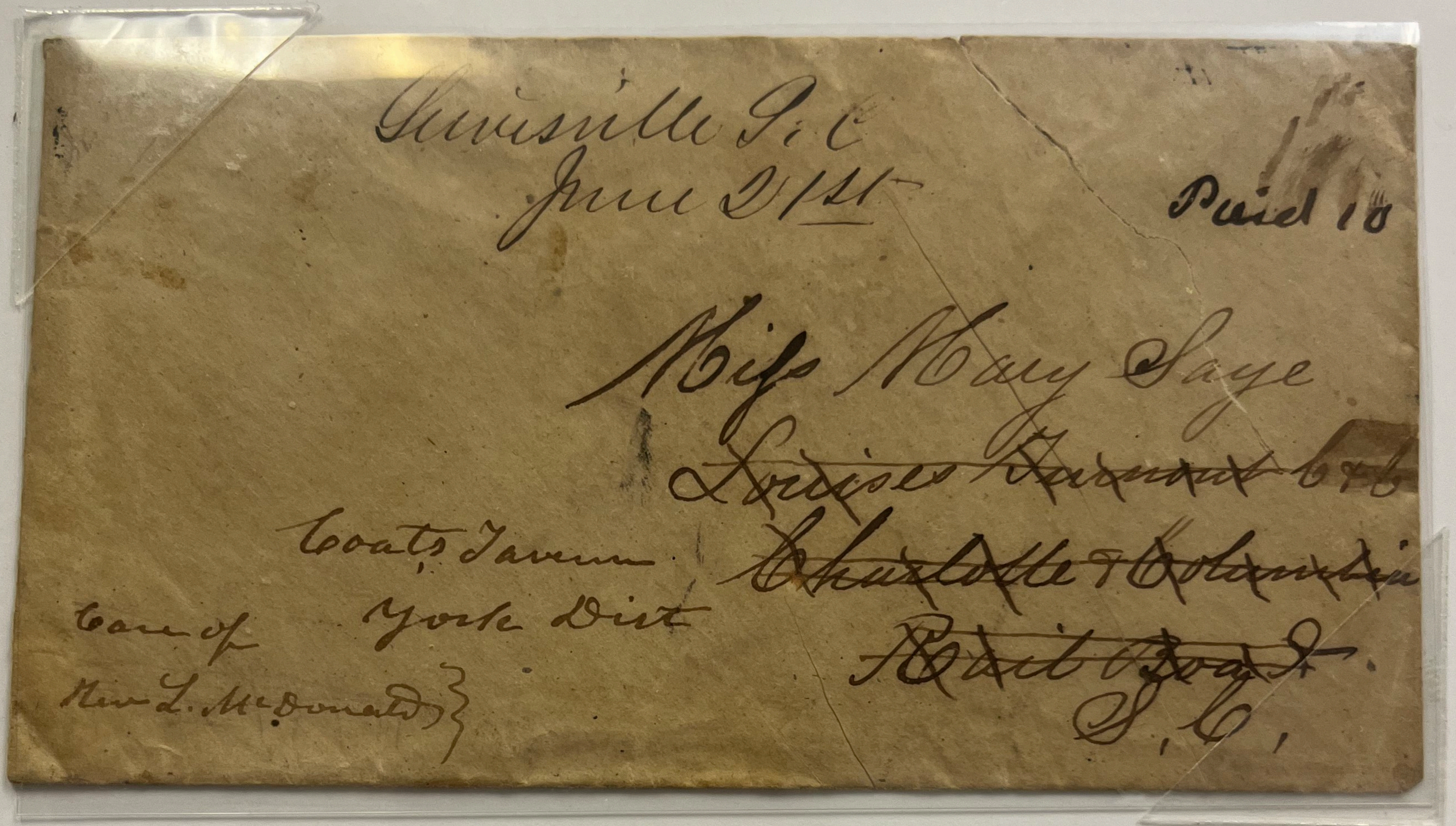

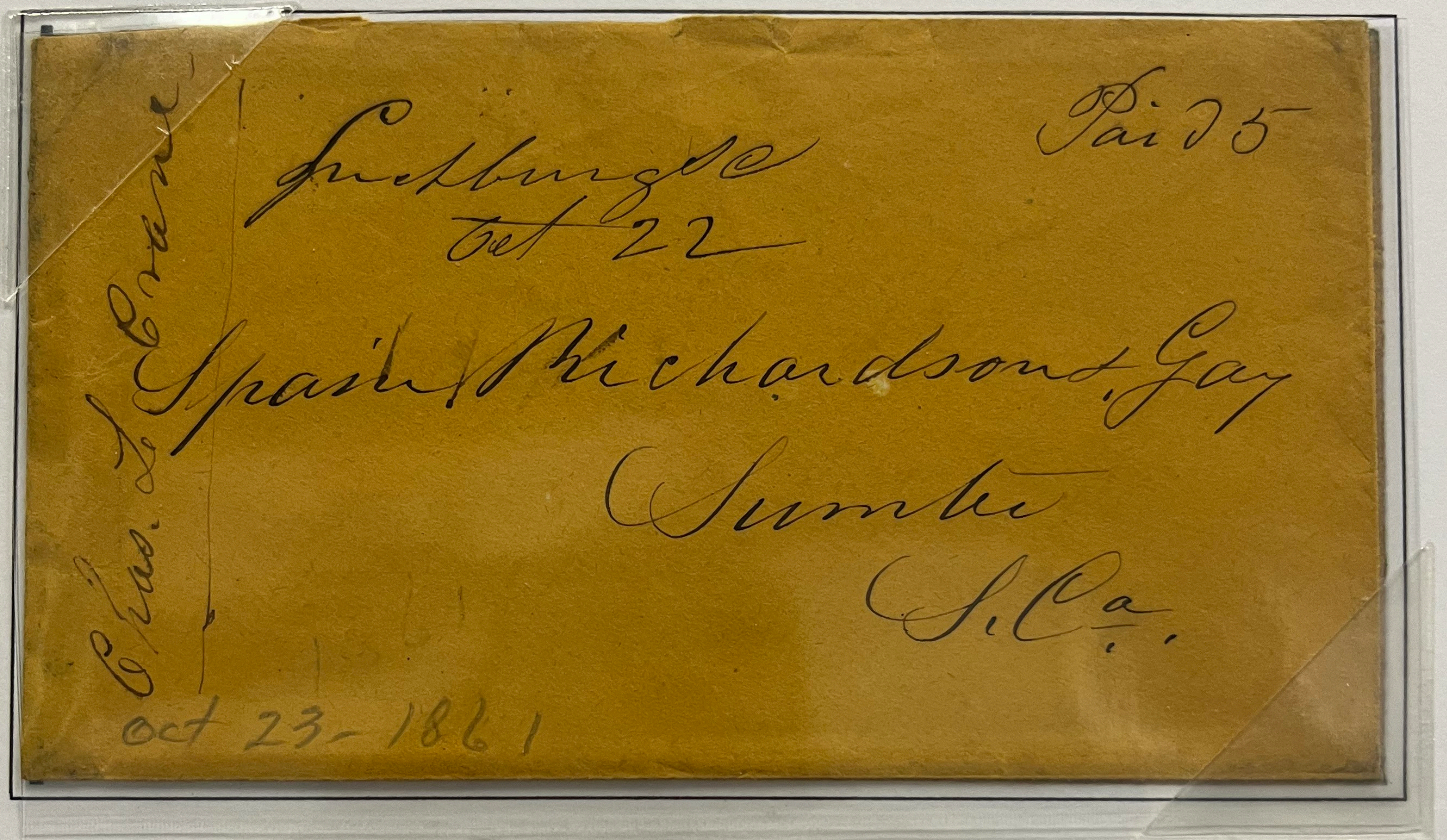

Forwarded to COATE'S TAVERN, York District, Care of Rev. L. Mc Donald. LOUISES TURNOUT never had a Post Office, probably dropped off by train conductor at the siding/turnout.

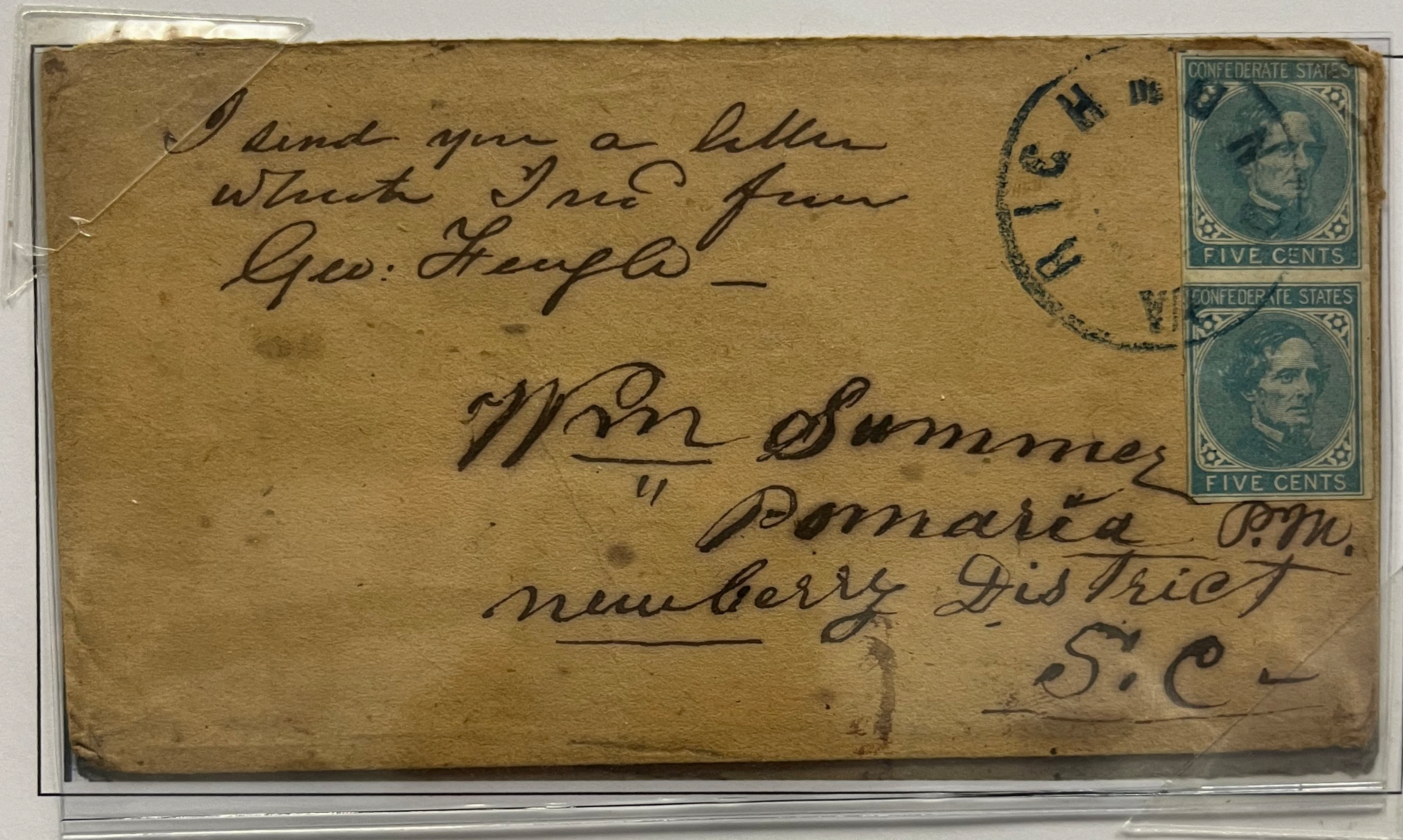

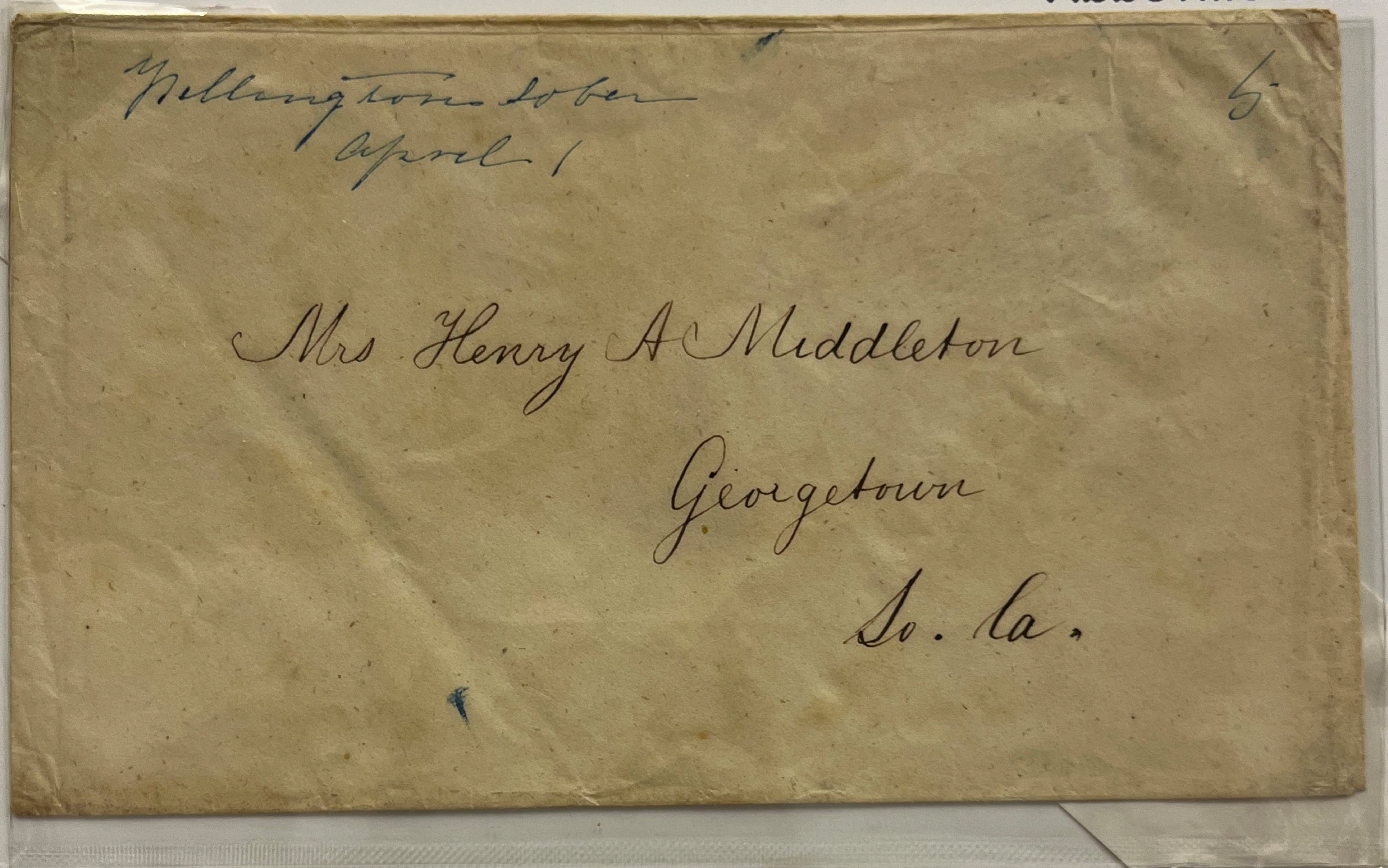

No. 145

W. C. Bradham enlisted on May 15, 1862 for the length of the war. He was assigned to Company A, then company I of the 7th SC Cavalry. In mid 1864, he was hospitalized in Jackson Hospital, Richmond and then transferred to Hug Springs Hospital on July 8, 1864. He later rejoined his unit and surrender on April 9, 1865 and was then paroled.

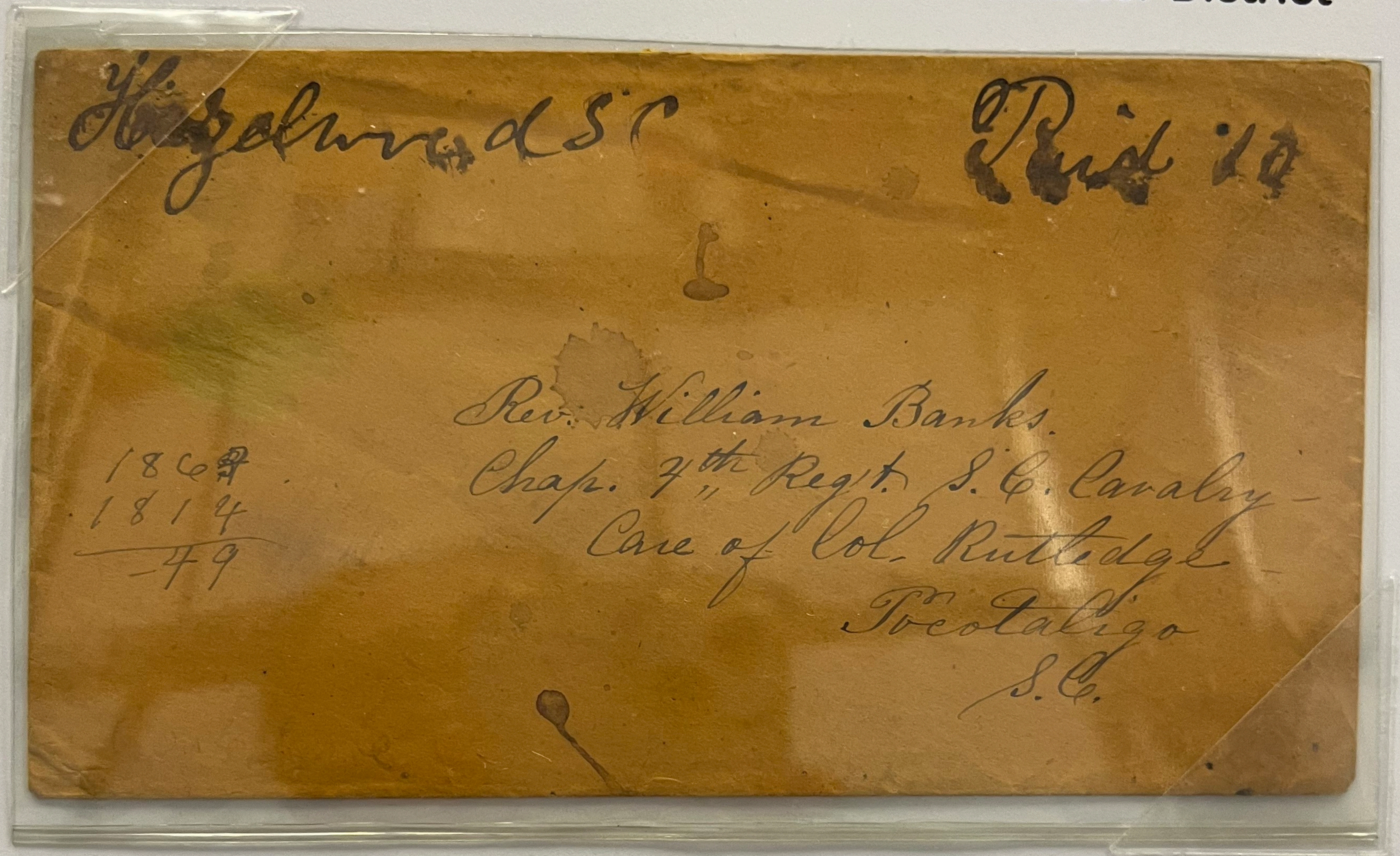

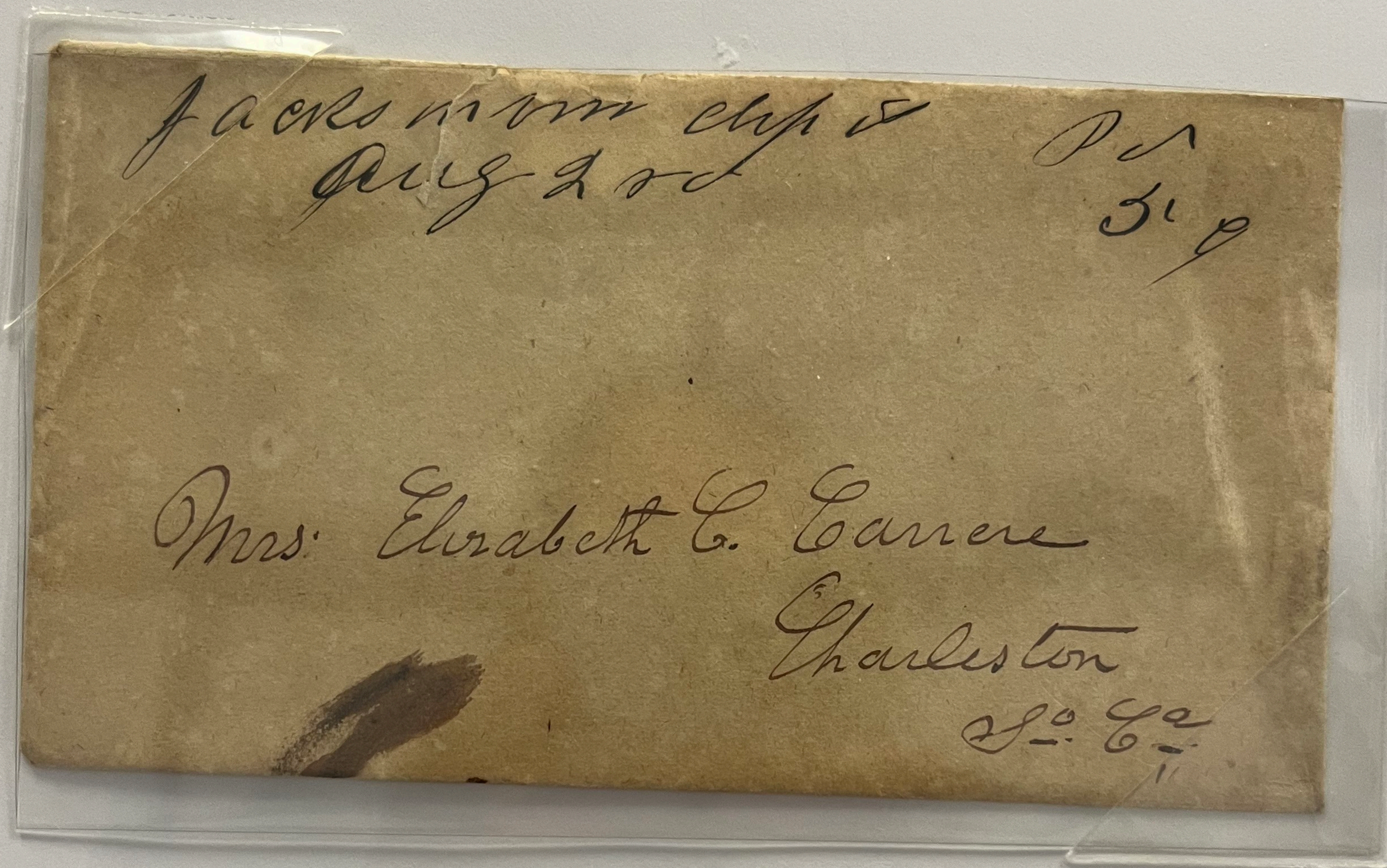
